1. Background and justification

Polymers are now widely used in all aspects of modern life. They contribute, to a great extent, to the comfort and improvement of the quality of life. They owe their importance to their outstanding properties such as low density, durability, consistency and flexibility for a wide range of applications from simple packaging to heavy construction. Because of their low production cost, they have been extensively used for disposable packaging and containers.

It is expected that, during the first few years of the 21st century, there will be 2 to 3 fold increases in plastic consumption in developing countries, and even more than that, in rich developing states. However, this increased use of plastics is accompanied by a vast accumulation of solid waste and plastic litter, which, due to their resistance to biodegradation, have a deleterious effect on the environment as an obvious contributor to pollution.

The production and consumption of polymeric materials for commodity and specialty plastic items are subject to all the constraints and regulations dealing with the management of primary and post-consumer plastic-waste. In this respect, the production of environmentally friendly (sound degradable) polymeric materials should be a strategic option among those available for the management of plastic waste. The introduction of degradable polymeric materials is expected to provide a competitive alternative to present solid-waste management such as burial in landfill sites, incineration with energy recovery, and mechanical or chemical recycling. The new degradable plastics should replace the conventional commodity plastics in those segments in which recycling is difficult or economically not feasible.

As all the price of goods is closely associated with the production volumes based on the demands, the high price of EDPs cannot be reduced unless the demand is not increased. EDPs can however be considered as materials for niche market and segments of application for which the price does not constitute a limiting factor. Under these circumstances, it is most important and absolutely necessary to create an actual market for EDPs. Such a market can be developed in the first initial stage possibly by incentives and legislative decisions enforcing the utilization of environmentally biodegradable polymeric materials in market segments where the biodegradability of the post-consume plastic items constitutes a crucial requirement for environmental protection and improvement of quality of life. These choices could then be justified and supported by public opinion, that is getting more and more concerned with environmental protection and minimization of resources consumption.

The "International Meeting on Recycling and Environmentally Degradable Plastics from Renewable Resources and International Exhibition on Plastic Industries and Technologies" held on September 11-14 in Jakarta, Indonesia focused and

emphasized on pursuing a strategy for EDPs utilization in developing countries in addition to the impact of manufacturing and consumption of polymers on the environment.

2. Objectives

- To discuss the latest issues of technological development related with Recycling of Non-degradable Plastics and Environmentally Degradable Plastics (EDP) including their standards and test methods as well as the market strategy for these products.
- To exchange knowledge and information of non-degradable and degradable plastics between developed and developing countries.
- To raise public awareness on the negative impacts of non-degradable plastics and to introduce new material of the EDP as an alternative solutions in minimizing plastic waste problems.
- To enhance international cooperation and facilitate information access to all countries namely to ICS-UNIDO databases, country reports, guidelines, standards and regulations, and available technologies & products

3. Content of the Program

The meeting program includes long lectures sessions as well as short presentations and exhibitions in the following areas. It was especially focused on the regional situations in Asia and industrial developments:

- Plastic Recycling
- Plastic Waste Management
- Preparation and Properties of Environmentally Degradable Plastics (EDP)
- Application of EDP
- Manufacturing of EDP and Related Products
- Standards and Test Methods of EDP
- Policy, regulation, legislation associated plastic waste and public awareness.
- Country Reports

4. Organization

The Meeting was organized by the International Center for Science and High Technology (ICS-UNIDO) in cooperation with the Agency for the Assessment and Application of Technology (BPPT) and the Ministry of Research and Technology of Indonesia.

7. Dates and Venue

The Meeting was held from September 11 to 13, 2001 in BPPT, Jakarta, Indonesia. And Field Trip to Center for Polymer Technology Serpong was on September 14, 2001.

8. Funding

The budget approved by the ICS/UNIDO was USD 30,000 USD to cover invited participants', expenses for board and lodging during the meeting. While Indonesian contribution for the total amount of USD 10,329 was used for Meeting and Exhibition (venues and other supporting materials), secretariat and for publication of the abstracts and proceedings.

The actual total expenses for the events amounted to USD 30,093 that are larger than the previous estimation of USD 24,000 (80% from USD 30,000). Therefore, the rest of USD **6,093** From the ICS-UNIDO has to be transferred in order to fix the final balance.

The difference between the estimated and actual budget for invited participants' expenses for board and lodging was mainly caused by some followings:

- Some speakers should stay longer because of their flight schedule.
- Invited speakers that were originally planned to pay by their own expenses had been fully paid by the limited fund available.
- Hotel has been reserved and paid for 30 rooms for invited participants from the abroad but some participants were unable to attend without notice.
- The numbers of local and invited participants who attend the meeting was much larger than expected.

