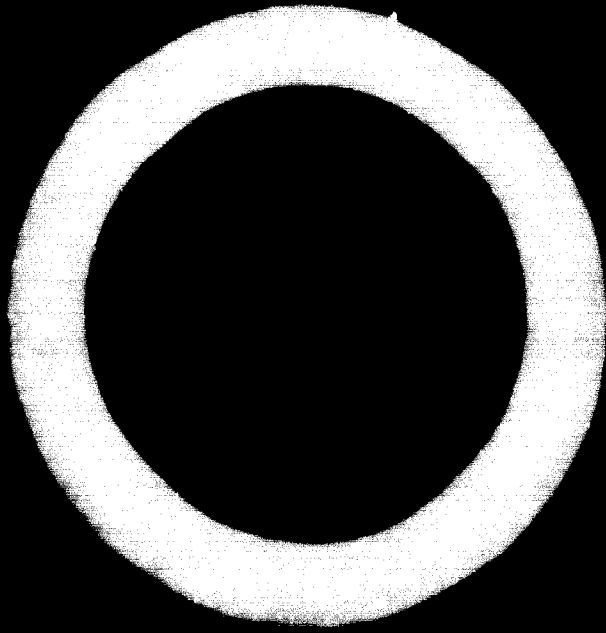

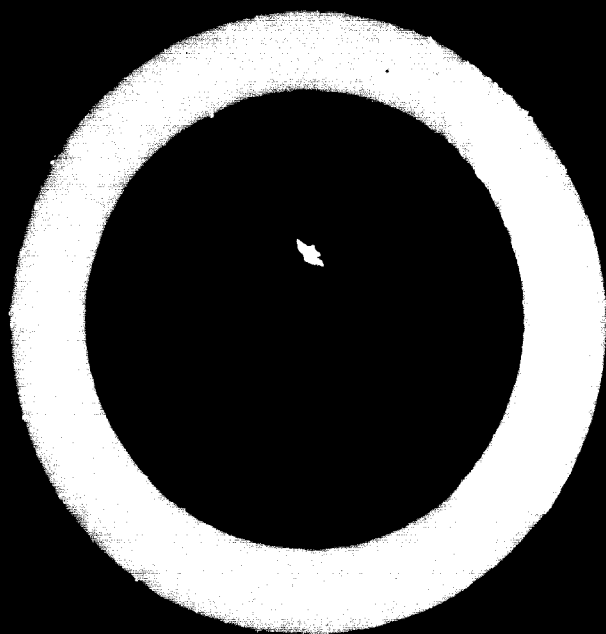

INTRODUCTION

The United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) promotes the use of industrial information in developing countries by guiding the organizations involved in the improvement of local information facilities. One of the means of achieving this is the compilation of directories and guides to basic information sources.

The UNIDO work programmes for 1972-1974 include the compilation of a series of directories and guides, listing selected information sources on branches of industry of primary concern to developing countries. The present guide is the ninth in the series entitled UNIDO Guides to Information Sources (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). A list of the guides published to date appears inside the back cover of this guide; many more are planned for the series.

The directories and guides are not intended to be exhaustive, nor are they intended as research tools; rather, they present a selection of sources that are considered to be of practical value to users. The data have been compiled so as to facilitate rapid access to the bodies referred to and the acquisition of the publications listed.

The manufacture of building boards from wood or other fibrous materials, which is the subject of the present issue, has great potential as a new industry in the developing countries. Many developing countries possess large forest resources and could readily manufacture wood panels both for domestic consumption and for exportation, instead of exporting unprocessed logs, as most of them do at present. Even those countries that do not possess vast forests could establish a building board industry by utilizing agricultural residues. UNIDO has helped developing countries to establish and improve such industries.

Suggestions for the inclusion of additional information in a future, revised version would be appreciated.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Publications have been selected mainly from literature in the official languages of the United Nations; when appropriate, publications in other languages have also been included.

The names of organizations listed in section I are given in their original language, wherever available; the names of organizations appearing in languages other than the official languages of the United Nations have been translated into English.

INTRODUCTION

Pour faciliter la diffusion et l'utilisation de l'information industrielle dans les pays en voie de développement, l'Organisation des Nations Unies pour le développement industriel (ONUDI) conseille les organismes qui s'occupent d'améliorer les moyens d'information locaux, notamment en établissant des répertoires et des guides des principales sources d'information.

Les programmes de travail de l'ONUDI pour 1972-1974 prévoient l'établissement d'une série de répertoires et de guides de sources d'information sur les secteurs industriels qui présentent un intérêt majeur pour les pays en voie de développement. Le présent répertoire est le neuvième de la série intitulée : Guides des sources d'information (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). On trouvera à la page 3 de la couverture la liste des guides déjà parus. De nombreux autres seront publiés par la suite.

Les ouvrages de cette série ne prétendent pas être exhaustifs; ce ne sont pas non plus des instruments de recherche, mais de simples guides des sources d'information que l'on estime être d'un intérêt pratique pour les utilisateurs. Les données ont été présentées de façon à faciliter et accélérer l'accès aux organismes cités et l'acquisition des publications mentionnées.

