A description of the organization of technical co-operation and the procedures for obtaining assistance from the United Nations. An outline of the types of projects and the types of assistance which may be made available in the field of small-scale industry development. The Annexes contain a number of typical job descriptions for expert missions and outlines of requests for assistance from the UNDP (Special Fund).

Small-scale Industry in Latin America, United Nations sales publication, New York, 1969, 323 pages.

This publication contains the "Report of the Seminar on Small-scale Industry in Latin America" held in Quito, Bouador, in 1966, four discussion papers and the summaries of four country monographs presented to the Seminar.

The Report (Part I) reviews the work of the Seminar and presents its findings and recommendations. It relates to the four main areas of discussion: the contribution of small-scale industry to industrialisation in Latin America, technical services and assistance for small-scale industry and regional and international co-operation in this field.

Part II contains a "Survey of Small-scale Industry in Latin America", prepared by the Seexetariat of the Bonomic Commission for Latin America (BCLA), which is an analytical review of the position of small-scale industries in the region. It discusses definitions of small-scale industry, its structure in various Latin American countries, and some of its major problems.

Part III, "Development Possibilities for Small-scale Industry in Specific Fields of Industrial Activity", by Alexander Heilson, describes some of the characteristics of different types of small-scale industries. The paper includes a listing of about 50 industrial fields in which small-scale industry is prevalent.

Part IV, "Industrial Estate Plans and Projects in Latin A orican Countries", by the United Mations Centre for Industrial Development (now the United Nations Industrial Development Organization), describes the status and plans of industrial estates and industrial areas in Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Ecuador, Jamaica, Mexico, the Netherlands Antilles, Micaragua, Panama, Peru, Puerto Rico, Trinidad and Tobage and Venezuela. Part V, "Evaluation of a Programme of Assistance to Small-scale Industry: the Case of Chile", by the Technical Co-operation Service of the Development Corporation of Chile, analyses the assistance provided by the Technical Co-operation Service (SCT) of the Development Corporation of Chile to small-scale industries and artisan undertakings in Chile from 1963 to 1966. It includes a cost-benefit analysis of the results achieved. The four summaries of country monographs, propared by the Secretariat of ECLA, focus on major aspects of small industry development: industrial programming (Ecuador), industrial financing (Mexico), technical assistance (Panama) and industrial zoning (Venezuela).

Small-scale Industry, Monograph No.11, United Mations sales publication, New York, 1969, 46 pages.

This monograph is one of twenty-one monographs on industrial development, based on the proceedings of the International Symposium on Industrial Development, Athens, Movember - Docember 1967. Monograph No.11 discusses the programmes, objectives and problems of small industry development. It reviews, among other things, Government objectives in promoting small-scale industries; modernisation of small-scale industries; transformation of artisans into small-scale industrialists; assistance programmes; co-ordination of services and facilities for small-scale industries: advisory services, training, terms of oredit, etc.

Amnex I outlines the areas in the field of small-scale industry in which UNIEO is in a position to provide technical assistance.

This publication contains the "Report of the Expert Group on the Development of Smallscale Industries in Arab Countries of the Middle Bast" held in Beirut in Nevember 1968, and three of the documents presented

to the Expert Group. The Report (Part I) presents findings and recommendations on policies and programmes for the development of small-scale industries, the transition from artisan activities to modern small-scale manufacturing, promotion of entrepreneurship. technical services, financing, and regional and international co-operation in the field of small-scale industry. Annex 1 of the Report is a paper on the establishment of a multi-national centre for industrial development with a special department for small-scale industry. (This report is also available as a mimeographed document under United Nations symbol ID/WI.17/19).

Part II of this publication contains three document as

"Situation, Problems and Prospects of Smallscale Industries in Six Arab Countries of the Middle East" by E. 
