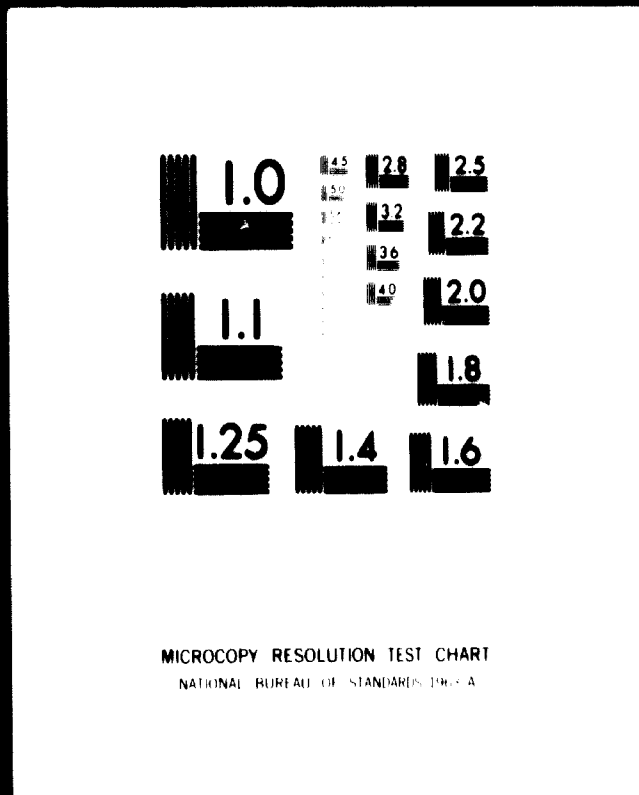

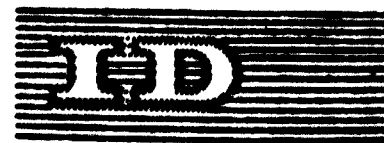

BOLTS, NUTS AND SCREWS, ETC.

I. THE PROJECT

The proponents wish to establish a new plant for the manufacture of bolts, nuts and screws. The installed annual capacity of the factory will be 2,000 tons of bolts, nuts, screws, etc. It is, however, anticipated that the production programme will be phased starting with about 400 tons in the first year and doubling the production in each subsequent year until full production is reached in the 4th year. The estimated total investment is US\$1,634,000.

This project is included in the country's Five Year Development Plan.

II. COMMERCIAL ASPECTS

At present, the proposed products of the project are imported. Locally manufactured bolts, nuts and screws, etc. will therefore be destined for domestic consumption. It is proposed that a detailed feasibility study be conducted jointly by the local promoter and the potential foreign collaborator.

III. PHYSICAL ASPECTS

The exact site has not yet been decided upon, but it is likely to be in one of Dacca's industrial areas where all the infrastructure and utilities already exist.

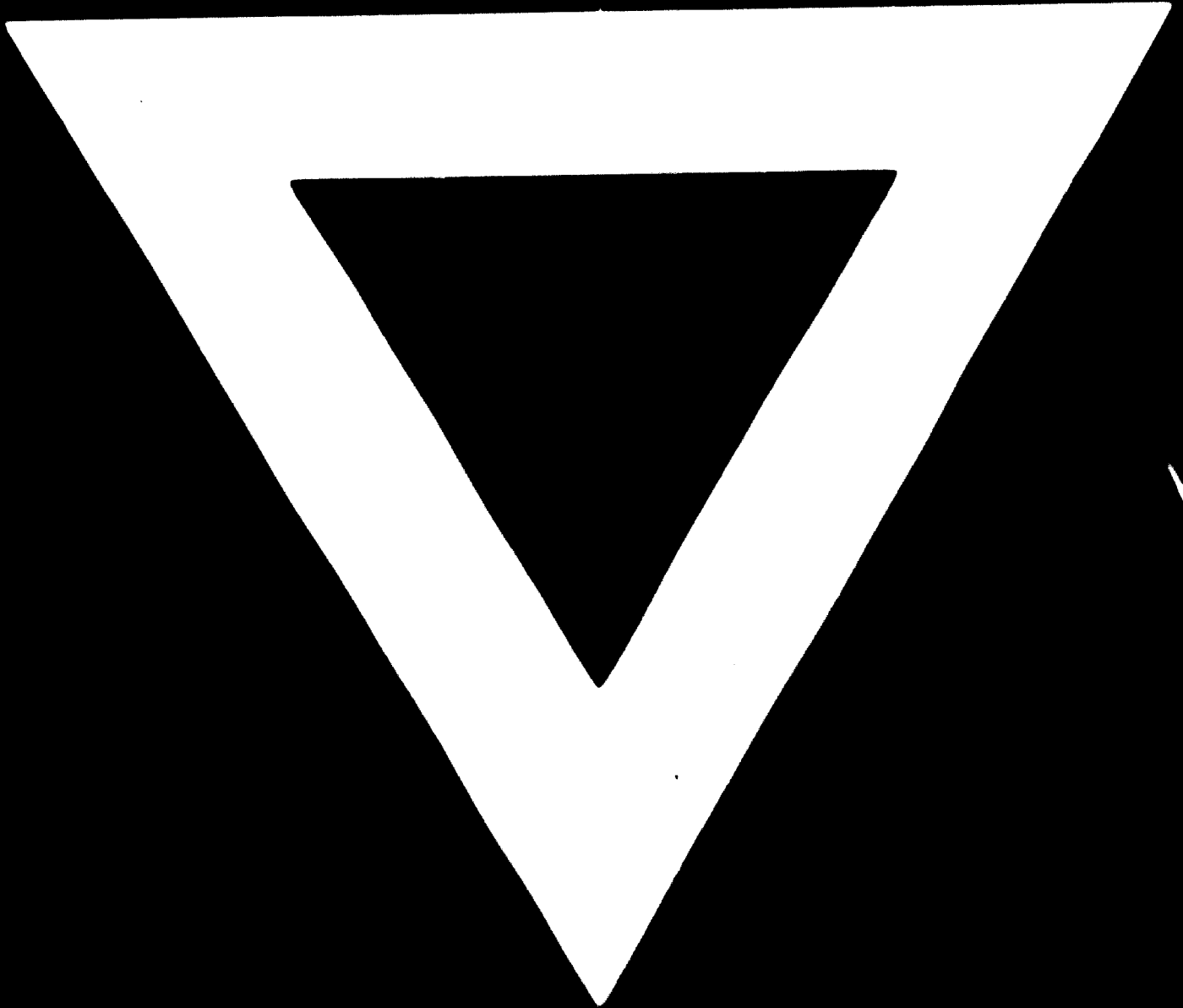
