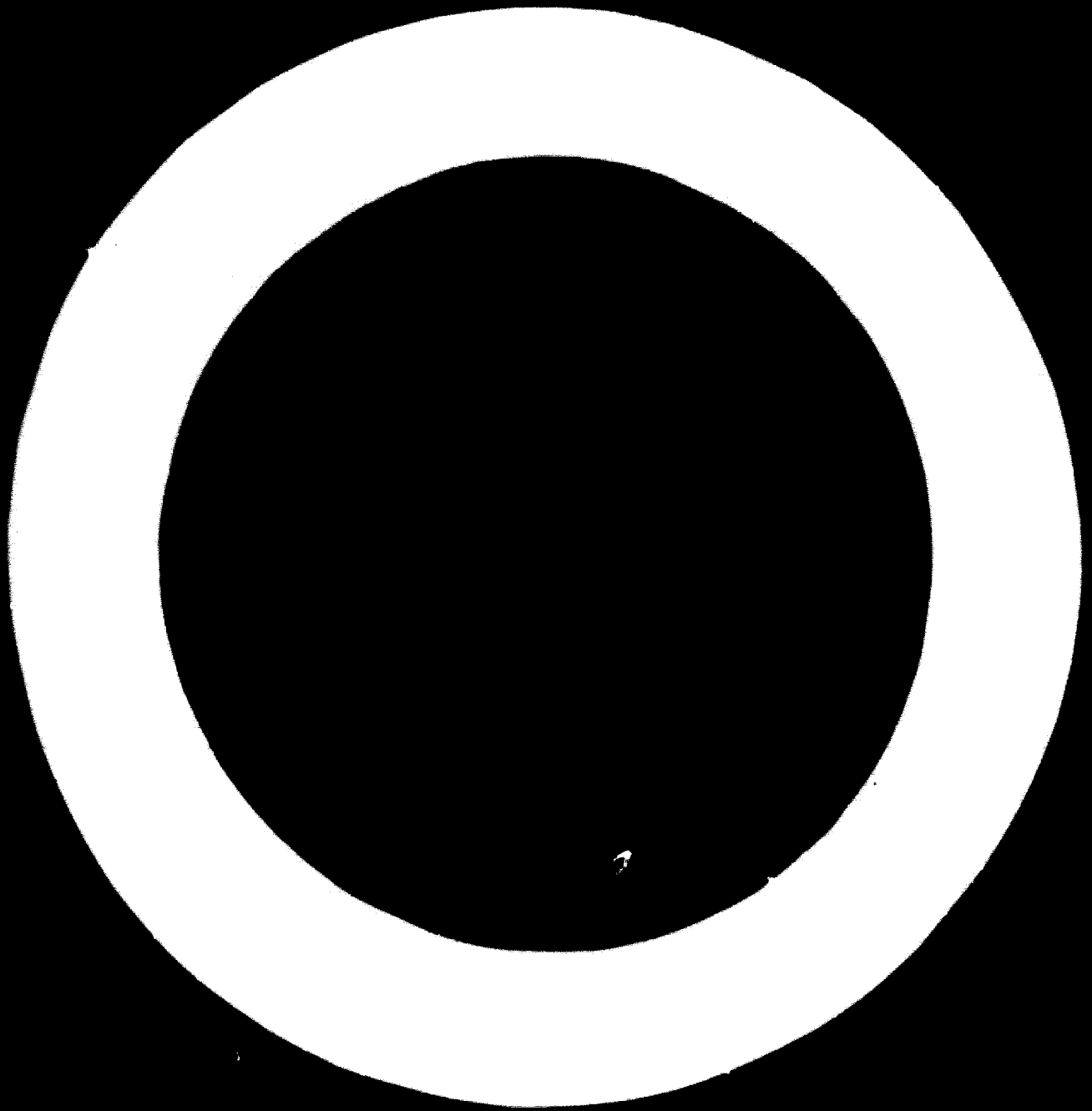

TOUR PROGRAMME

The Machine Tool Building and Toolmaking Association of the Peoples Republic of Bulgaria is responsible for research, design and production of various kinds of machine tools, including metal-cutting and wood-working machines, forging machines and presses, foundry equipment, various kinds of tools, dies, jigs and fixtures. The Association combines thirty-two plants, two research institutes and technical schools for the training of skilled personnel.

