

CHAPTER ONE

INTRODUCTION

Of the 1,138 fellowships completed as of 30 June 1973, a sample of 179 fellows was taken with maximum representation of all sajor cost factors. Only those costs that were paid for initially or refunded by the United Nations have been taken into account in computing costs. These include the following:

- a) International travel travel to and from the home country and travel between host countries:
- b) Internal travel travel within the host country or countries;
- c) Travel stipend or non-residential stipend given for the first month of the fellow-ship and thereafter if the fellow travels:
- d) Residential stipend;
- e) Book allowance:
- f) Insurance;
- g) Final report typings and
- those costs reimbursed by the United Nations to the governments, enterprises or institutions concerned. They are as follows:
 - i) Preparation of lectures:
 - ii) Attendance management (absences, supervisors, director);
 - iii) Fees of translators, interpreters, lecturers;
 - iv) Training aids;
 - v) Material—equipment cost (including depreciation, loss of production);
 - vi) Leasing of premises;
 - vii Meals, laboratory visits, etc!
 - viii) Programme preparation and organisation.

The following data relevant to the over-all cost or to some individual cost factor were noted for each fellow:

- a) Field of training
- b) Type of training:
- c) Host and home countries; and
- d) Training time.

The fields of training have been sstablished in accordance with UNIDO document "Programme, Programme Components and Specific Activities".

As to type of training, UNIDO distinguishes between:

- s) Non-institutional training carried out either in an enterprise or in an agency or similar body whose major activity is not training, e.g. banks, Chambers of Commerce.
- b) Institutional training carried out either in an academic body or in other training institutions.

Moreover, the fellowships were categorised as follows:

- Category A Substantial training performed in one, two, three or four bodies;
- Category B Substantial training performed in ons, two, three or four bodies as well as short visit(s) to other bodies:
- Category C Short visits to different bodies (study tour).

The results of this study warrant a separation of the fellows placed within Europe and those placed outside of Europe. Of the 179 fellowships selected for study, 144 fellows spent the major part of their training in host facilities in Europe while 35 fellows were placed in facilities located outside of Europe. Table I shows the distribution of the placements and their average duration in the major host countries. /1/

For statistical purposes, cost figures for 1967 - 1968 and for 1972 - 1973 often have been combined because 1967 and 1973 generally provide too small numbers for analysis.

A country with more than five per cent of the placements is considered a major host country.

CHAPTER 2 COSTS OF SELECTED FELLOWSHIPS CARRIED OUT WITHIN EUROPS

Table 2 gives the total expenditures for all cost factors in connexion with the selected fellowships carried out within Europe for the period 1967 - 1973.

Individual Cost Factors

International travel

In some cases travel was subsidised in full or in part by the home government as can be seen in table 3.

Stipenda

Travel stipends were given for all fellows with only one recorded exception.

There were twenty-two (22) reported cases where no residential stipend was paid. Residential stipend and travel stipends are in some ways complementary. (For example, when no travel stipend was found; it was assumed that the stipend was paid at the residential rate and visa versa.) Thus data for both stipends may be combined as shown in table 6.

Final report typing

A lump sum of US\$ 10 is generally provided with the first payment to cover the cost of typing the final report; occasionally this amount is increased. No exceptions were found. Data on cost of final report typing for the period 1967 - 1973 are given in table 9.

Details of training costs were available in a number of cases thus allowing a division of training costs into a) theoretical training and b) practical training.

Theoretical training included such items as a) language courses (mentioned frequently); b) university fees; and o) fees for participation in conferences.

Practical training included: a) field work; b) excursions and/or visits to plants; and o) on-the-job training.

Costs involved with theoretical training were found in thirty-two (32) cases. (See table 11.) The costs involved with practical training have been estimated by means of substruction. These combined data are given in table 12.

- a) Administrative costs --- so termed in two identified cases, amounting to 532 and \$71 respectively, and
- b) Unidentified refund found in only one instance expressed as a negative cost for UNIDO of -£23.

Thus the total of miscellaneous costs is \$80.

CHAPTER THREE


