

PREFATORY NOTE

- 1. This document is presented to the Industrial Development Board in compliance with General Assembly resolution 2298 (XXII) through which a separate section was established in part V of the budget of the United Nations to provide for the regular programme of technical assistance in industrial development. In the resolution, the General Assembly also requested the Industrial Development Board to consider and approve the projects unter the regular programme and to provide general policy guidance and direction to the utilization of the resources appropriated for it.
- 2. The present document contains a review of the activities undertaken in 1971 under the regular programme as well as a proposal for the 1973 regular programme and for the planning level for 1974, which the Industrial Development Board is requested to consider and approve.

REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN IN 1971

- 3. The resources available under the regular programme in 1971, amounting to \$1.5 million, were utilized fully in the course of the year. The activities implemented under the regular programme fell into several categories.
- 4. <u>Country leve!</u> The sum of \$771,500 was utilized to finance 22 field experts and 13 advisory missions, carried out by staff members, as well as 190 individual fellowship posts amounting to 922 man/months of training in industrially advanced countries.
- 5. Regional level The financing of 14 industrial advisers attached to the regional economic commissions and UNESOB cost a total of \$242.600.
- 6. Interregional level A total of \$286,700 from resources of the regular programme were utilized for partial financing of group training programmes in such fields as iron and steel, pesticides, plastics and product adaptation for exports. The number of participants in these training programmes was 120. In addition, six interregional advisers, operating out of head-quarters, provided advisory services; these advisers were financed from the regular programme in 1971 to the amount of \$164,400.
- 7. Consultations Another important activity carried out under the regular programme has been the consultations with Governments of developing countries for the purpose of identifying, planning and programming their future technical assistance needs in industry. In 1971, fourteen such consultations were carried out, either at UNIDO headquarters or in the field, including one with a regional intergovernmental organization. This activity, which had a total cost to the regular programme of \$34,800 in 1971, has contributed to the preparation of the UNIDE Country Erogrammes.

the Industrial Development Board at its fourth sassion in 100 (ID/F/C), contain changes were inevitable in the course of implementing the programme. As a result of savings accruing from the industrial regional advisers and the long-range programming components of the programme, it was possible to divert additional runds to group training programmes and to increase the number of experts who served in the field at the country level. Table 1 below compares the programme as approved by the Industrial Development Board and as delivered in 1971.

THE PROPOSED 1973 PROGRAMME

- 9. In the planning of the 1973 regular programme, the secretariat has taken into consideration both the need to continue the types of assistance financed traditionally from the regular programme under the existing guidelines, which include essentially the training of technical personnel and the financing of industrial regional advisers, and the need for development of new activities complementary to UNIDO*s other programmes of technical assistance.
- 10. The proposed programme detailed in the following paragraphs and in the annex of country projects is within the \$1.5 million planning level recommended by the Industrial Development Board at its tifth session (A/8416, para.333).

COUNTRY REQUESTS

11. Following the programming cycle established in previous years, the Executive Director initiated in July 1471 consultations with all developing countries to determine the needs for 1973 to be met from the regular programme. As a result of these consultations, a significant part of the regular programme (\$740,000) will be devoted to country projects, particularly for

the training of personnel in advanced industrial fields, thereby providing for constant flow of specialized know-how from the industrialized to the leveloping countries. This portion of a regular programme is expected to finance some 243 fellowship posts in a variety of feeling.

Details of the country projects are shown in the annex to this to ment. The low number of expert posts indicates that these are being progressively absorbed by the VSAT Tourney. Programmes and financel under the Indicative Flanning Figures (IFF).

REGIONAL ADVISERS IN INDUSTRY

- 13. In 1973, the regular programme provides for the continued financing of the posts of industrial regional advisers attached to the regional economic commissions and UNESOB. With a view
 to adapting the co-operation between UNIDO and the regional economic commissions to current needs,
 the Executive Director initiated in 1971 consultations with the Executive Secretaries of ECA,
 ECLA and ECAFE and with the Director of UNESOB on the work of the industrial regional advances.
- In the past, the industrial regional advisors have been mainly concerned with advices in specialized fields such as iron and steel, pulp and paper and chemicals. This situation into-dated the establishment of UNIDO and fulfilled certain needs that would not have been met otherwise. However, as the regional economic commissions enjoy special positions as regional bedien and as they have special knowledge of the economic and social conditions of the countries within their regions, they are particularly well placed to carry out, through the industrial regional advisers attached to them, certain activities. These activities would be those that have priority in the programme of co-operation between UNIDO and the regional economic commissions and for which the regional economic commissions are particularly qualified, such as analyzed and our sycon industrial policies, plans, progress and intersectoral and inter-country relations.
- 15. The proposed regular programme for 1973 reflects to a certain extent this reorientation of the activities of the industrial regional advisers. Two such activities, which the secretariat considers as priorities in the co-peration between UNIDO and the regional economic semainstions, are those related to the Second United Nations Development Decade and the transfer of technology related to the needs of the region...
- 16. The regular programme will also be utilized to ensure the availability of why isory services as well as to initiate and develop projects through the interregional advisors with specialization in selected fields, who are attached to headquarters.
- As in previous years, the secretariat has provided for the financing from the remources of the regular programme of consultations with Governments on the development of their technical assistance strategies, plans and programmes in industry. The instrument of consultations has proved useful in identifying a country's immediate and future requirements for technical assistance. The preparation of the UNDP Country Programmen has reaffirmed the need for a school actions in the field of industry prior to the over-all country programming exercise, and only in view of the special complexities existing in industryal development.

- 18. In its endeavour to accelerate the industrialization of the developing countries, UNIDO is also continuously examining new ideas and avenues of action. Some of these ideas can be implemented through the established programmes of technical assistance on a country by country basis. Others, which require special appraisal and preparation, could be started by a limited appropriation from the regular programme until their feasibility and acceptability have been verified. This type of experimental activity, to be financed under the regular programme, would initially be limited to a relatively small number of projects designed to lead eventually to a wider application at the country level under other programmes. Any such activities undertaken by UNIDO would be reported to the Industrial Develoment Board in future documentation on the regular programme.
- 19. Table 2 below contains a breakdown, by types of activities, of resources from the proposed 1973 regular programme.

ACTION BY THE BOARD

- 21. The Executive Director requests the Industrial Development Board to approve the proposals for the regular programme for 1973 and to recommend to the General Assembly the appropriation of \$1.5 million within section 14 of part VI of the Regular Budget of the United Nations for the year 1973.
- 22. The Executive Director further proposes to the Board to recommend a planning level of \$1.5 million of resources for the regular programme for the year 1974.
