


SUGGESTIONS FOR FOLLOW-UP ACTION 1

- On co-operation between Industrial Development Banks of both the industrialized and developing countries and the participants at this Meeting wished that it should be as informal as possible in order to insure an efficient co-operation between development banks on a concrete and specific basis to be directly discussed by them.
- II. The deliberations showed the need to insure that this co-operation be continued on a more regular basis. There was an exchange of ideas on the subject and a number of successions were made. Among these, the convening of a second Neeting next year received general agreement. Participants appreciated particularly the individual contacts and they expressed the wish that for the next Neeting, more time to devoted to these contacts. They also called for wider participation at the next Neeting. To meet these requirements it was suggested that UNIDO, in collaboration with the World Bank to assisted in the preparation for the mext Neeting to a number of participants designated in their personal expacity by the Neeting.
- III. Further suggestions were made relarding the establishment of certain settings up or procedures in order to develop interbank co-operation in the exchange of information and experience. There was unanimous agreement as to the need to develop such co-operation but time did not permit the examination in detail of the suggestions made. The wish was therefore expressed that the same group as mentioned in paragraph II should study the matter more thoroughly and propose possible solutions for consideration during the next Neeting.
