

PLASTIC ROOFING AND AWNINGS


The project proponent, C.V. Deli Djaja, Plastic Industries and Trading Company, Jl. K.L. Jos Sudarso, started production of plastic bags, hoses, pipes, ropes, cups for latex and household wares, based upon the raw materials P.V.C. and polypropylene.

The production facilities available are for a capacity of 1,200 tons per annum. Now the Company works at 80% capacity.

The project proponent is interested to discuss with foreign companies the possibility of expansion and diversification of his production lines. His present thinking includes, as product ideas, plastic roofing, awnings and plastic parts for the radio and TV set industry.

The project proponent is prepared to discuss details with investors from advanced countries during the course of the Kuala Lumpur Investment Promotion Meeting.
