



Global perspective

Month-over-month growth rates of global manufacturing exports



Global manufacturing exports posted another **robust result** in April 2025, growing by

2.1%


with limited impact yet from tariff uncertainty.



Regional performance


Month-over-month growth rate of manufacturing exports by region, April 2025

Global manufacturing export growth was driven by Asia & Oceania and Europe, while relatively higher U.S. tariffs already weighted on China's export performance.





Manufacturing Trade Balance



Northern America's trade deficit in manufactured goods narrowed significantly in April 2025, though it remains elevated. This shift reflects the initial impact of higher U.S. tariffs and a weaker dollar.

^{*} The normalized trade balance shows the trade surplus or deficit as a proportion of total trade (the sum of exports and imports) to facilitate cross-regional comparison. Note: This report is based on seasonally adjusted official data on monthly manufacturing trade (in current US dollar). Global and regional coverage exceeds 90%, except in Africa, where data availability remains limited.