Le présent volume est consacré à la fabrication de panneaux de construction dérivés du bois ou d'autres matières fibreuses, qui offre d'intéressantes perspectives pour le développement d'une industrie nouvelle dans les pays en voie de développement. De nombreux pays en voie de développement possèdent d'importantes ressources forestières et pourraient facilement fabriquer des panneaux dérivés du bois pour leur propre usage comme pour l'exportation, au lieu d'exporter des grumes non transformées, comme c'est le cas aujourd'hui. Même les pays qui ne possèdent pas de grandes forêts pourraient entreprendre la fabrication de panneaux de construction à base de déchets agricoles. L'ONUDI a déjà aidé des pays en voie de développement à organiser et améliorer ce type de production. Toute suggestion de renseignements complémentaires éventuellement à insérer dans une future édition révisée sera la bienvenue.

Les publications énumérées sont pour la plupart rédigées dans les langues officielles de l'Organisation des Nations Unies; toutefois, certains documents publiés en d'autres langues ont aussi été mentionnés.

ВВЕДЕНИЕ

Организация Объединенных Наций по промышленному развитию (ЮНИДО) содействует использованию промышленной информации в развивающихся странах путем предоставления руководящих указаний в области улучшения местной службы информации организациям, занимающимся вопросами промышленного развития. Одной из важных мер такого рода деятельности является составление справочников и руководств по основным источникам информации.

Программа деятельности ЮНИДО на 1972-1974 гг. предусматривает составление целого ряда таких справочников и руководств, в которых перечисляются отдельные источники информации по отраслям промышленности, имеющим первостепенное значение для развивающихся стран. Настоящее руководство является девятым в серии, которая называется Guides to Information Sources (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). Список руководств, выпущенных до настоящего времени, приводится на внутренней стороне задней части обложки; для этой серии планируется выпуск еще целого ряда руководств.

Такие справочники и руководства не ставят своей целью быть исчерпывающими и не являются средствами исследования, а представляют собой скорее источники, которые, видимо, могут иметь практическую ценность для удовлетворения непосредственных нужд потребителей информации. Для облегчения пользования этими справочниками данные подобраны таким образом, чтобы дать как можно больше информации для обеспечения быстрой связи с организациями, на которые имеется ссылка, и облегчить приобретение перечисленных изданий.

Производство строительных плит из дерева и других волокнистых материалов, являясь предметом настоящего издания, как новая отрасль промышленности, имеет большие потенциальные возможности в развивающихся странах. Многие развивающиеся страны располагают крупными лесными ресурсами и могли бы быстро приступить к производству деревянных панелей как для внутреннего потребления, так и на экспорт вместо того, чтобы экспортировать необработанный лес в виде бревен, как это делают в настоящее время большинство из них. Даже те страны, которые не располагают большим массивом лесов, могли бы создать промышленность по производству строительных плит из сельскохозяйственных отходов. ЮНИДО помогает развивающимся странам в деле создания и совершенствования таких отраслей промышленности.

Предложения по включению дополнительной информации в пересмотренный вариант в будущем будут вслестски приветствоваться.

INTRODUCCION

La Organización de las Naciones Unidas para el Desarrollo Industrial (ONUDI) promueve la utilización de información industrial en los países en desarrollo, proporcionando orientación a las organizaciones que se ocupan de mejorar los servicios locales de información. Uno de los medios para lograr este objetivo es la compilación de repertorios y guías de fuentes básicas de información.

Los programas de trabajo de la ONUDI para 1972-1974 incluyen la compilación de una serie de repertorios y guías de este tipo, en que se registren determinadas fuentes de información sobre ramas industriales de interés primordial para los países en desarrollo. La presente guía es la novena de la serie titulada Guías de Fuentes de Información (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). En el interior de la contracubierta figura una lista de las guías publicadas hasta la fecha. Se prevé la publicación de muchas más en esta serie.

Estos repertorios y guías no pretenden ser exhaustivos ni están destinados a servir de instrumentos de investigación, sino que presentan más bien una selección de fuentes que se consideran de valor práctico para los usuarios. Los datos se han recopilado de manera que proporcionen un rápido acceso a las entidades mencionadas y para facilitar la adquisición de las publicaciones que se indican.

La fabricación de tableros de construcción a base de madera o de otros materiales fibrosos, tema a que se refiere este número, tiene un gran potencial como industria nueva en los países en desarrollo. Muchos de éstos poseen grandes recursos forestales y podrían fácilmente fabricar tableros de madera, tanto para el consumo interno como para la exportación, en lugar de exportar troncos sin elaborar, como lo hacen la mayoría de ellos en la actualidad. Aun los países que no poseen grandes recursos forestales podrían establecer una industria de tableros de construcción, utilizando residuos agrícolas. La ONUDI ha ayudado a diversos países en desarrollo a establecer y mejorar dichas industrias.

Se agradecerá el envío de sugerencias para la inclusión de información adicional en una futura versión revisada.
