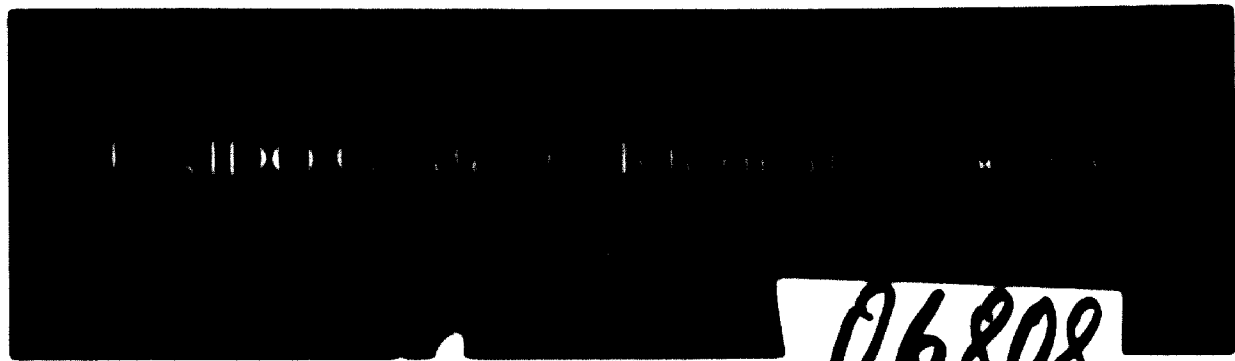

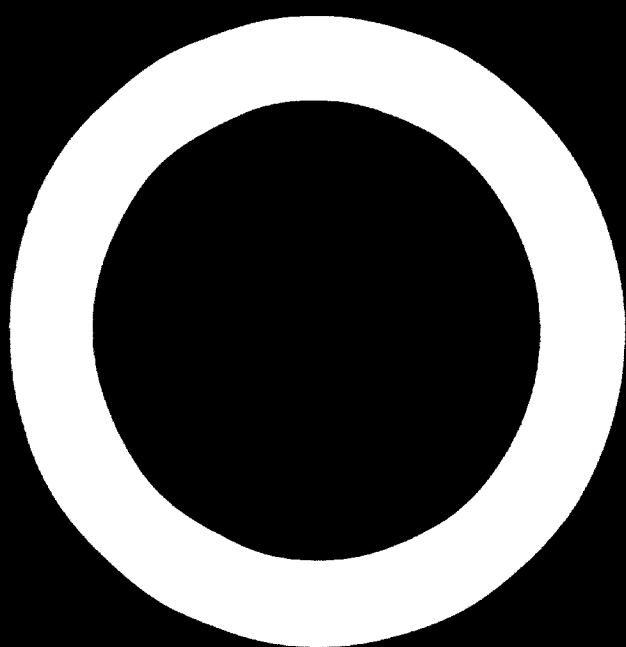


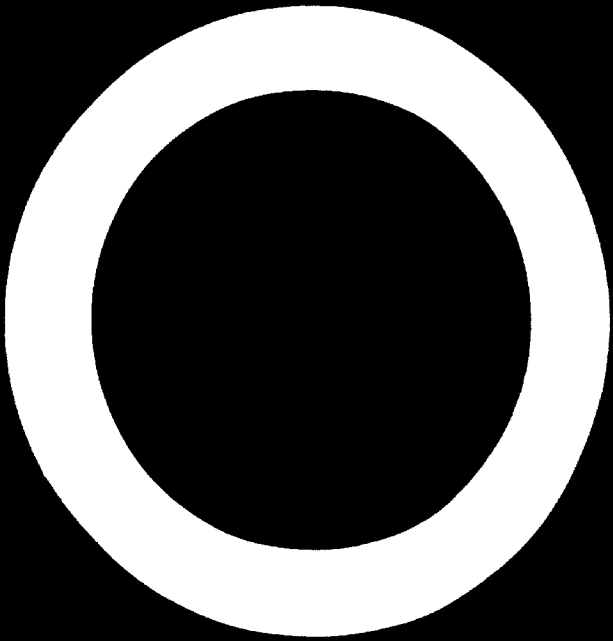

INTRODUCTION

The United Nations Industrial Development Organisation (UNIDO) promotes the use of industrial information in developing countries by giving guidance in improving local information facilities. As one of the means of promotion UNIDO compiles directories and guides to selected information sources on branches of industry of primary concern to developing countries. The present guide, dealing with the canning industry, is the nineteenth in the series of UNIDO Guides to Information Sources (UNIDO/LIB/SFR.D). A list of the guides published to date appears inside the back cover of this guide; more are planned for the series.

The directories and guides are not intended to be exhaustive, nor are they intended to be research tools; rather, they present sources considered to be of practical value to users. The data have been compiled so as to facilitate rapid access to the bodies referred to and the acquisition of the publications listed.

Although most developing countries could produce enough food not only for their own consumption but for export as well, they are not taking full advantage of the available resources and many of them are still net importers of processed food on the one hand and exporters of food as raw material on the other. One of the most frequent impediments to the development of the food processing industry in developing countries is the shortage of adequate packaging means. In this respect, it should be pointed out that although canning is a traditional and widespread industry in developing countries, it still faces numerous problems, such as inadequate quality and lack of standardisation. These shortcomings adversely affect the quality and prices of the end-products.

Many developing countries are, for the above reasons, rationalising their canning industry by means of merging enterprises, new equipment and reduction of types of cans in order to benefit from the advantages of economy of scale. UNIDO assists developing countries in modernising this industry.

INTRODUCTION

