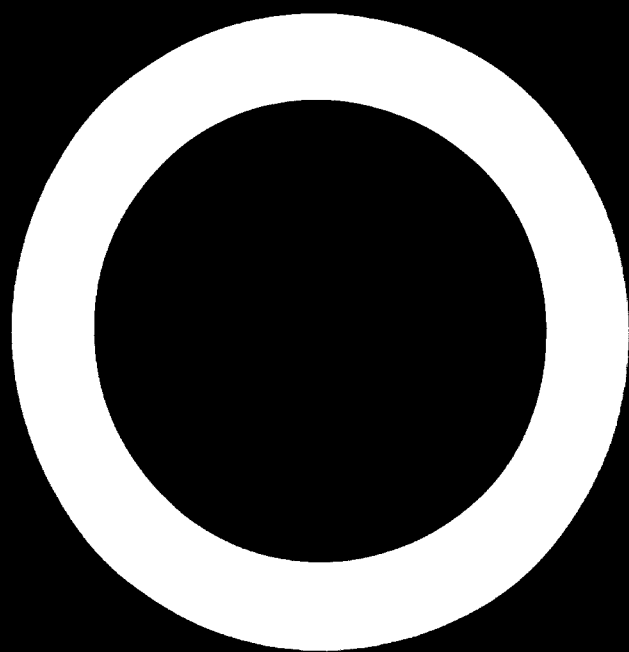

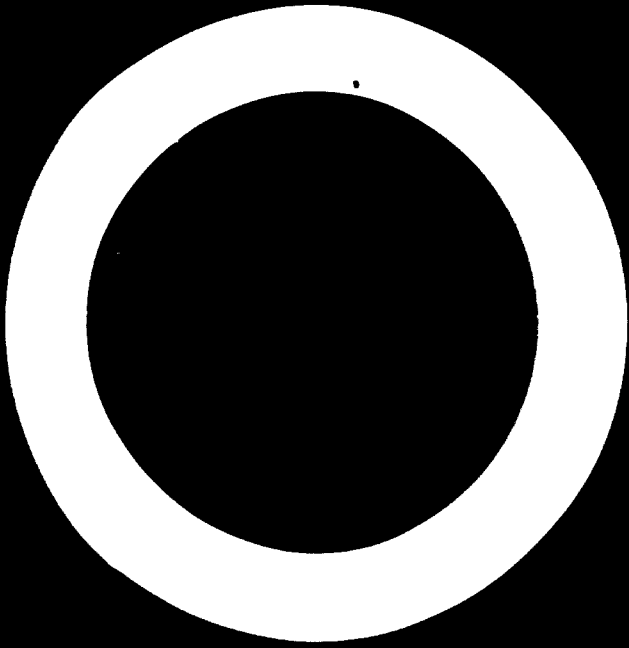

## INTRODUCTION

The United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) promotes the use of industrial information in developing countries by giving guidance in improving local information facilities. As one of the means of promotion, UNIDO compiles directories and guides to selected information sources on branches of industry of primary concern to the developing countries. The present guide, dealing with the paint and varnish industry, is the eighteenth in the series of UNIDO Guides to Information Sources (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). A list of the guides published to date appears inside the back cover of this issue; more are planned for the series.

The directories and guides are not intended to be exhaustive, nor are they intended to be research tools; rather, they present sources considered to be of practical value to users. The data have been compiled so as to facilitate rapid access to the bodies referred to and the acquisition of the publications listed.

The paint and varnish industry has developed considerably in the past decades and consumption has increased on a par with industrialisation and social development, not only because paint products provide a means of protection against corrosion and subsequent losses in equipment, but also because they help to beautify the surroundings. It is a particularly important industry for developing countries as many of the raw materials are available locally and a ready market can be found for the products. UNIDO has undertaken a number of projects in this field and is currently seeking to enlarge the scope of this assistance.

## INTRODUCTION

Pour faciliter la diffusion et l'utilisation de l'information industrielle dans les pays en voie de développement, l'Organisation des Nations Unies pour le développement industriel (ONUDI) aide ces pays à améliorer leurs moyens d'information, notamment en établissant des répertoires et des guides des principales sources d'information sur les secteurs industriels qui présentent pour eux un intérêt majeur. Le présent guide, qui concerne l'industrie des peintures et des vernis, est le dix-huitième de la série des Guides des sources d'information (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). On trouvera à la page 3 de la couverture la liste des guides déjà parus. D'autres sont prévus.

