INTRODUCTION

The United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) promotes the use of industrial information in developing countries by giving guidance in improving local information facilities. As one of the means of promotion UNIDO compiles directories and guides to selected information sources on branches of industry of primary concern to developing countries. The present guide, dealing with the fertilizer industry, is the twenty-first in the series of UNIDO *Guides to Information Sources* (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). A list of the guides published to date appears inside the back cover of this guide; more are planned for the series.

The directories and guides are not intended to be exhaustive, nor are they intended to be research tools; rather, they present sources considered to be of practical value to users. The data have been compiled so as to facilitate rapid access to the bodies referred to and the acquisition of the publications listed.

Of all the factors contributing to the Green Revolution, chemical fertilizers constitute the single most important input. The fertilizer industry has a significant place in the industrialization strategies of developing countries. A key industry in building up technology and know-how in agriculture, it is also one of the fastest growing industries in these countries.

Habitually, the developing world has been deficient in fertilizers. In order to increase agricultural production to keep up with the needs of growing populations, it has been necessary to import fertilizers from the developed countries. Yet many developing countries possess reserves of the raw materials used in producing fertilizers, such as natural gas, sulphur, phosphate rock and potash. UNIDO therefore assists these countries in establishing new industries to exploit their indigenous raw materials. The goal of this assistance is to enable the developing countries with adequate resources to become self-sufficient in fertilizer production and capable of exporting fertilizers to other developing countries.

INTRODUCTION

Pour faciliter la diffusion et l'utilisation de l'information industrielle dans les pays en développement, l'Organisation des Nations Unies pour le développement industriel (ONUDI) aide ces pays à améliorer leurs moyens d'information, notamment en établissant des répertoires et des guides des principales sources d'information sur les secteurs industriels qui présentent pour eux un intérêt majeur. Le présent guide, qui concerne l'industrie des engrais, est le vingt et unième de la série des *Guides des sources d'information* (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). On trouvera à la page 3 de la couverture la liste des guides déjà parus. D'autres sont prévus.

Les ouvrages de cette série ne prétendent pas être exhaustifs; ce ne sont pas non plus des instruments de recherche, mais de simples guides des sources d'information considérées comme présentant un intérêt pratique pour les utilisateurs. Les données sont présentées de manière à permettre à ceux-ci de se mettre rapidement en rapport avec les sources d'information mentionnées et d'obtenir les publications auxquelles ils s'intéressent.

Parmi tous les facteurs qui contribuent à la Révolution verte, les engrais chimiques sont le principal. L'industrie des engrais occupe une place importante dans les stratégies d'industrialisation des pays en développement. Clef du développement de la technologie et des connaissances dans le domaine agricole, elle est aussi l'une des industries qui connaissent la croissance la plus rapide dans ces pays.

En général, les pays en développement souffrent d'une pénurie d'engrais. Pour satisfaire aux besoins résultant de la croissance démographique, et pour augmenter en conséquence la production agricole, ils doivent importer des engrais en provenance des pays développés. Cependant, beaucoup de pays en développement possèdent des gisements de matières premières utilisées pour la fabrication des engrais, telles que le gaz naturel, le soufre, le phosphate et la potasse. Aussi l'ONUDI aide-t-elle ces pays à créer les industries qui leur permettront d'exploiter ces matières premières. Le but de son assistance est de doter les pays en développement des ressources nécessaires pour se suffire à eux-mêmes en engrais et pour en exporter dans d'autres pays en développement.

ВВЕДЕНИЕ

Организация ООН по промышленному развитию (ЮНИДО) содействует использованию промышленной информации в развивающихся странах путем предоставления руководств по совершенствованию местных средств информации. Одним из средств такого содействия является составление в ЮНИДО справочников и руководств по отдельным источникам информации, касающимся тех отраслей промышленности, которые имеют первостепенное значение для развивающихся стран. Настоящее руководство, касающееся вопросов производства удобрений, является двадцать первым в серии ЮНИДО под названием *Справочники источников информации* (Guides to Information Sources) (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). Перечень опубликованных до настоящего времени руководств приведется на третьей странице обложки данного справочника; в этой серии запланирован выпуск еще целого ряда руководств.