Pour faciliter la diffusion et l'utilisation de l'information industrielle dans les pays en voie de développement, l'Organisation des Nations Unies pour le développement industriel (ONUDI) aide ces pays à améliorer leurs moyens d'information, notamment en établissant des répertoires et des guides des principales sources d'information sur les secteurs industriels qui présentent pour eux un intérêt majeur. Le présent guide, qui concerne l'industrie de la conserve, est le dix-neuvième de la série des Guides des sources d'information (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). On trouvera à la page 3 de la couverture la liste des guides déjà parus. D'autres sont prévus.

Les ouvrages de cette série ne prétendent pas être exhaustifs; ce ne sont pas non plus des instruments de recherche, mais de simples guides des sources d'information considérées comme présentant un intérêt pratique pour les utilisateurs. Les données sont présentées de manière à permettre à ceux-ci de se mettre rapidement en rapport avec les sources d'information mentionnées et d'obtenir les publications auxquelles ils s'intéressent.

Alors que la production alimentaire de la plupart des pays en développement devrait être suffisante pour leur permettre, non seulement de nourrir leur population, mais encore d'exporter, ces pays ne tirent pas tout le parti possible de leurs ressources, et nombre d'entre eux restent à la fois des importateurs nets de produits de l'industrie alimentaire et des exportateurs de matières premières alimentaires. Le manque de moyens de conditionnement est un des principaux obstacles à l'expansion de l'industrie alimentaire dans les pays en développement. À cet égard, il convient de signaler que l'industrie de la conserve, bien qu'elle soit implantée de longue date dans de nombreux pays en développement souffre encore de nombreuses insuffisances, notamment pour ce qui est de la qualité et de la normalisation, qui se répercutent défavorablement sur la qualité et le prix du produit final.

Pour ces raisons, de nombreux pays en développement s'efforcent de rationaliser leur industrie de la conserve en favorisant les fusions d'entreprises, la modernisation du matériel et la réduction du nombre de modèles de boîtes afin de bénéficier des économies d'échelle. L'ONUDI aide les pays en voie de développement à moderniser ce secteur industriel.

