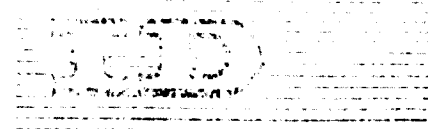

## I. Description of the Project

Centre for the collection of milk at Gabès, transport thereof to existing dairy at Sfax and establishment of a Yoghourt plant at Sfax.

This project is part of an overall regional development plan and as such has the full support of the Government of Tunisia.

### 1. The Proposal

The Oasis at Gabès offers an opportunity for collection of a much needed additional supply of milk for the dairy at Sfax. This would include weighing of milk delivered by farmers, quick testing of the milk, cooling, storage at Gabès and shipment.

1100 cows will produce 10,000 litres of milk per day by 1970.

A 4-ton refrigerator truck could carry the milk from Gabès to Sfax, a distance of 145 Km. and bring back general supplies to Gabès on its return trip.

The Yoghourt plant will be established as part of the existing dairy at Sfax.

Other contributions: the Tunisian sponsor is well qualified in the technique of manufacturing yoghurt and the dairy industry. No technical or managerial assistance is required.