9. Participation

A total number of 90 participants, of which the ICS-UNIDO sponsored participants were 19 international key lecturers and participants from neighboring countries and 8 invited lecturers and participants from Indonesia.

1. Lecturers

Lecturers were presented by 27 participants from different countries and institutions and discussed about plastic recycling, plastic waste management, preparation and properties of EDP, application of EDP, manufacturing of EDP and related products, standards and test methods of EDP, and country reports.

2. Participants

The event of this meeting was announced to most universities, government and non-government institutions, industries, associations and many others. It was 90 participants that attended the meeting including those of invited participants from the abroad. Their numbers and countries were summarized in the table bellow:

10. Workshop Materials

11. Opening Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony was attended by several invited guests. It was started by the reports from the chair of the Organizing Committee Mrs. Tusu A. Adibroto, followed by Welcoming Address from the ICS-UNIDO Coordinator, Prof. Stanislav Miertus. Meanwhile, Congratulation Address was given by UNIDO Representative Mr. S.A. Hasnain, and Italian Ambassador H.E. Alessandro Merola. Finally, the Opening Remarks was addressed by Minister of Research and Technology/ Chairman of BPPT, H.E. M. Hatta Rajasa.

12. Program Agenda

The program was divided into two main events i.e. Meeting and Discussion held in BPPT Building from September 11-13, 2001 and Field Trip to Center for

Polymer Technology and Polymer Industry in Serpong and Serang on September 14, 2001.

Day-1 (Tuesday, Sept 11, 2001)

Preliminary session was filled with the opening ceremony, it was then to be continued by session-1 and 2 delivered by policy makers from both Indonesian and ICS sides. That session filled by 9 keynote speech (each 20 minutes) and discussed about General Aspects of NDP and EDP.

Day-2 (Wednesday, Sept 12, 2001)

It consists of 4 sessions (session 3 through 6) and 16 lecturers/papers (each 15 minutes). The topic of session 3 was the Application of EDP, session 4, 5 and 6 were the Manufacturing of EDP and related products. At the end of day-2, Wah Mau Industrial (H.K.) Co. Ltd delivered short presentation. Each presentation was followed by few minute discussion.

September 13 (Thursday):, and followed by Round Table Discussion with the industries and continued with Future Plan Discussion, and finally the meeting was closed on 06.00 PM.

Day-3 (Thursday, Sept 13, 2001)

10 country reports and 6 papers/lecturers (each 20 minutes) were delivered. After Round Table Discussion with the industries followed by Future Plan Discussion, the meeting was then closed at 06.00 PM. by the Minister of Research and Technology/Chair of BPPT.

Day-4 (Friday, Sept 14, 2001)

All participants followed the field trip to the Center for Polymer Technology (a polymer laboratory belonged to BPPT, under the Minister of Research and Technology), at Serpong Banten. In this place the participants were gathered to look around the facilities of this laboratory, especially the facilities for characterization of polymer material, the machinery for plastic processing, and also the reactors for synthesis of polymer materials.

Detailed Program Agenda is attached on this report.

13. Closing Session

After all presentations were to be given, it was then continued by Round Table Discussion with industries, Discussion on Follow-up Activities, and Recommendation and Conclusion.

The content of the meeting was summarized by Prof. E. Chiellini. Several important topics from the discussion are as the followings :

- Most of plastic waste is produced by packaging materials, and therefore several strategic issues related to packaging must be taken into account.
- There are some options for reducing the environmental impact of plastic wastes.
- The formulation of environmentally degradable polymeric materials and relevant plastic items will constitute a key option among that management of plastic wastes.
- Several countries do not focus on the development of waste management to solve their plastic wastes, but tend to focus on replacing NDP components with semi or fully biodegradable components.
- Testing and regulation for certification of plastic products in recognized laboratory is importantly required.

In addition, Mr. Miertus explained the ICS-UNIDO follow-up activities, which consist:

- To promote and support follow-up activities proposed by Indonesian committee
- Finalization of country report of all participating countries.
- Elaboration of guidelines on promotion of sustainable polymers
- Promotion of regional networks of ICS-UNIDO through establishment of national and regional focal points to facilitate information access to all countries.
- To analyze all recommendation and proposals for follow-up activities at the next EGM of ICS-UNIDO.