ВВЕДЕНИЕ

Глобальная стратегия Организации Объединенных Наций по промышленному развитию (ЮНИДО) уделяет особое внимание передаче информации в развивающихся странах посредством расширения круга доступа к делу о верности в пользу местных средств информации. Одним из средств такого действия является составление в ЮНИДО справочников о кругах доступа к отдельным источникам информации, в том числе телеграфной информации, которые имеют первостепенное значение для развивающихся стран. Настоящее руководство по вопросам консервации информации является двенадцатым в серии ЮНИДО Handbook to Information Sources (ЮНИДО/ИИС/СЕР.12). Перевод с английского языка от ясного времени круга доступа к информации в национальной стране задан в целях настоящего издания; в этот список включаются также выпуски еще целого ряда руководств.

Такие справочники и круги доступа не ставят своей целью быть исчерпывающими или служить в качестве средства исследования; в них скорее представлены источники, которые предельно тщательно имеют практическую ценность для тех, кто ими пользуется. Данные в этих справочниках подобраны таким образом, чтобы облегчить как доступ к получению информации в тех организациях, на которые имеется ссылка, так и приобретение перечисленных изданий.

Хотя большинство развивающихся стран может производить достаточно продуктов питания не только для своего собственного потребления, но и на экспорт, в них до сих пор неполностью используются имеющиеся ресурсы и многие из них по-прежнему импортируют только обработанные продукты питания, с одной стороны, и экспортируют продукты питания в виде сырья, с другой. Наиболее частым препятствием на пути развития пищевой промышленности в развивающихся странах является отсутствие соответствующих средств упаковки. В этой связи необходимо указать, что хотя консервирование и является традиционной и широко распространенной отраслью промышленности в развивающихся странах, перед ним по-прежнему стоят многочисленные проблемы, такие, например, как недостаточно высокое качество продукции и отсутствие стандартизации. Эти недостатки оказывают отрицательное воздействие на качество и цены конечной продукции.

В силу приведенных выше причин многие развивающиеся страны, чтобы с большей отдачей использовать преимущества крупномасштабного производства, совершенствуют консервную промышленность путем объединения предприятий, внедрения нового оборудования и уменьшения количества различных видов консервных упаковок. ЮНИДО, со своей стороны, оказывает развивающимся странам помощь в модернизации этой отрасли промышленности.

INTRODUCCION

La Organización de las Naciones Unidas para el Desarrollo Industrial (ONUDI) promueve la utilización de información industrial en los países en desarrollo, proporcionando orientación para el mejoramiento de los servicios locales de información. Uno de los medios de promoción que emplea la ONUDI consiste en compilar guías y repertorios de fuentes seleccionadas de información sobre ramas de la industria de especial interés para los países en desarrollo. La presente guía, que trata de la industria conservera, es la decimonovena de la serie de Guías de Fuentes de Información (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D) que publica la ONUDI. La lista de las publicaciones aparecidas hasta la fecha figura en el anverso de la contratapa de la presente guía; se prevé la publicación de otras en esta misma serie.

Estas guías no pretenden ser exhaustivas ni están destinadas a servir de instrumentos de investigación; en ellas se mencionan, más bien, fuentes que se consideran de valor práctico para los usuarios. Los datos se han recopilado de modo tal que faciliten el rápido acceso a las entidades mencionadas y la adquisición de las publicaciones que se indican.

La mayoría de los países en desarrollo podrían producir alimentos suficientes, no sólo para su propio consumo, sino también para la exportación; sin embargo, no aprovechan plenamente los recursos de que disponen y muchos de ellos siguen siendo, por una parte, importadores netos de alimentos elaborados y, por otra, exportadores de alimentos en forma de materia prima. Uno de los obstáculos con que tropieza más a menudo el desenvolvimiento de la industria de elaboración de alimentos en los países en desarrollo es la escasez de elementos adecuados para el envasado. A este respecto cabe señalar que la producción de conservas, aunque es una industria tradicional y extendida en los países en desarrollo, aún hace frente a muchos problemas, tales como insuficiente calidad y falta de normalización. Estas deficiencias repercuten desfavorablemente en la calidad y precios de los productos finales.

