Wood, paper, solid board, corrugated board, textiles, plastics, metals, etc.

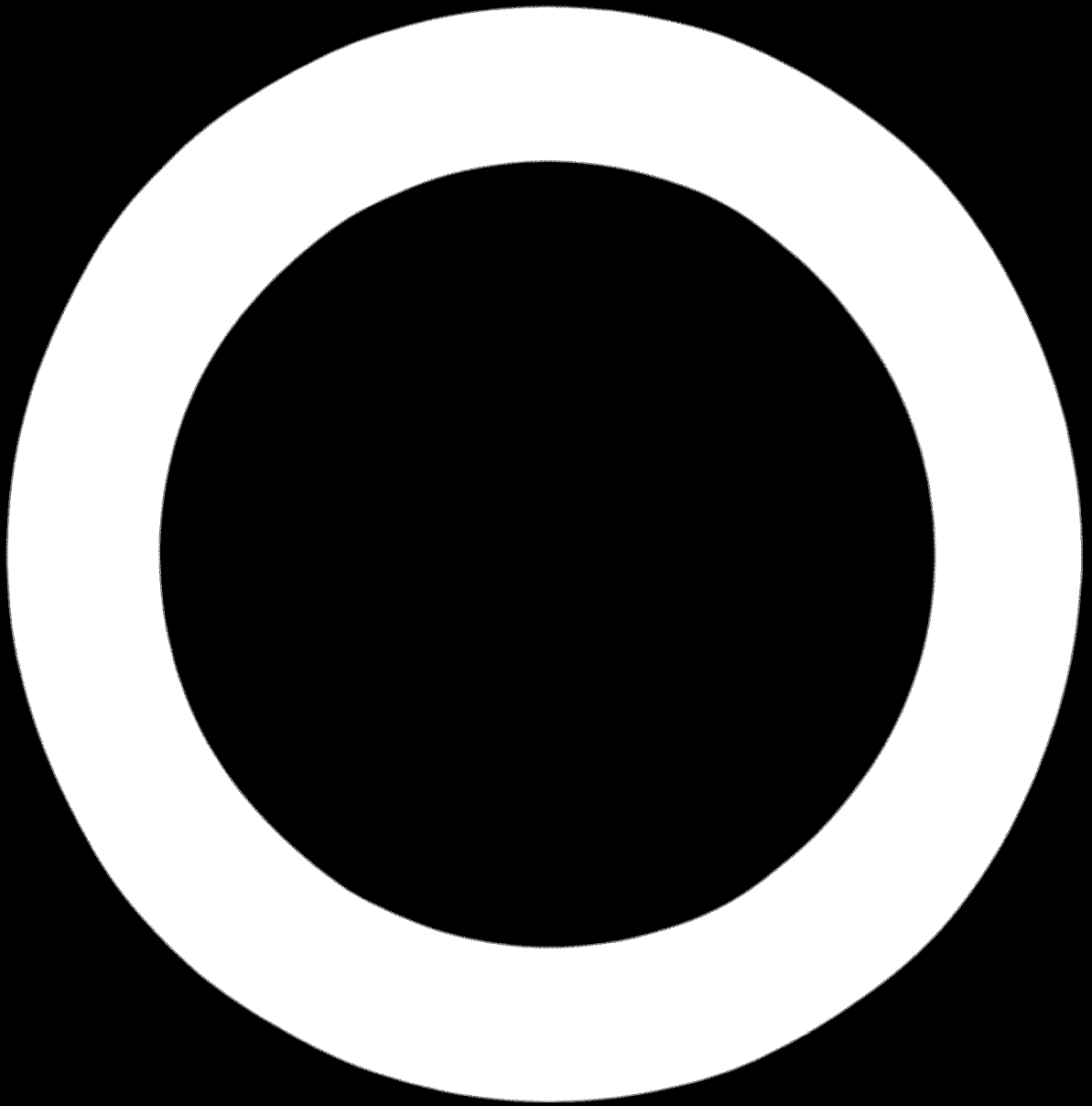

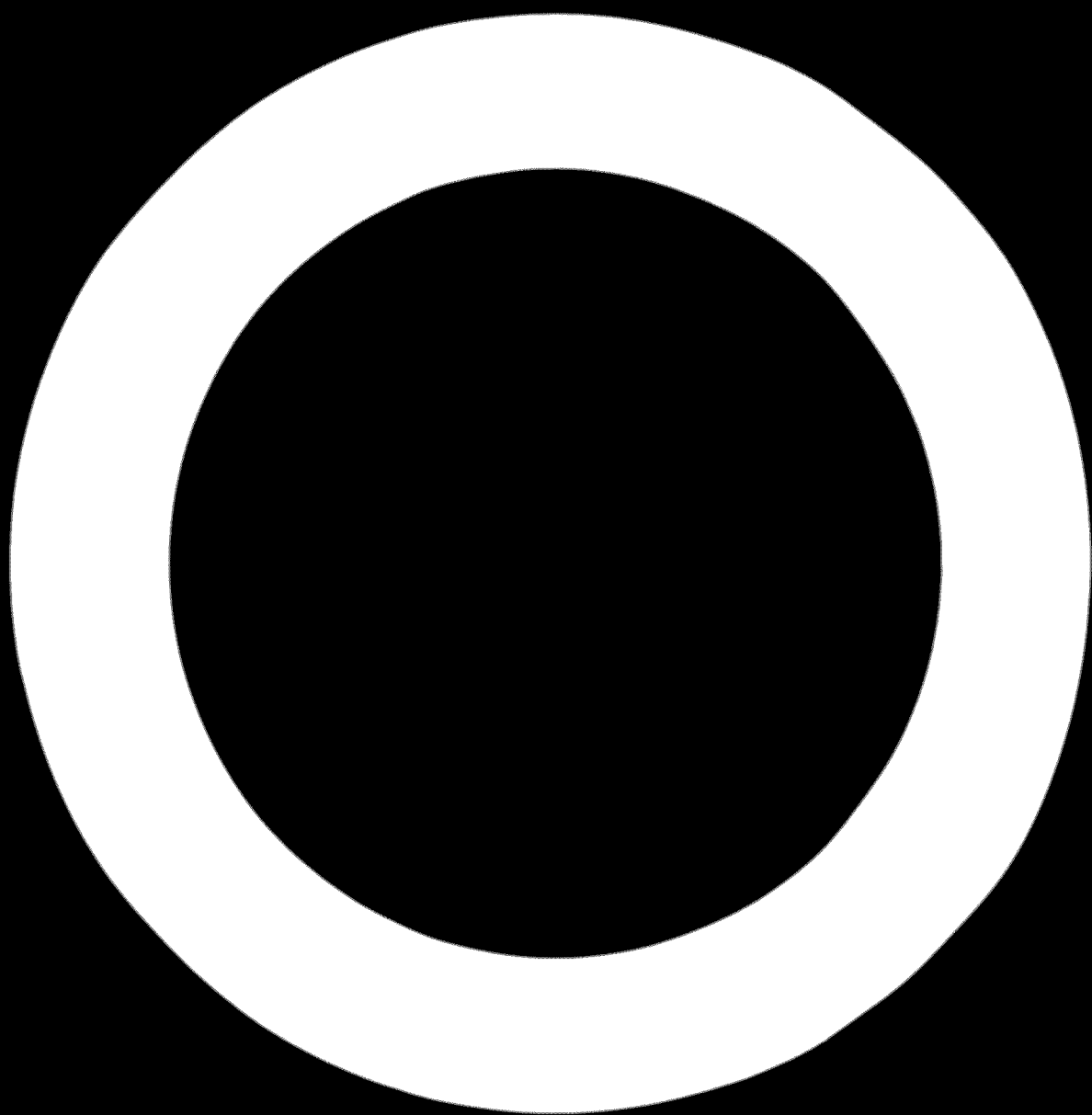

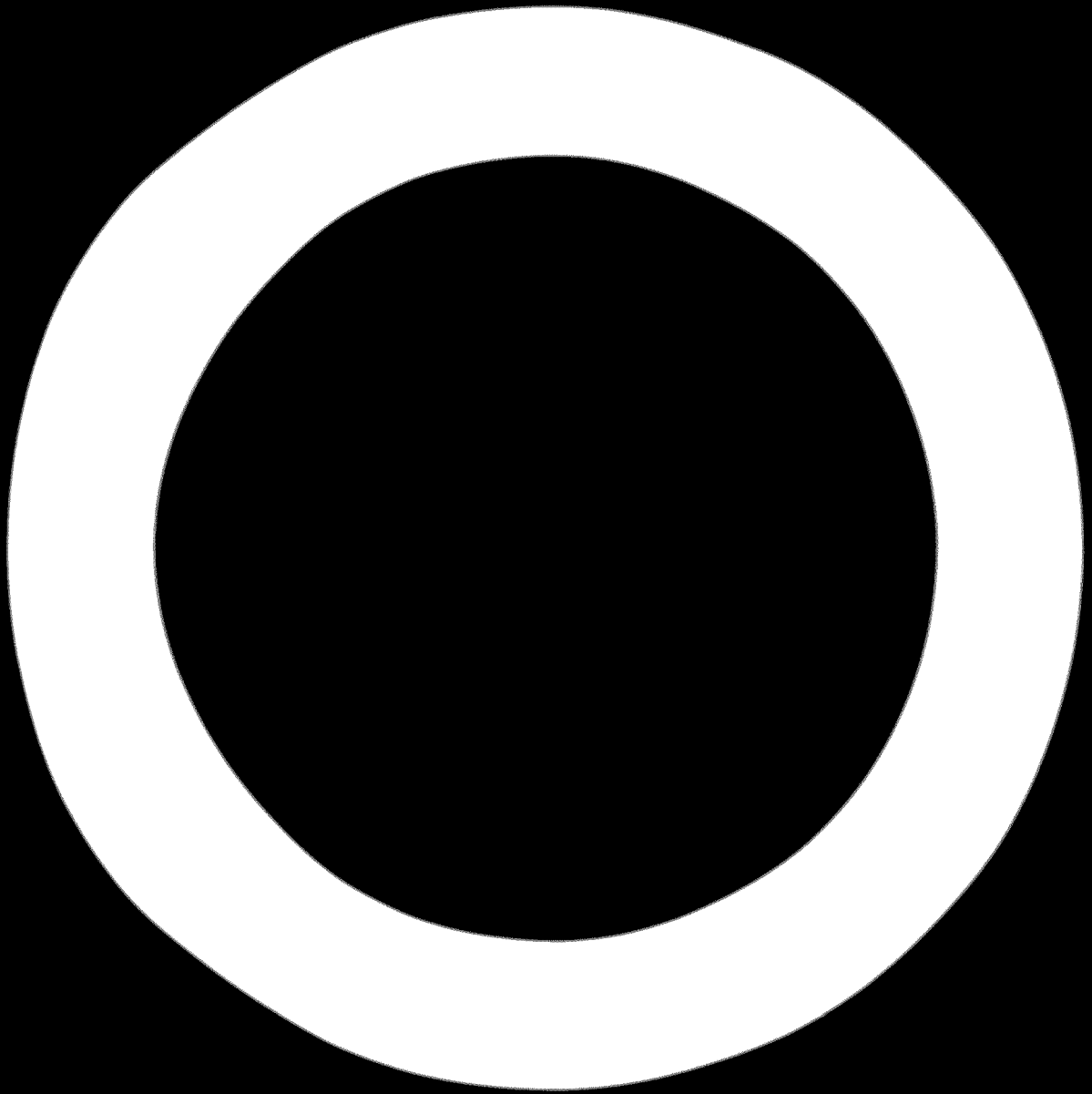
Index

The to which production, transportation and distribution of the various units, packaging materials, and other related products and services are required to compete with foreign products in various markets. It is necessary to the consumer to have a high level of quality and reliability in the products, services and materials. The packaging materials, and in particular the design, are developed locally and are therefore subject to the local market conditions. Temporary solutions have been found in the past, but a permanent solution between supplier and user is not possible unless the user is able to supply and support it not necessarily a local market.

