

10(II) Voluntary Contributions

The Industrial Development Board,

<u>Considering</u> the need to achieve a substantial expansion of the resources of UNIDO for the purpose of increasing its operational programmes of assistance to the developing countries,

Recalling the provisions of General Assembly Resolutions 2152 (XXI) of 17 November 1966,

<u>Recalling further</u> its resolution 2 (I) of 4 May 1967 by which the Secretary-Ceneral was invited to convene an annual pledging conference for announcement of contributions to UNIDO,

<u>Mindful</u> of the fact that appropriate voluntary contributions to UNIDO from as many countries as possible would be fully consistent with the international character of its programmes designed to assist the industrialization of the developing countries,

1. <u>Requests</u> the Executive Director to take the necessary steps to promote through direct contacts with the governments of the developed and the developing countries their effective support by means of appropriate voluntary contributions to UNIDO for its operational programes in accordance with Section 11, paragraph 23 of General Assembly resolution 2152 (XXI);