Les ouvrages de cette série ne prétendent pas être exhaustifs; ce ne sont pas non plus des instruments de recherche, mais de simples guides des sources d'information considérées comme présentant un intérêt pratique pour les utilisateurs. Les données sont présentées de manière à permettre à ceux-ci de se mettre rapidement en rapport avec les sources d'information mentionnées et d'obtenir les publications auxquelles ils s'intéressent.

L'industrie des peintures et vernis s'est beaucoup développée au cours des dernières décennies pour répondre à une demande accrue due à l'industrialisation et au développement social. Les produits, en effet, ne sont pas utilisés seulement comme moyens de protection contre la corrosion et les dommages qui peuvent en résulter, ils contribuent aussi à embellir le cadre de vie. La fabrication de peintures et de vernis présente un intérêt particulier pour les pays en voie de développement parce que ces pays disposent généralement des matières premières nécessaires et que les débouchés y sont assurés. L'ONUDI a déjà entrepris la réalisation d'un certain nombre de projets dans ce domaine et s'efforce actuellement d'élargir son assistance.

Настоящее руководство, касающееся лакокрасочной промышленности, является восемнадцатым в серии Guides to Information Sources КНИДО (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). Это особенно важная отрасль промышленности для развивающихся стран, поскольку на местах имеется множество сырьевых материалов и имеется возможность изготовления готового рынка для продукции. КНИДО взяла на себя обязательство по ряду проектов в данной области и в настоящее время пытается расширить объем этой помощи.

## INTRODUCCION

La Organización de las Naciones Unidas para el Desarrollo Industrial (ONUDI) promueve la utilización de información industrial en los países en desarrollo, proporcionando orientación para el mejoramiento de los servicios locales de información. Uno de los medios de promoción que emplea la ONUDI consiste en compilar guías y repertorios de fuentes seleccionadas de información sobre ramas de la industria de especial interés para los países en desarrollo. La presente guía, que trata de la industria de pinturas y barnices, es la decimoctava de la serie de Guías de Fuentes de Información (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D) que publica la ONUDI. La lista de de las publicaciones aparecidas hasta la fecha figura en el anverso de la contratapa de la presente guía; se prevé la publicación de otras en esta misma serie.

Estas guías no pretenden ser exhaustivas ni están destinadas a servir de instrumentos de investigación; en ellas se mencionan, más bien, fuentes que se consideran de valor práctico para los usuarios. Es una industria especialmente importante para los países en desarrollo, ya que la mayoría de las materias primas existen localmente, y se puede encontrar fácilmente mercado para los productos. La ONUDI ha emprendido diversos proyectos en esta esfera y actualmente procura ampliar el ámbito de su asistencia.

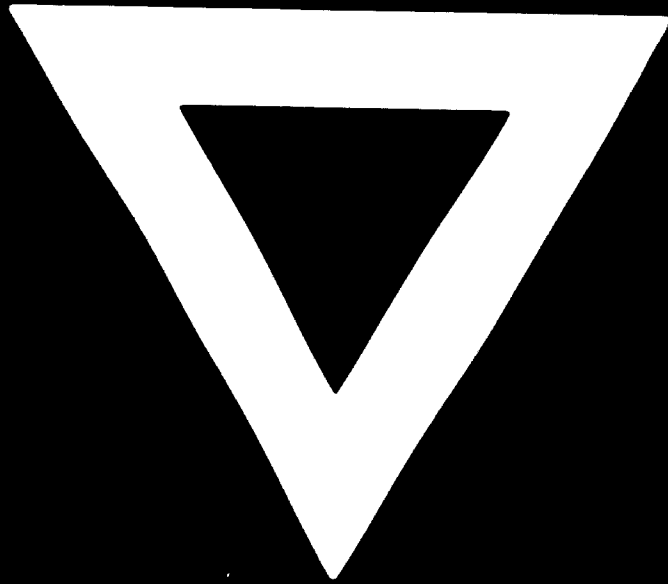
