Date and place

1. The second Consultation Meeting on the Iron and Steel Industry will open on Monday, 15 January 1979, at 10 a.m. It will be held in the Commission Room 'H', second floor, Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi-110001. The sessions will be held from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. daily.

List of participants

2. A provisional list of participants will be made available on Monday, 15 January 1979 to all participants. Only names which are communicated to the secretariat by 5 January at the latest can be included in this provisional list. The final list of participants will be issued before the conclusion of the meeting.

Nomination of representatives

Weather forecast

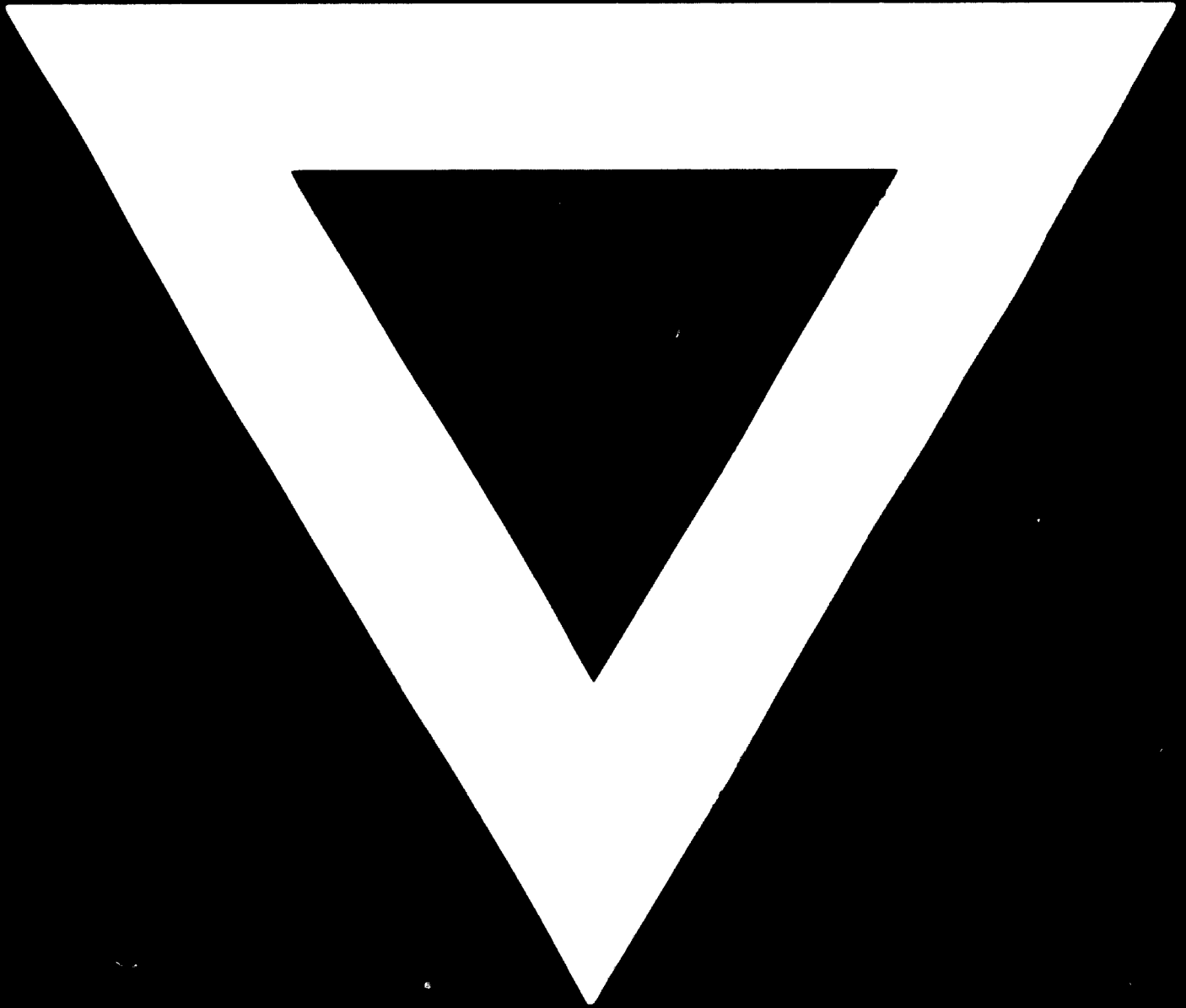
13. The temperature in Delhi, in January, varies between 7° to 21° C.
