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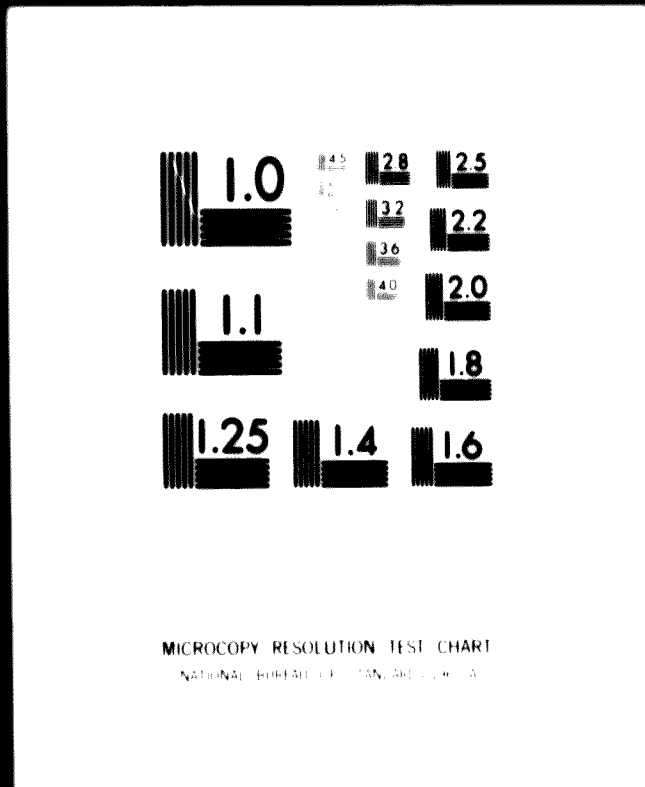

ANIMAL FEED

I. THE PROJECT

It is proposed to establish a plant producing 5 tons per hour of animal feedstuff. The estimated total investment is US \$2,074,900. The plant will be located at El Ab ar, Benghazi. The project is important in so far as it will provide employment, contribute to the diversification and development of the economy and facilitate the utilisation of some local raw materials.

All imported machinery and equipment will be exempt from tax.

II. COMMERCIAL ASPECTS

At present most of the requirements are imported. The local consumption is about 40,000 tons per annum of which 15,000 tons are produced locally.

The landed price of imported feedstuff is US \$121.5-148.5 per ton. The proposed price for locally produced feedstuff is US \$140.4 per ton.

III. PHYSICAL ASPECTS

a) Productive Capacity

It is proposed that the plant should have a capacity of 5 tons per hour.

b) Land and Buildings

22,500 square metres of land will be required for the project.

c) Labour Force

The project will require 40 persons including 5 skilled (engineers, technicians, etc.) and the rest unskilled.

d) Facilities

Harbour, roads, water, electricity are all available.

e) Raw Materials

Dates, sodium carbonate, calcium carbonate and fish meal are available locally. Other raw materials will be imported.

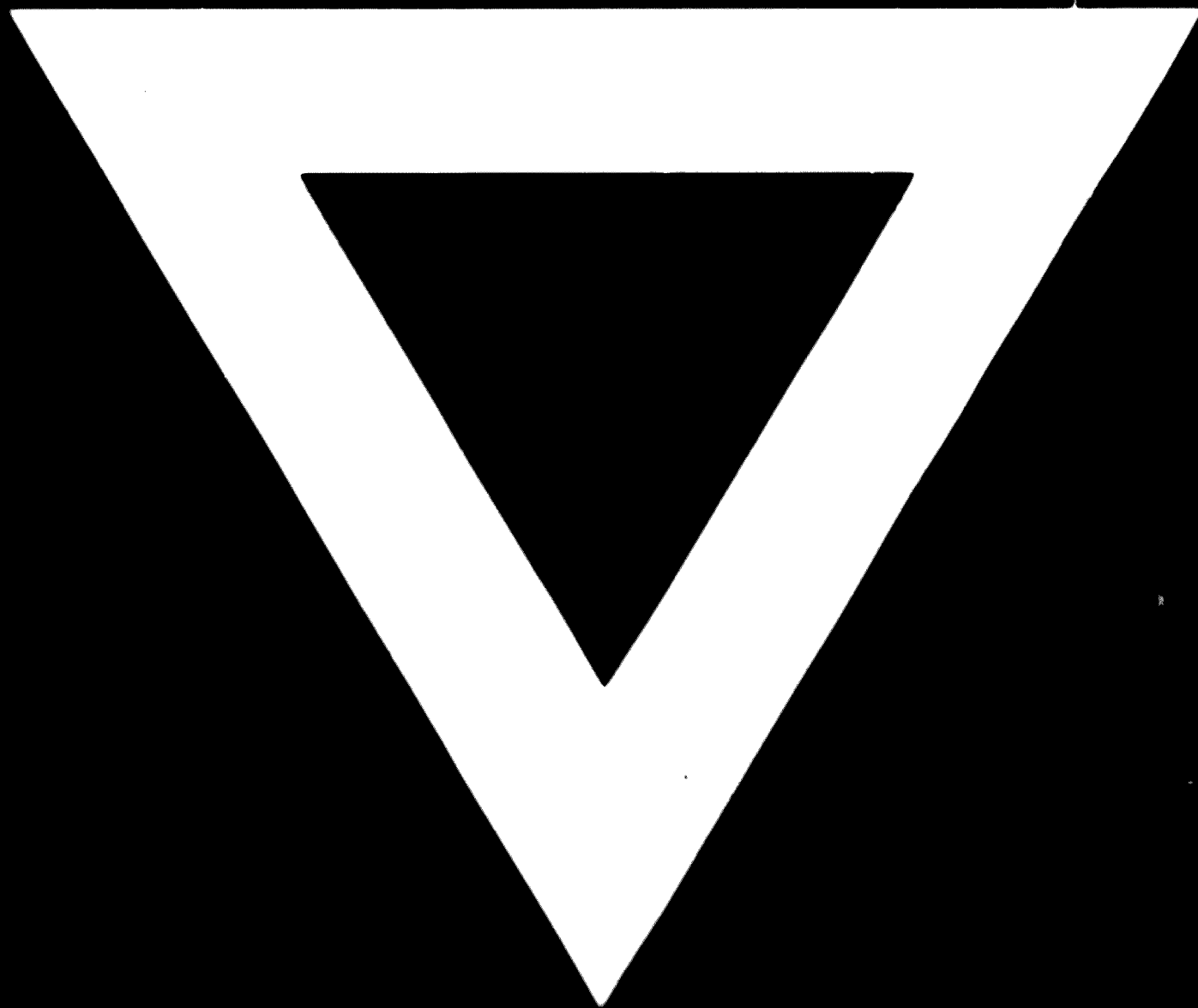