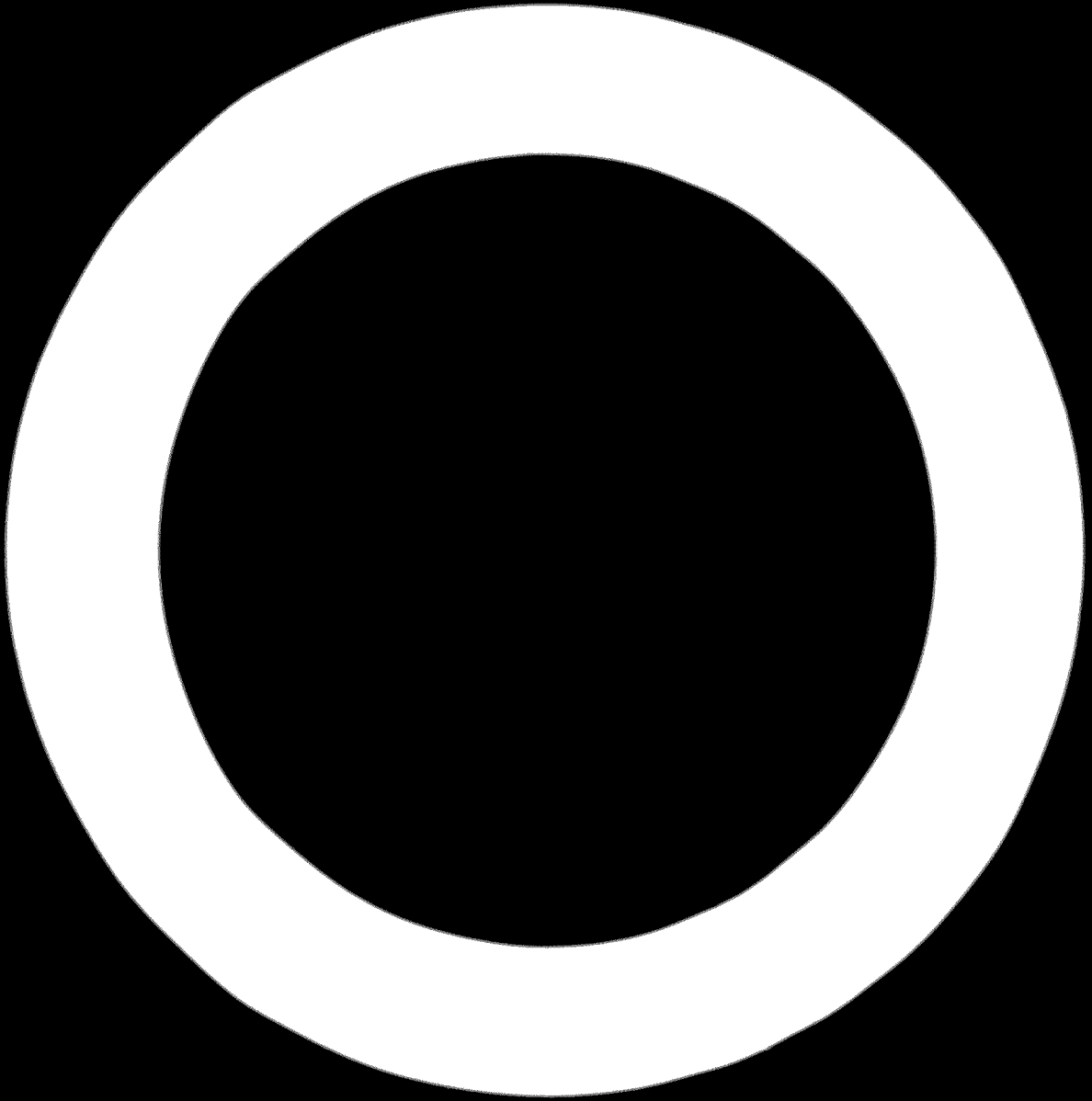