Ms. Lies A. Wisojodharmo addressed the recommendation for consideration as the followings:

- Capacity and knowledge building in Indonesia including plastic waste management, recycling and implementation of EDP.
- Technological Transfer

Director of Environmental Technology BPPT, Ms. Tusy A. Adibroto and her staff Mr. Mohamad Yusman proposed Joint Research Between ICS-UNIDO and BPPT entitled Plastic Waste Minimization in Indonesia with Special Case: "Plastic Waste from Packaging" as attached on Appendix-5..

Finally the meeting was closed by the Secretary General of the Minister of Research and Technology Dr. Ir. A. Malik.

14. Questionnaire

Questionnaire was distributed to all participants and returned to the local organizer. From the evaluation, all participants were generally satisfied with all meeting facilities and services as well as the topic of the meeting itself.

15. Results

- In the meeting all present issues related with EDPs were discussed with a focus on the general aspects of NDP and EDP, manufacturing, application, standard and test methods.
- The participants from developing countries, especially from Asia, were provided with updated knowledge and information on EDP in terms of the plastic waste management.
- All speakers and participants agreed the proper waste treatment system of plastic waste should be established and should prepare the EDP by using the resources from their countries.
- The international co-operation was stimulated through possible joint or follow-up projects by identifying regional R & D centers in those countries, through contacts established with the participants in the meeting. ICS-UNIDO can identify qualified academic, industrial, and R & D centers for future joint ventures for EDP's development.
- The meeting was successful and has achieved its objectives. It can be shown from :
 - The number of 90 participants, 81 persons from domestic and 20 from abroad.
 - The comprehensive issues of EDP were discussed covering all kinds (starch, cellulose, PHA, Polyolefin, chitosan), and all the aspects of EDP (technology and market development, standard and test, and also future aspects).
 - The exhibition session to demonstrate the actual EDP products (from China) and R & D of the EDP conducted by R & D institutions from Indonesia to all participants.
 - Attention from Indonesian industries to plastic waste treatment and EDP material, especially for the application of EDP as packaging materials.
 - Mass media coverage including local newspapers and direct interview with Ms. Tasy A. Adibroto for more or less 30 minutes by radio broadcasting. In addition, Mr Isa Karmisa, one of our Steering Committee members, was also interviewed by NHK Japan a week after the meeting (Attached).

ICS-UNIDO FOLLOW-UP From the meeting

1. To promote and support (where appropriate) follow up activities proposed by Indonesian committee.

Next steps:

- creation of join Indonesian – ICS-UNIDO expert group implementing key follow up recommendation presented (see Annex 1) and elaboration action plan based on detailed country report.
 - Evaluation of transferability and upgrading of national project to sub-regional level.
2. # Finalization of country report of all participating countries (by the end of October – full papers)
Their analysis and priority tasks for all countries
And presentation of strategy plans for next expert groups meeting indicating priority need.
 3. Elaboration of the Guidelines on Promotion of Sustainable Polymers (EDP, recycling, resources, technologies + standards, legislation) for Decision-makers).
 4. Promotion of regional networks of ICS_UNIDO through establishment of national and regional focal points to facilitate information access to all countries namely to :
 - ICS-UNIDO databases
 - Country reports
 - Guidelines
 - Standards + regulations
 - Available technologies & products
 5. Possible agreement on transfer of updated information on standards in EDP issues from main international standardization bodies and ICS-UNIDO (ASTM, ISO + ICS-UNIDO memorandum to be finalized and agreed).
 6. To analyze all recommendation and proposals for follow up activities at the next EGM of ICS-UNIDO (December 2001) and implement to next program.

Future plan of ICS-UNIDO-Indonesia cooperation

Follow up activities that might be realized between Indonesia and Italy is bilateral cooperation which will identify the necessity of EDP and promotion concept for sustainable development.

Schedule of activities will be more concise and be implemented in parallel covering :

1. Capacity and knowledge building in Indonesia including :

- plastic waste management
- recycling
- new concept for the implementation of EDP concept i.e. petro and bio resources

This will consist of the following steps:

- a. Pre-feasibility study related with potencies, industries, and availability of research facilities in order to prepare standardization steps.
- b. Training the manager for both researchers and industries in preparing the establishment of national Training Center supervised by the ICS-UNIDO.
This training packages and training for decision makers are aimed to implement the EDP concept.

2. Technological Transfer

- Assessment the available technology and product to be transferred and the establishment of new technology with biotech as its basic.

