## SUMMARY OF MEETINGS

MONDAY, 1 JULY 2019

### 1st PLENARY MEETING (morning)

The forty-seventh session of the Industrial Development Board was opened by H.E. Ms. Faouzia Mebarki (Algeria) outgoing President of the forty-sixth session.
