NOTE

The work of the Conference will be organized in accordance with the approach defined, i.e. to establish contacts between foreign and Tunisian participants centred on specific proposals of co-operation in a given industrial project, a branch of industry or a sub-contracting operation.

Two types of programmes are therefore being arranged:

- (i) individual programmes as confidential business meetings to discuss co-operation in the form of investments, expansions of existing enterprises or the setting up of new enterprises;
- (ii) group programmes aiming at informing foreign participants on the general conditions of a certain branch of industry, as a first step to initiate direct contacts to discuss those specific projects of industrial co-operation between both parties concerned.

Participants will thus be given two different programmes: the first lists suggested individual contacts with Tunisian project sponsors; the second refers to group meetings on branches of industry which the participant may wish to attend.

The schedule of individual programmes will as far as possible take into account the group programmes to allow participants to attend both.