Por tales motivos, muchos países en desarrollo están racionalizando su industria conservera mediante la fusión de empresas, la adopción de nuevo equipo y la disminución de los tipos de envase, a fin de aprovechar las ventajas de las economías de escala. La ONUDI presta asistencia a los países en desarrollo para modernizar esta industria.

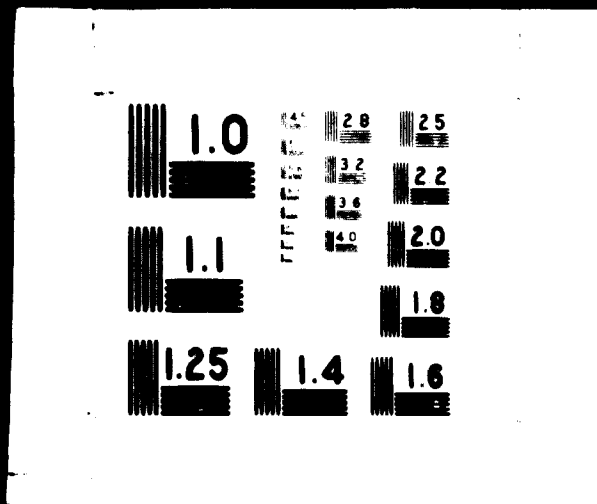

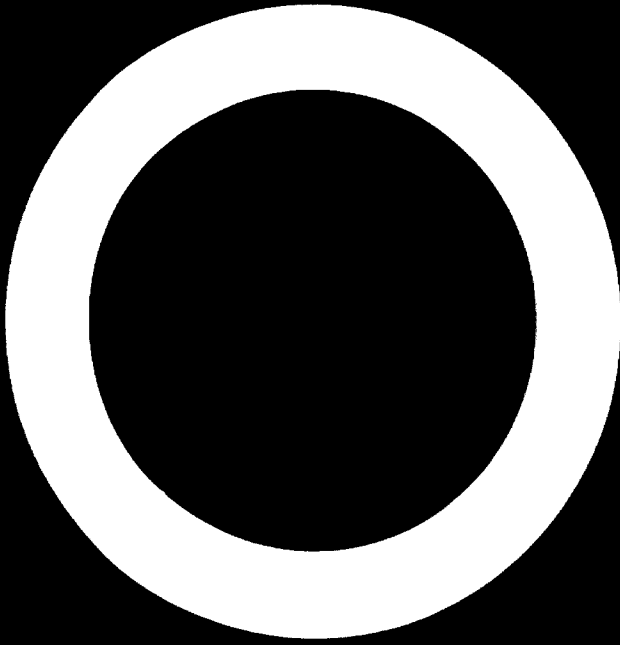

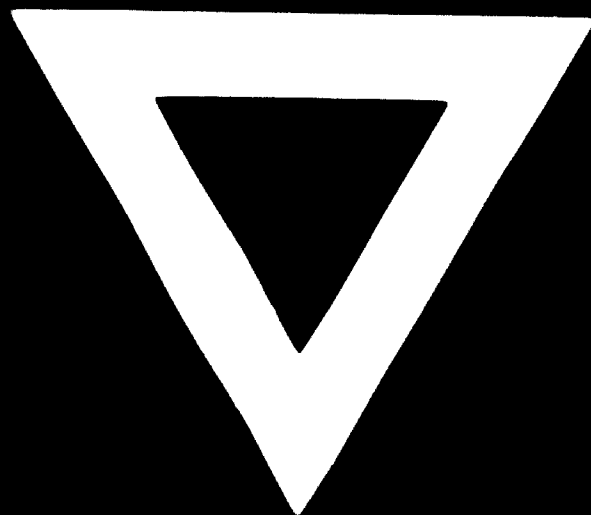
