I. INTRODUCTION

External capital has an important supplementary and complementary function in the industrialization of African countries. Investment promotion is therefore not only a desirable activity but also a necessary one. The operation-oriented elements of this work include the publicising of industrial opportunities in African countries for investment attention and the search for mutually beneficial joint venture arrangements.

In the past few years, ECA has had an opportunity of developing a number of contacts in several countries to facilitate its catering to specific regional needs. These contacts represent links with potential investors and provide the means to bring to the latter's attention specific industrial proposals from African countries. The work has now been consolidated in the publication of this Directory of Investment Promotion Contacts for African Industrialisation.

The Directory provides a useful reference to African Governments on potential investors who may be called upon to pursue investment proposals in co-operation with the government, industrialization agencies and entrepreneurs. In compiling the Directory, ECA has been prompted by a desire to help accelerate the pre-investment process and gain access to the requisite sources of industrial investment. It is also hoped that the governments may also wish to draw the attention of these contacts to their industrialization objectives, programmes and policies with a view to making known the investment climate in Africa.

The Directory lists 62 organizations in 19 countries besides 8 international and specialized institutions, each with a distinctive status and potential for assistance in investment promotion. It includes organisations noted for their experience in industrial investment promotion activity and their knowledge of the requisites of African industrialization as well as new ones which have expressed interest in following up African industrial proposals for investment attention. They have been described, for convenience, according to their functional position in six broad categories. The details of the African industrial proposals may be referred to them with an indication of the kind of resources - financial, technological, managerial or marketing - required for their implementation. Likewise, these contacts may consider bringing to the notice of the African Governments or ECA industrial proposals from potential investors in their countries.

The Directory is the first of its kind from ECA and is being brought out in a provisional form. ECA would welcome comments and suggestions on its contents and presentation so that future editions of it may incorporate required improvements.


