ANNOTATIONS TO THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

Item 1. Opening of the Session

Paragraph 12 of General Assembly resolution 2152 (XXI) provides that the Board shall elect its President, three Vice-Presidents and a Rapporteur to hold office for a period of one year. It also provides that in electing its officers, the Board shall pay due regard to the principle of equitable geographical representation.

Item 3. Adoption of the Agenda

The Provisional Agenda for the session was drawn up in accordance with the provisions of General Assembly resolution 2152 (XXI).

Item 4. Adoption of the Draft Rules of Procedure

The Board will have before it a report containing draft rules of procedure for its consideration (document ID/B/2).

Item 5. <u>Activities of the United Nations System of Organizations in the Field</u> of Industrial Development

In compliance with paragraph 42 of General Assembly resolution 2152 (XXI) and with the provisions of Economic and Social Council resolutions 1081 D (XXXIX) and 1181 (XLI), the Board will have before it the second annual report on the activities of the United Nations system of organizations in the field of industrial

Faragraph 27 of General Assembly resolution (15) (XXI) provides that "the Organization shall play the central role in and ke responsible for reviewing and promoting the co-ordination of all activities or the United Nations system in the field of industrial development". Faragraphs 29 through 36 deal further with the question of co-ordination and co-operation with United Nations bodies and other organizations.

Item 6. Report on Activities and Programme of Work of UNIDO

In compliance with the requirements of paragraph 42 of General Assembly resolution 2152 (XXI), the Board will have before it a report by the Executive Director on the activities and programme of work of UNIDO (document ID/B/4), covering the following fields:

- (a) Industrialization surveys and policies, including industrial financing
- (b) Industrial programming and project formulation

In addition to the keport, the following papers prepared for the International Symposium on Industrial Development may be available in draft form to the Board for background information:

Implementation and Follow-up of Industrial Projects

(c) Industrial location and regional development

In addition to the Report, a draft paper on industrial location planning, prepared for the International Symposium on Industrial Development, may be available to the Foard for background information.

(d) Development of export-oriented industries

The Foard will also have before it a progress report on steps taken by developing countries to develop and establish export-oriented industries (document $1D_{/}B/B$), which has been prepared in response to resolution 1178 (XLI) of the Economic and Social Council, and a report of a joint UNIFO/U₋₁CTAD meeting of experts on United Nations technical assistance relating to exports of manufactures and semi-manufactures from developing countries (document ID/B/11).
