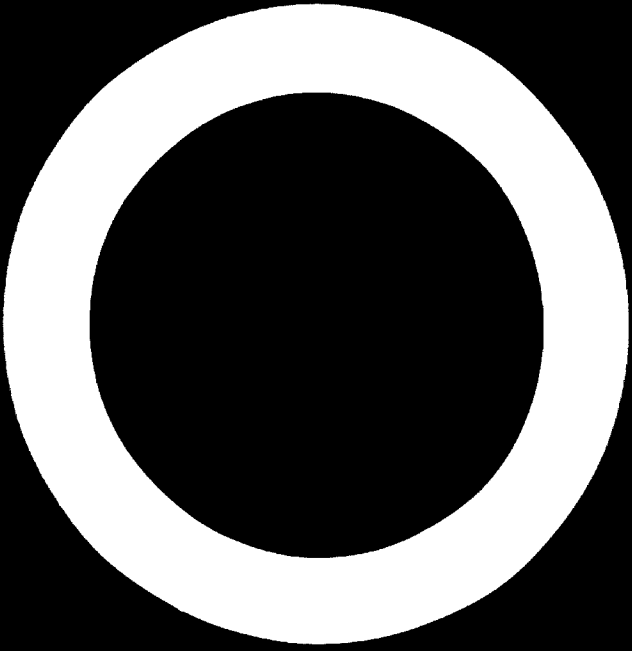
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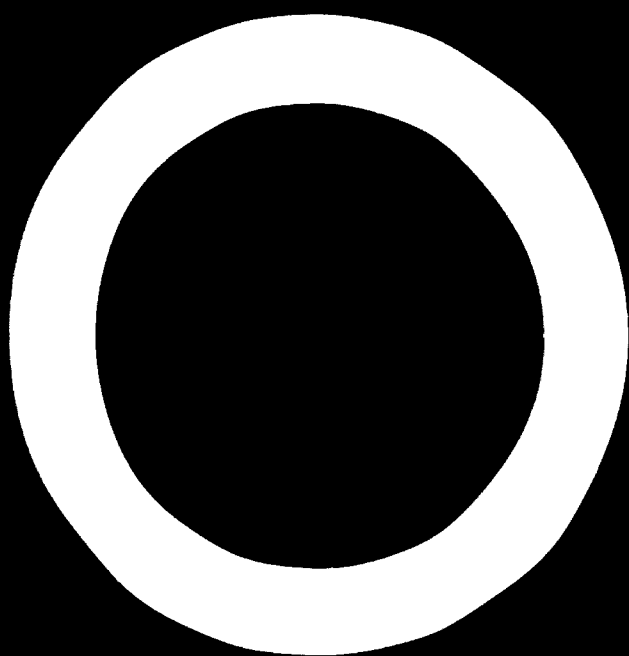

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INTRODUCTION

The United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) promotes the use of industrial information in developing countries by giving guidance in improving local information facilities. As one of the means of promotion UNIDO compiles directories and guides to selected information sources on branches of industry of primary concern to developing countries. The present guide, dealing with the non-alcoholic beverage industry, is the fifteenth in the series of UNIDO Guides to Information Sources (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). A list of the guides published to date appears inside the back cover of this guide; many more guides are planned for the series.

The directories and guides are not intended to be exhaustive, nor are they intended as research tools; rather, they present sources considered to be of practical value to users. The data have been compiled so as to facilitate rapid access to the bodies referred to and the acquisition of the publications listed.

The manufacture of non-alcoholic beverages is a common activity in many developing countries, particularly in regions with tropical or temperate climates.

Non-alcoholic beverages have been defined in this guide as fruit juices, carbonated beverages and mineral waters. Fruit juices are included since they are often used as basic materials for many carbonated beverages. Non-alcoholic beverages based on dairy products have been omitted.

UNIDO assists developing countries in establishing non-alcoholic beverage industries and in improving existing ones.

INTRODUCTION

Pour faciliter la diffusion et l'utilisation de l'information industrielle dans les pays en voie de développement, l'Organisation des Nations Unies pour le développement industriel (ONUDI) aide ces pays à améliorer leurs moyens d'information, notamment en établissant des répertoires et des guides de certaines sources d'information sur les secteurs industriels qui présentent pour eux un intérêt majeur. Le présent guide, qui concerne l'industrie des boissons non alcooliques, est le quinzième de la série des Guides des sources d'information (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). On trouvera à la page 3 de la couverture la liste des guides déjà parus. De nombreux autres sont prévus.