При составлении этих справочников и руководств не ставится цель сделать их искажающими или чтобы они служили в качестве инструмента исследования; в них скорее представлены источники, которые имеют практическую ценность для тех, кто ими пользуется. Данные в этих справочниках подобраны таким образом, чтобы не только облегчить доступ к получению информации в тех организациях, на которые имеется ссылка, но также и приобрести перечисленные публикации.

Из всех факторов, способствующих „зеленой революции“, производство химических удобрений является единственным самым важным фактором. Производство удобрений занимает значительное место в стратегии индустриализации развивающихся стран. Являясь одной из ключевых отраслей промышленности в деле накопления технологий и „ноу-хау“ в сельском хозяйстве, производство удобрений — одна из самых быстро растущих отраслей промышленности в эти странах.

Обычно развивающиеся страны всего мира испытывают недостаток в удобрениях. Для того чтобы увеличить сельскохозяйственное производство в соответствии с нуждами постоянно растущего населения, необходимо заниматься импортом удобрений из развитых стран. Однако многие развивающиеся страны располагают запасами таких сырьевых материалов, необходимых для производства удобрений, как, например, природный газ, сера, фосфаты и поташ. Поэтому ЮНИДО помогает этим странам в создании новых промышленных отраслей во эксплуатации имеющихся в местах сырьевых материалов. Цель этой помощи заключается в том, чтобы позволить развивающимся странам, имеющим соответствующие сырьевые ресурсы, обеспечить себя полностью продукцией производства удобрений и стать экспортерами удобрений в другие развивающиеся страны.

INTRODUCCION

La Organización de las Naciones Unidas para el Desarrollo Industrial (ONUDI) promueve la utilización de información industrial en los países en desarrollo proporcionando orientación para el mejoramiento de los servicios locales de información. Entre las medidas para realizar esa labor figura la compilación de repertorios y guías respecto a determinadas fuentes de información sobre ramas industriales de interés primordial para los países en desarrollo. La presente guía, consagrada a la industria de los fertilizantes, es la vigésima primera de la serie titulada *Guía de Fuentes de Información* (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). En el interior de la contracubierta de esta guía puede verse una lista de las guías publicadas hasta la fecha; se prevé la publicación de muchas más en esta serie.

Estos repertorios y guías no pretenden ser exhaustivos ni están destinados a servir de instrumentos de investigación, sino que presentan fuentes consideradas de valor práctico para los usuarios. Los datos se han recopilado de manera que proporcionen un rápido acceso a las entidades mencionadas y faciliten la adquisición de las publicaciones que se indican.

De entre los factores que contribuyen a la Revolución Verde, los fertilizantes químicos constituyen el insumo más importante. La industria de los fertilizantes ocupa un lugar importante en las estrategias de industrialización de los países en desarrollo. Además de ser una industria clave para el desarrollo de la tecnología y de los conocimientos técnicos aplicados a la agricultura, constituye una de las industrias de mayor crecimiento en estos países.

Los países del mundo en desarrollo han sido, por lo general, deficitarios en materia de fertilizantes. Para aumentar la producción agrícola y satisfacer las necesidades de poblaciones en continuo crecimiento, ha sido preciso importar fertilizantes de países desarrollados. Sin embargo, muchos países en desarrollo poseen reservas de las materias primas utilizadas en la producción de fertilizantes, tales como gas natural, azufre, fosfato mineral y potasa. En consecuencia, la ONUDI presta asistencia a estos países en el establecimiento de nuevas industrias para explotar sus materias primas locales. Tal asistencia tiene por meta que los países en desarrollo dotados de recursos apropiados puedan llegar a ser autosuficientes en la producción de fertilizantes y posibles exportadores de éstos hacia otros países en desarrollo.