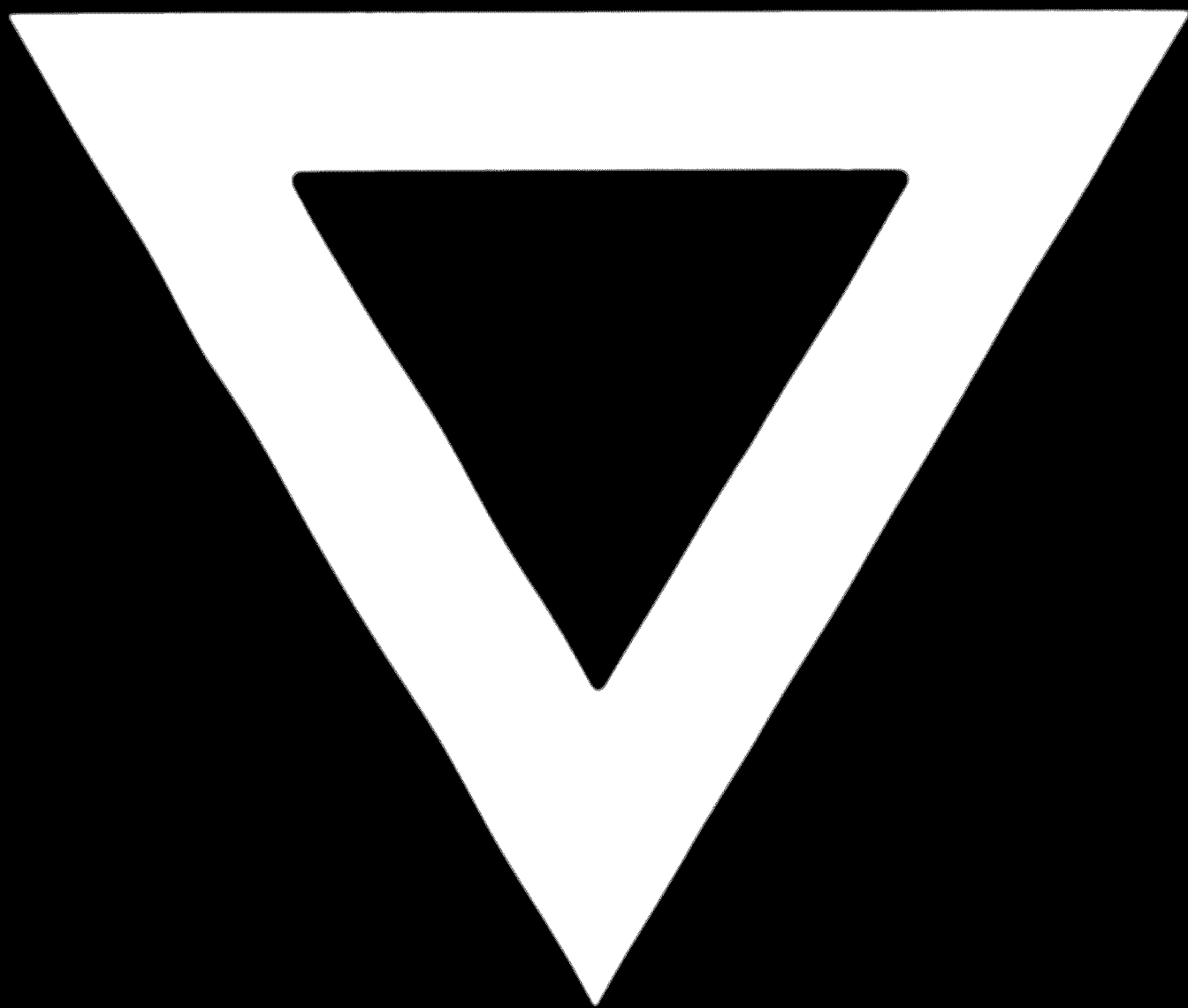