Les ouvrages de cette série ne prétendent pas être exhaustifs; ce ne sont pas non plus des instruments de recherche, mais de simples guides des sources d'information, considérées comme présentant un intérêt pratique pour les utilisateurs. Les données sont présentées de manière à permettre à ceux-ci de se mettre rapidement en rapport avec les sources d'information mentionnées et d'obtenir les publications auxquelles ils s'intéressent.

La fabrication de boissons non alcooliques est une activité courante dans de nombreux pays en voie de développement, notamment dans les régions chaudes et tempérées.

Dans la présente publication, on entend par boissons non alcooliques les jus de fruits, les boissons gazeuses et les eaux minérales. On y a inclus les jus de fruits qui entrent souvent dans la composition de nombreuses boissons gazeuses; en revanche, les boissons non alcooliques à base de lait n'y figurent pas.

L'ONUDI aide les pays en voie de développement à se doter d'une industrie des boissons non alcooliques ou à améliorer leurs installations.

В данном руководстве группа безалкогольных напитков включает фруктовые соки, газированные напитки и минеральные воды. Фруктовые соки включены в их число, так как они часто используются в качестве основного материала для производства многих газированных напитков. Безалкогольные напитки, основанные на молочных продуктах, исключены.

ЮНИДО оказывает помощь развивающимся странам в создании предприятий по производству безалкогольных напитков и усовершенствовании существующих предприятий.

INTRODUCCION

La Organización de las Naciones Unidas para el Desarrollo Industrial (ONUDI) promueve la utilización de información industrial en los países en desarrollo proporcionando orientación para el mejoramiento de los servicios locales de información. Uno de los medios de promoción que emplea la ONUDI consiste en compilar guías de fuentes básicas de información sobre ramas de la industria de especial interés para los países en desarrollo. La presente guía, que trata de la industria de bebidas no alcohólicas, es la decimoquinta de la serie Guías de Fuentes de Información (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D) que publica la ONUDI. La lista de las guías publicadas hasta la fecha figura en el anverso de la contratapa de la presente guía; se prevé la publicación de muchas guías más en esta serie.

Estas guías no pretenden ser exhaustivas ni están destinadas a servir de instrumento de investigación; presentan, más bien, una selección de fuentes que se consideran de valor práctico para los usuarios. Los datos se han recopilado de modo tal que faciliten el rápido acceso a las entidades mencionadas y la adquisición de las publicaciones que se indican.

La fabricación de bebidas no alcohólicas es una actividad corriente en muchos países en desarrollo, especialmente en regiones de climas cálido o templado.

En la presente guía se definen las bebidas no alcohólicas como zumos de fruta, bebidas carbónicas y aguas minerales. Se han incluido los zumos de fruta porque se utilizan a menudo como material de partida para muchas bebidas carbónicas. Se han omitido las bebidas no alcohólicas basadas en productos lácteos.

La ONUDI presta asistencia a países en desarrollo para establecer nuevas industrias de bebidas no alcohólicas y para mejorar las existentes.

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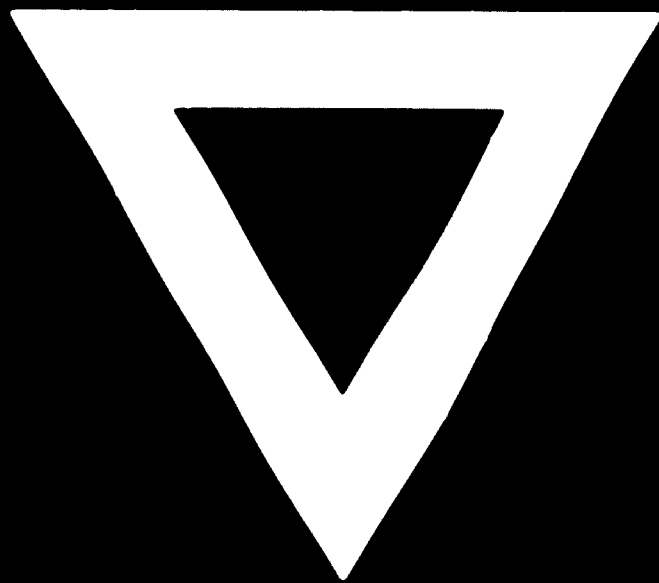
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