This assessment include :

- a. needs
 - b. resources
 - c. existing industries to be upgraded
- Determine 2 – 3 technologies for the future.
 - Define pilot projects for both EDP and recycling.

3. Preparatory for this project is until the end of December 2001 and the overall project should be scheduled for only 2 years (2002-2003) in which phase 1 is a short parallel for identifying pilot project.

Plastik Berbisik

Jakarta - Plastik mungkin material buatan yang paling berhasil. Dia menggantikan peranan banyak material lain di banyak industri dan barang-barang konsumsi. Plastik dapat sekeras batu, sekuat besi baja, tembus pandang layaknya kaca, ringan seperti kayu, kenyal seperti karet, dan--yang paling utama--harganya lebih murah.

Plastik jauh lebih andal untuk, misalnya, pembungkus dibanding daun pisang atau jati. Tapi andal tak mesti ramah. Faktanya, plastik telah menjadi salah satu pencemar lingkungan paling merusak. Daya tahannya terlalu hebat untuk punah dengan segera. Tapi, ramah, bukan pilihan.

Hingga saat ini, penggunaan plastik masih terus meningkat, yang berdampak pada peningkatan volume sampah plastik yang dihasilkan. Tak terkecuali di Indonesia.

Menurut Menteri Negara Riset dan Teknologi Ir Hatta Radjasa, permintaan domestik untuk plastik setiap tahun mencapai 1,5 juta ton atau tujuh kilogram perkapita pertahun. Sampah plastik yang dihasilkan, di Jakarta saja, perhari di atas tujuh persen dari total buangan sampah yang sebanyak 4.775 ton.

Celakanya, kebanyakan sampah plastik tidak terpisahkan dari sampah padat lain, hingga menyulitkan penanganan sampah tersebut dan berdampak pada penurunan kualitas lingkungan hidup. Itu tadi, plastik masih tetap bugar ketika sampah organik sudah hancur.

Sehubungan dengan itu, Pusat Pengkajian dan Penerapan Teknologi Lingkungan - Badan Pengkajian dan Penerapan Teknologi (BPPT) menyelenggarakan Indonesia International Meeting & Exhibition on Plastic 2001, mulai Selasa (11/9) hingga 14 September 2001 di Jakarta. Bekerjasama dengan International Center of Science and High Technology-United Nation for Industrial Development Organization (ICS-UNIDO), kegiatan ini bertujuan memperkenalkan teknologi daur ulang plastik petrokimia dan plastik ramah lingkungan.

Plastik ramah lingkungan memang salah satu solusi untuk mengurangi dampak buruk plastik terhadap lingkungan. Solusi lainnya adalah dengan mendaur ulang plastik yang tak dapat dihancurkan secara alamiah (non-degradable plastics).

Di Indonesia, pemakaian plastik ramah lingkungan masih terbatas dalam penelitian dan belum diterapkan secara luas. Kendala utamanya adalah karena ketersediaannya masih dalam jumlah kecil. Selain itu harganya empat sampai sepuluh kali lebih mahal dari plastik petrokimia.

Tapi bukannya tak ada. Penelitian yang dilakukan Sentra Teknologi Polimer (STP) PUSPITEK Serpong pada 1997, misalnya, berhasil menciptakan polimer dari bahan pati atau tapioka yang dicampur dengan //methyl acrylate// sehingga diperoleh plastik yang dapat menyatu dengan tanah. Johan A Nasiri, PhD, manajer penguji STP mengatakan bahwa plastik ini cocok untuk poly bag tanaman yang dalam jangka 3 bulan dapat hancur.

Penelitian lain yang dilakukan Research Center for Physics-Lembaga Ilmu Pengetahuan Indonesia (LIPI) berhasil membuat plastik untuk selaput loudspeaker dari fermentasi sari pati kelapa (//nata de coco//).

Adapun upaya untuk mengurangi sampah plastik dilakukan oleh industri yang mengkonsumsi plastik dalam jumlah besar. Misalnya seperti yang dilakukan PT Tirta Investama, produsen salah satu air mineral di Jakarta.

Menurut Eka Budiarta, Direktur Hubungan Sosial, pihaknya berupaya mengurangi sampah plastik di dalam pabrik dengan cara menekan pemakaian bahan baku. Kemasan botol air merek itu dikurangi beratnya dari di atas 20 gram menjadi 18 gram. Selain itu sisa-sisa plastik yang dihasilkan waktu memproduksi kemasan didaur ulang untuk dijadikan bahan baku plastik kembali.

