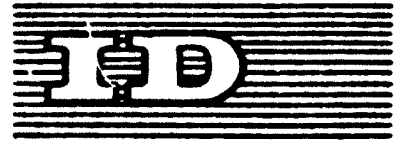

12 (II) Establishment of a working group on programme and co-ordination as a subsidiary organ of the Board

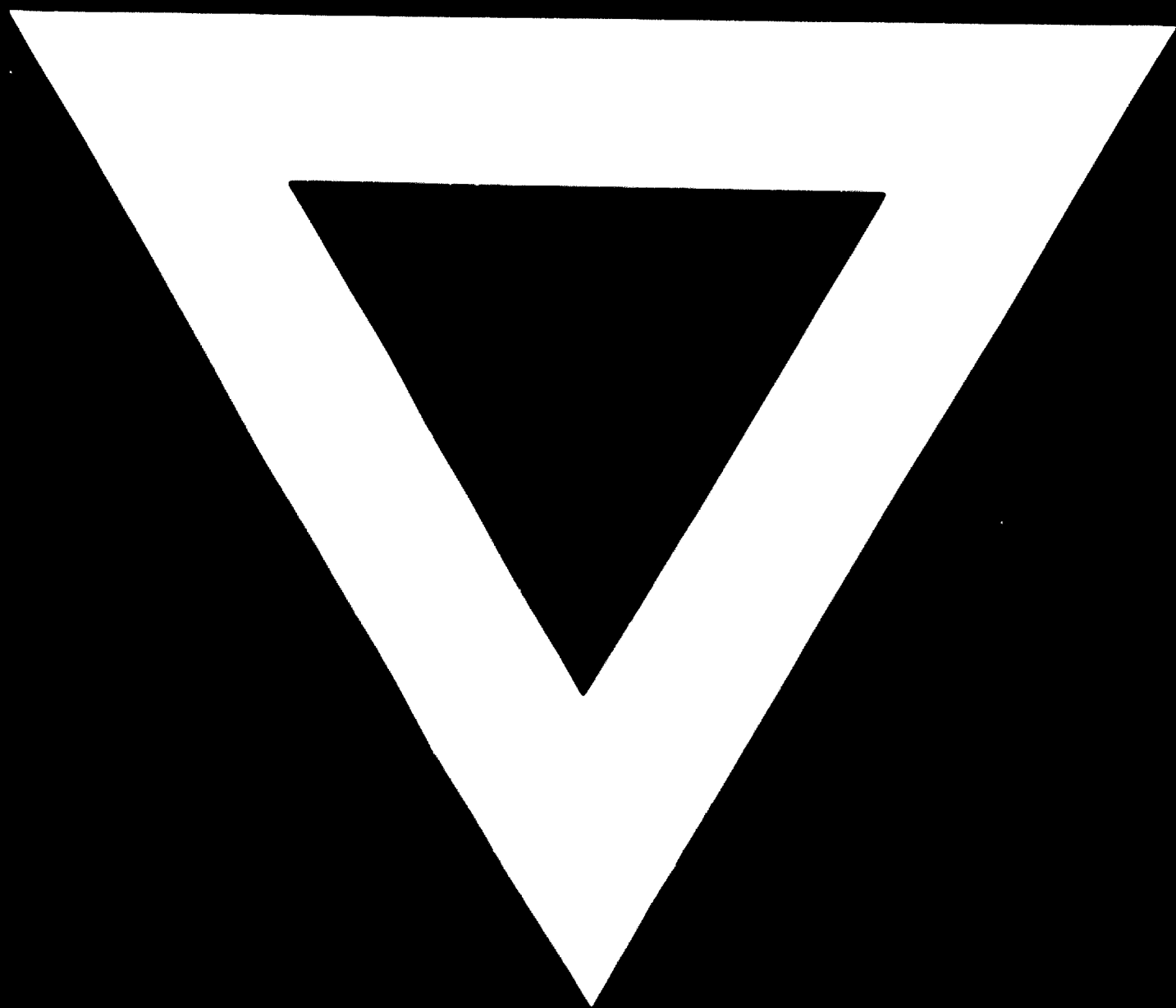
The Industrial Development Board,