To observe the production and utilization of machines under workshop conditions with a view to studying the experience gained in the creation and development of the machine tool industry in Bulgaria, visits to a number of plants will be made. The Tour Programme also includes visits to some famous Bulgarian resorts.

Visit to the ZDM machine tool manufacturing plant in Sofia.

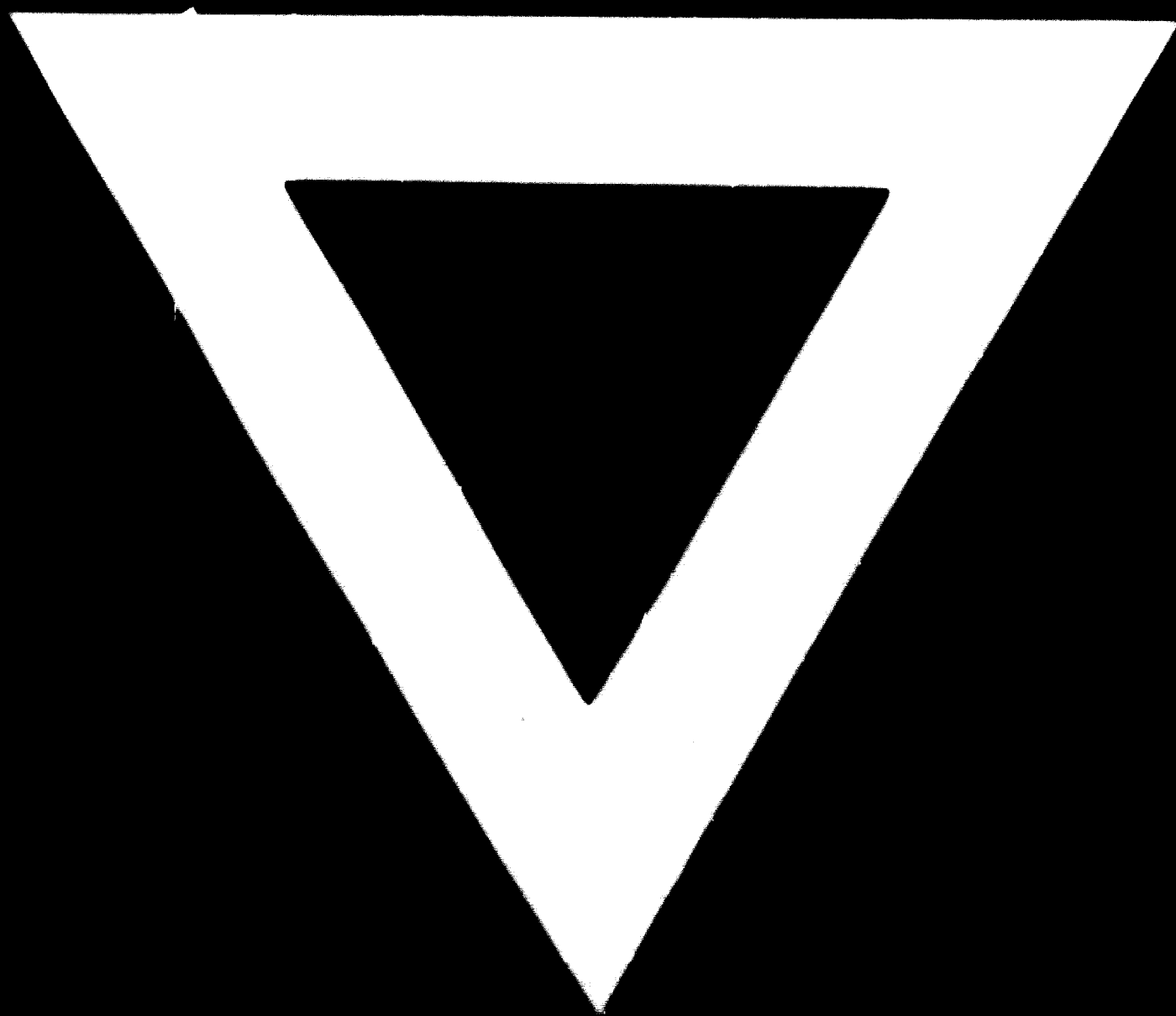
Following the plant visit a plenary meeting will be held to review the plant visits made.