Selain untuk mengurangi sampah plastik, Budiarta mengatakan, pihaknya juga turun ke lapangan dan memberi penjelasan kepada para konsumen bahwa lebih baik membeli air dalam kemasan ukuran besar ketimbang air dalam kemasan kecil. "Sebenarnya 70 hingga 85 persen harga air untuk membeli kemasan," katanya.

Menurut Nasiri pilihan lain untuk mengurangi sampah plastik adalah dengan mendaur ulangnya melalui tiga macam penanganan -- menjadikannya bahan baku langsung, bahan baku unsur pembuat plastik, dan menjadikan plastik sebagai energi dengan cara dibakar. Mendaur ulang plastik untuk dipergunakan sebagai bahan baku langsung dilakukan dengan memilah-milah jenis plastik yang dikumpulkan, lalu plastik dibersihkan dan dilelehkan untuk mendapatkan pelet atau resin. Biasanya kualitas pelet yang dihasilkan menurun sehingga pelet ini hanya digunakan untuk bahan baku pembuatan tali rafiah, ember, keset atau gantungan baju. Sedangkan untuk menghasilkan bahan baku plastik dari plastik bekas harus melalui proses panjang. Yang paling mudah adalah menjadikan sampah plastik sebagai energi dengan cara membakarnya.

Kelihatannya, tak seperti memakainya, menangani sampahnya bukan pekerjaan gampang.

PLASTIK Ramah Lingkungan

Sejak 11 September hingga 14 September 2001 diselenggarakan Indonesian International Meeting & Exhibition on Plastics (HMEP). Pertemuan dan pameran yang berlangsung di gedung BPPT, Jakarta ini juga akan mengadakan kunjungan ke Pusat Teknologi Polymer - Serpong, Banten. Pertemuan internasional ini sendiri diikuti oleh lebih dari 30 negara.

Dalam salah satu makalahnya, salah seorang peserta mengatakan bahwa diperkirakan tak kurang dari 200 juta ton plastik yang telah dibersihkan manusia, dimana angka ini nampaknya akan terus bertambah sesuai dengan kebutuhan manusia. Untuk mengatasi permasalahan ini, beberapa negara telah berhasil membuat plastik yang ramah lingkungan dari bahan tepung dan jagung, sehingga bila dibuang begitu saja di atas tanah, lama kelamaan rambut akan hancur dan menyatu dengan tanah.

Disamping itu, nampaknya di Indonesia akan kembali digalakkan program untuk pembuatan dan pemakaian pupuk alam (kompos) yang tak memakai lagi zat-zat kimia. Bahkan, menurut saindhu satu sumber yang ada, kan ada reward bagi yang membuat pupuk alam serta yang memproduksinya.



Perkembangan farmasi di dunia semakin hari semakin berkembang. Baik ditilik dari sudut obat-obatan sebagai industri dan komoditi maupun bila ditilik dari segi teknologi dan inovasi. Jumlah obat untuk satu jenis penyakit saja kini bisa bermacam-macam. Sebut saja obat untuk sakit kepala, berpuluhan-puluhan merek dagang obat yang bisa kita pilih yang menawarkan khasiat penyembuhan yang berbeda satu dengan yang lain.

Dalam Indonesia sendiri perkembangan dunia farmasi berlangsung dengan sangat cepat. Dari segi jumlah, tak kurang dari 250-an perusahaan yang menggeluti

industri farmasi nasional. Nilai produksinya pun cenderung mengalami peningkatan setiap tahunnya. Kondisi ini tentunya patut kita syukuri bersama. Namun demikian, ditilik dari sudut inovasi, perkembangan dunia farmasi relatif mengalami stagnasi. Hal ini terutama karena sebagian besar industri farmasi nasional lebih menitikberatkan pada formulasi bahan baku obat, yang notabene di import dari luar negeri. Karenanya tak perlu heran bila R&D di perusahaan-perusahaan farmasi kurang berkembang.

Bersamaan dengan itu, didalam masyarakat muncul kecenderungan untuk kembali ke alam (*back to nature*). Sebagian masyarakat kini menyukai mengkonsumsi obat-tradisional yang alami ke obat-obatan modern. Mereka anggap lebih aman mengonsumsi obat alami karena efek sampingnya sangat kecil. Ini merupakan peluang bagi industri tradisional, seain karenanya pasarnya mulai terkuak, buat obat-obatan alami sangat dibutuhkan di Nusantara ini.
