



INTRODUCTION

The United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) promotes the use of industrial information in developing countries by giving guidance in improving local information facilities. As one of the means of promotion UNIDO compiles directories and guides to selected information sources on branches of industry of primary concern to developing countries. The present guide, dealing with the glass industry, is the sixteenth in the series of UNIDO Guides to Information Sources (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). A list of the guides published to date appears inside the back cover of this guide; more are planned for the series.

The directories and guides are not intended to be exhaustive, nor are they intended to be research tools; rather, they present sources considered to be of practical value to users. The data have been compiled so as to facilitate rapid access to the bodies referred to and the acquisition of the publications listed.

The manufacture of glass articles, such as sheet glass, bottles and containers, domestic glassware and glass fibres, has a great potential as a new industry in developing countries. The demand for glass products is rapidly increasing and in those countries where no glass industry has been established is now being met by imports. However, the basic raw materials for the industry, namely silica sand, soda ash and limestone, are available in many developing countries, and considerable foreign-exchange savings could be achieved through their industrial exploitation. UNIDO has assisted developing countries in establishing glass industries and has also, in a number of cases, advised existing glass-works on the expansion or diversification of their production.

In view of the basic differences in raw materials and technology between the glass industry and the ceramic industry, the latter will be treated in a separate issue of Guides to Information Sources to which interested readers are referred.

INTRODUCTION

Pour faciliter la diffusion et l'utilisation de l'information industrielle dans les pays en voie de développement, l'Organisation des Nations Unies pour le développement industriel (ONUDI) aide ces pays à améliorer leurs moyens d'information, notamment en établissant des répertoires et des guides des principales sources d'information sur les secteurs industriels qui présentent pour eux un intérêt majeur. Le présent guide, qui concerne l'industrie du verre, est le seizième de la série des Guides des sources d'information (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). On trouvera à la page 3 de la couverture la liste des guides déjà parus. D'autres sont prévus.

Les ouvrages de cette série ne prétendent pas être exhaustifs; ce ne sont pas non plus des instruments de recherche, mais de simples guides des sources d'information considérées comme présentant un intérêt pratique pour les utilisateurs. Les données sont présentées de manière à permettre à ceux-ci de se mettre rapidement en rapport avec les sources d'information mentionnées et d'obtenir les publications auxquelles ils s'intéressent.

La manufacture des articles en verre, notamment du verre plat, des bouteilles et flacons, de la verrerie de ménage et des fibres de verre, offre, en tant qu'industrie nouvelle, des perspectives prometteuses dans les pays en voie de développement. La demande de produits en verre augmente rapidement et les pays qui n'en fabriquent pas ont actuellement recours aux importations. Cependant, de nombreux pays en voie de développement possèdent les matières premières de base qu'utilise l'industrie, c'est-à-dire des sables quartzeux, des cendres de soude et de la pierre calcaire, dont l'exploitation industrielle permettrait de réaliser des économies de devises considérables. L'ONUDI a aidé des pays en voie de développement à créer des industries du verre et a, en outre, dans certains cas, donné à des verreries des conseils sur le développement et la diversification de leur production.

En raison des différences fondamentales - quant aux matières premières et à la technologie - qui existent entre l'industrie du verre et l'industrie de la céramique, cette dernière sera l'objet d'un numéro distinct des guides des sources d'information auquel nous renvoyons les lecteurs que cette question intéresse.

ВВЕДЕНИЕ

Организация Объединенных Наций по промышленному развитию (ЮНИДО) содействует использованию промышленной информации в развивающихся странах путем осуществления руководства в деле улучшения местных средств информации. Одним из средств содействия развитию является составление в ЮНИДО справочников и руководств к отдельным источникам информации по отраслям промышленности, имеющим первостепенное значение для развивающихся стран. Настоящее руководство по стекольной промышленности является шестнадцатым в серии UNIDO Guides to Information Sources (UNIDO/LIB/349.D). Перечень руководств, выпущенных до настоящего времени, приводится на третьей странице обложки настоящего руководства; по этой серии планируется выпуск еще целого ряда руководств.

Такие справочники и руководства не ставят своей целью быть исчерпывающими или служить в качестве средств исследования; в них скорее представлены источники, которые рассматриваются как имеющие практическую ценность для тех, кто ими пользуется. Данные в этих справочниках подобраны таким образом, чтобы облегчить как доступ к получению информации в тех организациях, на которые имеется ссылка, так и приобретение перечисленных изданий.

Производство изделий из стекла таких, как листовое стекло, бутылки и стеклянные сосуды, бытовые стеклянные изделия и стекловолокно в качестве новой отрасли промышленности открывает для развивающихся стран большие возможности. Спрос на изделия из стекла быстро растет, и в странах, не имеющих стекольной промышленности, он обеспечивается в настоящее время за счет импорта. Однако основные виды сырьевых материалов для данной отрасли промышленности, такие, как кремниевый песок, кальцинированная сода и известняк, имеются во многих развивающихся странах, и при их промышленном использовании можно сделать значительные накопления иностранной валюты. ЮНИДО продолжает оказывать развивающимся странам помощь в создании стекольных предприятий, а также в ряде случаев предоставляла консультации имеющимся стекольным заводам по вопросам расширения или диверсификации их продукции.

Ввиду того, что существуют значительные различия в использовании сырьевых материалов и в технологиях в стекольной и в керамической промышленности, последняя будет рассматриваться в отдельном выпуске Guides to Information Sources, к которому мы отсылаем всех заинтересованных читателей.

INTRODUCCION

La Organización de las Naciones Unidas para el Desarrollo Industrial (ONUDI) promueve la utilización de información industrial en los países en desarrollo proporcionando orientación para el mejoramiento de los servicios locales de información. Uno de los medios de promoción que emplea la ONUDI consiste en compilar guías de fuentes seleccionadas de información sobre ramas de la industria de especial interés para los países en desarrollo. La presente guía, que trata de la industria del vidrio, es la decimosexta de la serie de Guías de Fuentes de Información (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D) que publica la ONUDI. La lista de las publicadas hasta la fecha figura en el anverso de la contratapa de la presente guía; se prevé la publicación de otras en esta misma serie.

Estas guías no pretenden ser exhaustivas ni están destinadas a servir de instrumentos de investigación; presentan, más bien, fuentes que se consideran de valor práctico para los usuarios. Los datos se han recompilado de modo tal que faciliten el rápido acceso a las entidades mencionadas y la adquisición de las publicaciones que se indican.

La fabricación de artículos de vidrio, tales como hojas de vidrio, botellas y frascos, artículos de uso doméstico y fibras de vidrio, ofrece grandes posibilidades como nueva industria en los países en desarrollo. La demanda de productos de vidrio aumenta rápidamente, y en los países que no tienen industrias del vidrio se satisface actualmente mediante las importaciones. Sin embargo, en muchos países en desarrollo se dispone de las materias primas básicas necesarias para esta industria, tales como arenas cuarzosas, cenizas de sosa y piedra caliza, y se conseguiría un notable ahorro de divisas mediante su aprovechamiento industrial. La ONUDI ha prestado asistencia a países en desarrollo para el establecimiento de industrias del vidrio, y ha asesorado también en varios casos a industrias del vidrio ya existentes para la expansión o diversificación de su producción.

En vista de las diferencias básicas que existen, en cuanto a materias primas y tecnología, entre la industria del vidrio y la industria cerámica, esta última se tratará en un número aparte de estas Guías de Fuentes de Información, al que se remite a los lectores interesados.


