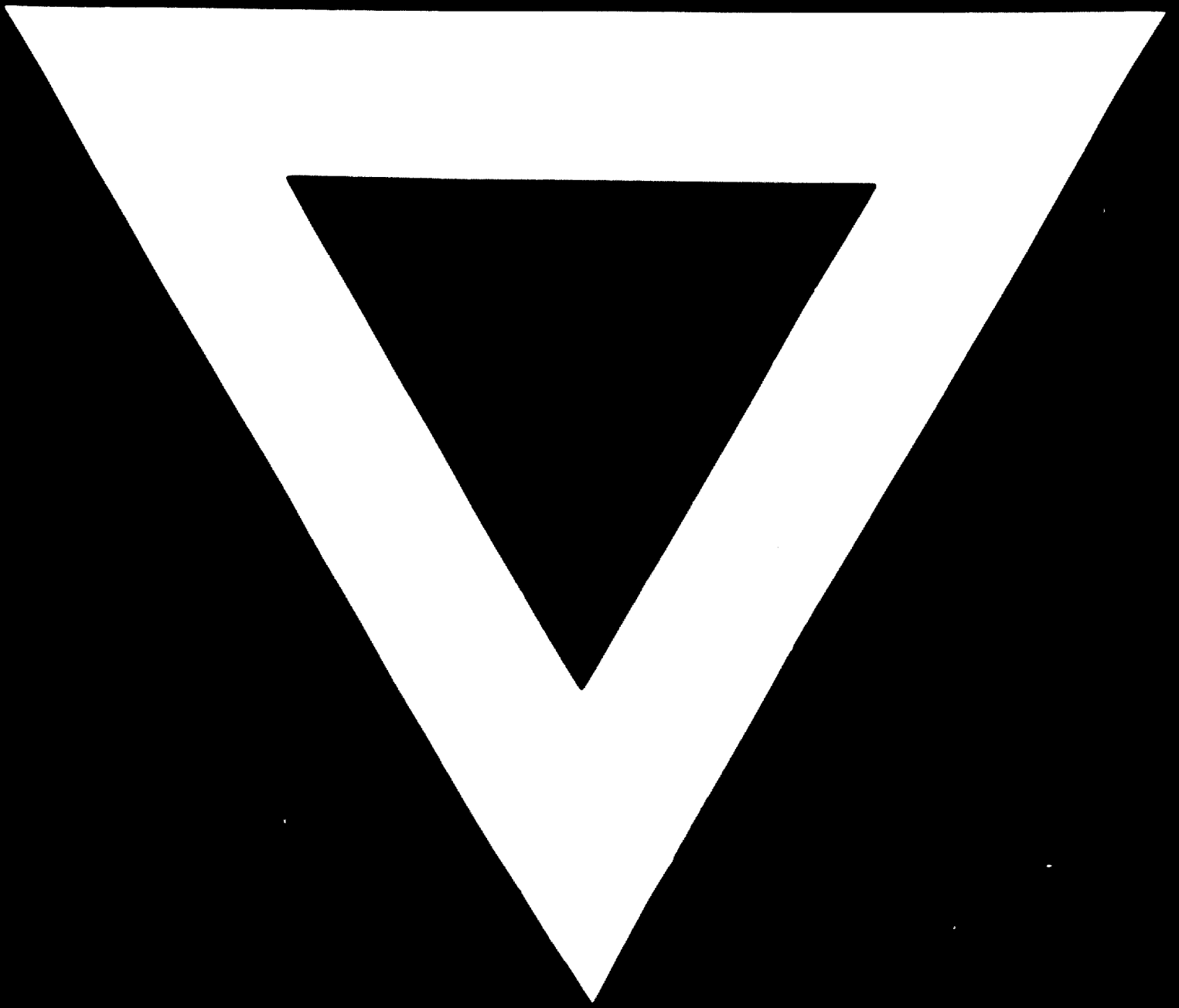

Review of the lists of States contained in the annex to General Assembly
Resolution 2152 (XXI), under which UNIDO was established

1. According to the last sentence of section II, paragraph 4, of General Assembly resolution 2152 (XXI),^{1/} under which the United Nations Industrial Development Organization was established, "the lists of States contained in the annex shall be reviewed by the Board in the light of changes in the membership of the United Nations or of the specialized agencies or of the International Atomic Energy Agency".
2. Since the last session of the Industrial Development Board, the People's Republic of Southern Yemen has become a Member of the United Nations.
3. The Board will doubtless therefore wish to decide to include the People's Republic of Southern Yemen in list A appearing in the annex to the above-mentioned resolution.
