

**INTERVENTION AND NATIONAL STATEMENTS - REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA  
AT THE 51<sup>st</sup> SESSION OF THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT BOARD (IDB), UNIDO**

**UNIDO and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development (Item 7)**

1. Indonesia commends UNIDO's active and prominent role as the custodian agency for six industry-related indicators under SDG 9.

2. We also positively acknowledge UNIDO's initiative in developing Industrial Analytics Platform as the SDG 9 Industry Tracker.

3. To support UNIDO's more active role in global conversation on SDGs, we urge UNIDO's continued deliberation in participating in various activities, including the UNIDO's submission of input documents to the High-Level Political Forum (HLPF) on Sustainable Development.

Subsequently, Indonesia will continue to be proactive in providing constructive comments to UNIDO's draft inputs for High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development.

4. Indonesia would like to draw attention that current food, financial and fuel crises, as well as continuous impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic have created unprecedented challenges for many countries to the achievement of SDGs.

5. In that context, we should explore and carry out more rigorous, innovative and impactful SDGs policies. UNIDO should positively contribute to strengthen international commitment to achieve SDGs, as we all get closer to reaching the 2030 deadline.

7. UNIDO's SDG 9 Accelerator Platform has a great potential to facilitate experience and knowledge exchanges on inclusive and sustainable industrial development among Member States and other stakeholders within and across regions.

8. UNIDO should also put more attention to the considering interlinked nature of the SDGs,

9. Therefore, it is imperative for UNIDO to collect and publish information regarding the Organization's activities which contribute to other SDGs.
