18. Matters related to intergovernmental, non-governmental, governmental and other organizations

- Indonesia is of the view that it is imperative for UNIDO to work with various partners to achieve its goals and objectives.
- At the same time, we should ensure that cooperation with partners provide maximum benefits to both UNIDO and its partners.
- In responding to applications from Asian Forest Cooperation Organization (AFoCO) and the Parliamentary Assembly of the Mediterranean (PAM), Indonesia requests further clarification from UNIDO on two aspects:
- Firstly, has UNIDO Secretariat has assessed whether both organizations stand ready to actively involve in UNIDO activities, in line with Paragraph 6.(a) of GC.1 Decision 41?
- Document No. 29 of this Meeting briefly explained potential cooperation between AfoCO and PAM on the one hand, and UNIDO on the other hand. However, we need to measure level of commitment and feasibility of pursuing such cooperation.
- Secondly, considering that both organizations are intergovernmental organizations, the Board should get clarification and more information on whether both organizations' intentions to have appropriate relationship agreement with UNIDO have obtained consent from respective members of the organizations.
