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Hides, Skins and Leather Industry in Developing Africa

1. At the Second Session of the Leather and Leather Products Industry Panel it was decided that increased consideration should be given to the conditions and situation of the Leather and Leather Products Industry, inter alia, in the developing countries of Africa.
2. The Panel is aware of the difficulties of gathering complete and reliable data from the African region, as well as the problems of standardizing the available data for the purposes of statistical comparison.
3. As suggested by some Panel members, a continuous collection and up-dating of statistical data over several years would probably provide the best way of carrying out the above task. It was further suggested that local as well as international experts working in the field should be utilized for this purpose.
4. Recognizing that the recruitment of local experts must remain the responsibility of concerned Member Governments, the Secretariat, on its part, plans to utilize as far as possible its own experts in the field to obtain the required data. In this connection, the Secretariat has prepared the attached table which -
  - (i) will serve as a standard information sheet on each country to be filled in by UNIDO experts in the field; and
  - (ii) will provide the basis to update currently available data from all sources.
5. Accurate and continuing information on production, collection, processing and final use of hides and skins in each African developing country is clearly needed to analyze the conditions and situation of the industry, and the ways and means of providing technical assistance to improve conditions in each country. (Issue Paper 1 deals with the problem systematically).
6. The Panel may wish to consider and recommend the format of the attached table for the purpose of improving and standardizing statistical intelligence on African developing countries in particular.


