

UNIDO REGULAR PROGRAMME OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE REVISED PROVISIONAL 1969 DRAFT PROGRAMME

Report of the Executive Director

1. As was stated in the Executive Director's report on the Provisional 1969 Draft Programme for the UNIDC Regular Programme of Technical Assistance (document ID/B/26/Add.II), owing to the short time available after the approval of resolution

2298 (XXII) of the General Assembly,^{1/} the proposed country projects as given in the provisional document were essentially based on information available at UNIDO Headquarters at that time. The draft proposals were submitted to Governments with a view to obtaining formal requests. The present report is a revision of the earlier document in the light of the consultations that have taken place.

2. Consultations were initiated with 100 governments receiving United Nations assistance from the Regular Programme. The Regular Programme in the Industrial Development field, as established by the General Assembly resolution, has aroused a great deal of interest in the developing countries. As of the date of the preparation of this report, 94 replies have been received: 44 governments have submitted requests exceeding the proposals made in the document ID/B/26/Add.II; 43 governments have endorsed the proposed figures, and 2 governments have advised that they are not in a position to submit requests for the Regular Programme in the Industrial Development field at this time.

^{1/} Resolution adopted on 12 December 1967 established the UNIDO Regular Programme of Technical Assistance as a separate section in Part V of the budget of the United Nations - document ID/B/26/Add.I.

3. Requests from six countries have not been received as yet. The Board may wish, however, to include in the Programme provision for these six countries at the levels proposed in the earlier document. Pending receipt of replies from the governments concerned, the Revised Draft Programme includes the earlier proposals subject to this provision.

4. Because a number of countries exceeded the draft proposals made by the Secretariat, the total value of the requests received so far from governments for country projects amounts to over US\$1,700,000 as compared with US\$643,000 originally proposed by the Executive Director in his report (ID/B/26/Add.II). These requests are related to assistance in major problems of the industrial sector in the developing countries.

5. In order to meet, at least in part, the increase in the requests received from member countries, the Executive Director would like to raise the proposals for the country projects by a total of US\$300,000, which would bring the total amount of the country part of the Regular Programme to US\$950,000. The amount proposed for the regional and interregional projects under the Regular Programme remains unchanged at US\$544,800.

6. Consequently, the Executive Director would like to recommend for the approval of the Board a planning level for the Regular Programme of 1969 of US\$1,500,000. This figure is above the level of the Programme in 1968, which was US\$991,400. The higher level is amply justified by the increase in requests indicated above which reflect the needs of governments for assistance in industry. In this connexion, reference is made to the recommendation to the General Assembly approved by the Industrial Development Board at its first session "for a programme of technical assistance in industrial development at an appropriate level commensurate with the expanding requirements of the developing countries". This recommendation was subsequently endorsed by the General Assembly in resolution 2298 (XXII) of 12 December 1967.

7. Under the proposal above, there would still be left an unsatisfied amount of approximately US\$750,000 in requests received from governments. It is suggested that these requests be included in the Programme as Category II; it is hoped that it may be possible to implement at least some of them through savings that may occur in the course of the year under this Programme.




