Pending the adoption of the new procedures, Committee II had felt that the consideration of applications was the prerogative of the Board itself.

Relations with inter-severement | organisations (ID/B/C.2/2/Add.1, ID/B/33 and ID/B/33/Add.1).

The PERMOY (Bulgaria), speaking as Chairman of Committee II, said that the Committee had unanimously decided to recommend the following inter-governmental organizations for admission as observers in accordance with Rule 75 of the Rules of Procedure: (a) Standing Consultative Committee of the Enghrob; (b) International Agriculture and Food Industries Commissions; and (c) Common Afro-Malagasy Organization.

- 8. <u>Fr. FERROV</u> (Bulgaria), speaking as Charmen of Committee II, said that the Committee had uranimously decided to recommend that the Industrial Development Board should include the People's nepublic of Southern Yemen and Mauritius, which had recently acquired independence, in Part A of the list of States annexed to General Assembly resolution 2152 (EAI).
- 9. The recommendations of Committee II were adopted.

10. Hr. SIBI (Ivory Coast) expressed appreciation, on behalf of the French-speaking African representatives, at the granting of consultative status to OCAN and emphasised that the African countries, which belonged to the least developed of the developing countries, placed great hopes in co-operation between UNIDO and OCAN.
