## INTRODUCTION

The United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) promotes the use of industrial information in developing countries by giving guidance in improving local information facilities. As one of the means of promotion UNIDO compiles directories and guides to selected information sources on branches of industry of primary concern to developing countries. The present guide, dealing with the beer and wine industry, is the twenty-fifth in the series of *UNIDO Guides to Information Sources* (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). A list of the guides published to date appears at the end of this guide; more are planned for the series.

The directories and guides are not intended to be exhaustive, nor are they intended to be research tools; rather, they present sources considered to be of practical value to users. The data have been compiled so as to facilitate rapid access to the bodies referred to and the acquisition of the publications listed.

The climate in many developing countries favours an increased consumption of beverages, including those with a limited alcohol content. Where water—a main ingredient—is abundant, it is economical to produce beverages locally, especially if the other raw materials are available. At present beer production is expanding gradually, and new facilities are being built or planned. In grape-growing areas, wine making is also increasing.

UNIDO assists developing countries in establishing, improving and expanding beer and wine industries based on imported bulk materials and on imported and indigenous raw materials. It also helps to make information on the technical and economic aspects of beer and wine production more readily available.

## INTRODUCTION

Pour faciliter l'utilisation de l'information industrielle dans les pays en développement, l'Organisation des Nations Unies pour le développement industriel (ONUDI) aide ces pays à améliorer leurs moyens d'information, notamment en établissant des répertoires et des guides des principales sources d'information sur les secteurs industriels qui présentent pour eux un intérêt majeur. Le présent guide, qui concerne les industries brassicoles et vinicoles, est le vingt-cinquième de la série des *Guides des sources d'information* (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). On trouvera à la fin de cette publication la liste des guides déjà parus. D'autres sont prévus.

Les ouvrages de cette série ne prétendent pas être exhaustifs; ce ne sont pas non plus des instruments de recherche, mais de simples guides des sources d'information considérées comme présentant un intérêt pratique pour les utilisateurs. Les données sont présentées de manière à permettre à ceux-ci de se mettre rapidement en rapport avec les sources d'information mentionnées et d'obtenir les publications auxquelles il s'intéressent.

Dans de nombreux pays en développement le climat favorise l'accroissement de la consommation de boissons, notamment celles qui sont légèrement alcoolisées. Dans les entroits où l'eau — ingrédient indispensable — existe en abondance, il est rentable de produire des boissons localement, surtout si on peut se procurer facilement les autres matières premières. A l'heure actuelle, l'industrie brassicole se développe progressivement et de nouvelles installations sont en cours de construction ou à l'étude. Dans les régions de viticulture, la production vinicole est également en augmentation.

L'ONUDI aide les pays en développement à créer des industries brassicoles et vinicoles ou à développer celles qui existent déjà, qu'elles utilisent des produits importés en vrac ou bien des matières premières importées ou disponibles localement. Elle contribue également à faciliter l'accès aux renseignements concernant les aspects techniques et économiques de la fabrication de la bière et du vin.

## ВВЕДЕНИЕ

Организация Объединенных Наций по промышленному развитию (ЮНИДО) содействует использованию промышленной информации в развивающихся странах путем обеспечения руководства в деле совершенствования местных средств информации. Одним из средств такого содействия является составление в ЮНИДО справочников и руководств по отдельным источникам информации, касающимся тех отраслей промышленности, которые имеют первостепенное значение для развивающихся стран. Данное руководство по пивоваренной и винодельческой промышленности является двадцать пятым в серии Руководств ЮНИДО по источникам информации (*Guides to Information Sources* [UNIDO/LIB/SER. D.]). Перечень опубликованных до настоящего времени руководств приводится на внутренней стороне задней обложки данного руководства; в этой серии планируется выпуск еще целого ряда руководств.

Справочники и руководства не ставят своей целью быть исчерпывающими или служить в качестве инструмента исследований; в них скорее представлены источники, которые, как полагают те, кто ими пользуется, имеют для них практическую ценность. Климат многих развивающихся стран благоприятствует росту потребления напитков, в том числе напитков с ограниченным содержанием алкоголя. Там, где имеется в изобилии вода - главная составная часть напитков - вполне экономично заниматься местным производством напитков, особенно, если имеются другие сырьевые материалы. В настоящее время постепенно расширяется производство пива и ведется или планируется строительство новых производственных мощностей. В районах, где выращивается виноград, расширяется также производство вина.

ЮНИДО помогает развивающимся странам в деле создания, совершенствования и расширения отраслей промышленности по производству пива и вина на базе импортируемых материалов в виде бестарного груза и на базе импортируемых и местных сырьевых материалов. Она также помогает более быстрому предоставлению информации по техническим и экономическим аспектам производства пива и вина.

## INTRODUCCION

La Organización de las Naciones Unidas para el Desarrollo Industrial (ONUDI) promueve la utilización de información industrial en países en desarrollo proporcionando orientación para el mejoramiento de los servicios locales de información. Entre los medios de que se vale la ONUDI para este fin, figura la compilación de repertorios y guías de fuentes de información seleccionadas sobre ramas industriales de interés primordial para los países en desarrollo. La presente guía, consagrada a las industrias cervecera y vitivinícola, es la vigésimo quinta de la serie titulada *Guías de Fuentes de Información* (UNIDO/LIB/SER.D). Al final de esta guía puede verse una lista de las publicadas hasta la fecha; se prevé la publicación de otras de la misma serie.

Los repertorios y las guías no pretenden ser exhaustivos ni están destinados a servir de instrumento de investigación, sino que presentan fuentes consideradas de valor práctico para los usuarios. Los datos se han recopilado de manera que proporcionen un rápido acceso a las entidades mencionadas y faciliten la adquisición de las publicaciones que se indican.

El clima de muchos países en desarrollo favorece un mayor consumo de bebidas, incluso las que tienen un contenido limitado de alcohol. Allá donde abunda el agua —ingrediente fundamental— resulta económico producir bebidas en el propio país, sobre todo si se dispone de las restantes materias primas. En la actualidad, la producción de cerveza crece paulatinamente, y se están construyendo o proyectando nuevas fábricas. En las comarcas viticultoras, la elaboración de vinos va también en aumento.

La ONUDI presta asistencia a países en desarrollo en el establecimiento, mejoramiento y expansión de las industrias cervecera y vitivinícola basadas en materias primas importadas a granel o en materias primas importadas y locales. La ONUDI contribuye asimismo a facilitar la búsqueda de información sobre los aspectos técnicos y económicos de la fabricación de cerveza y la elaboración de vino.

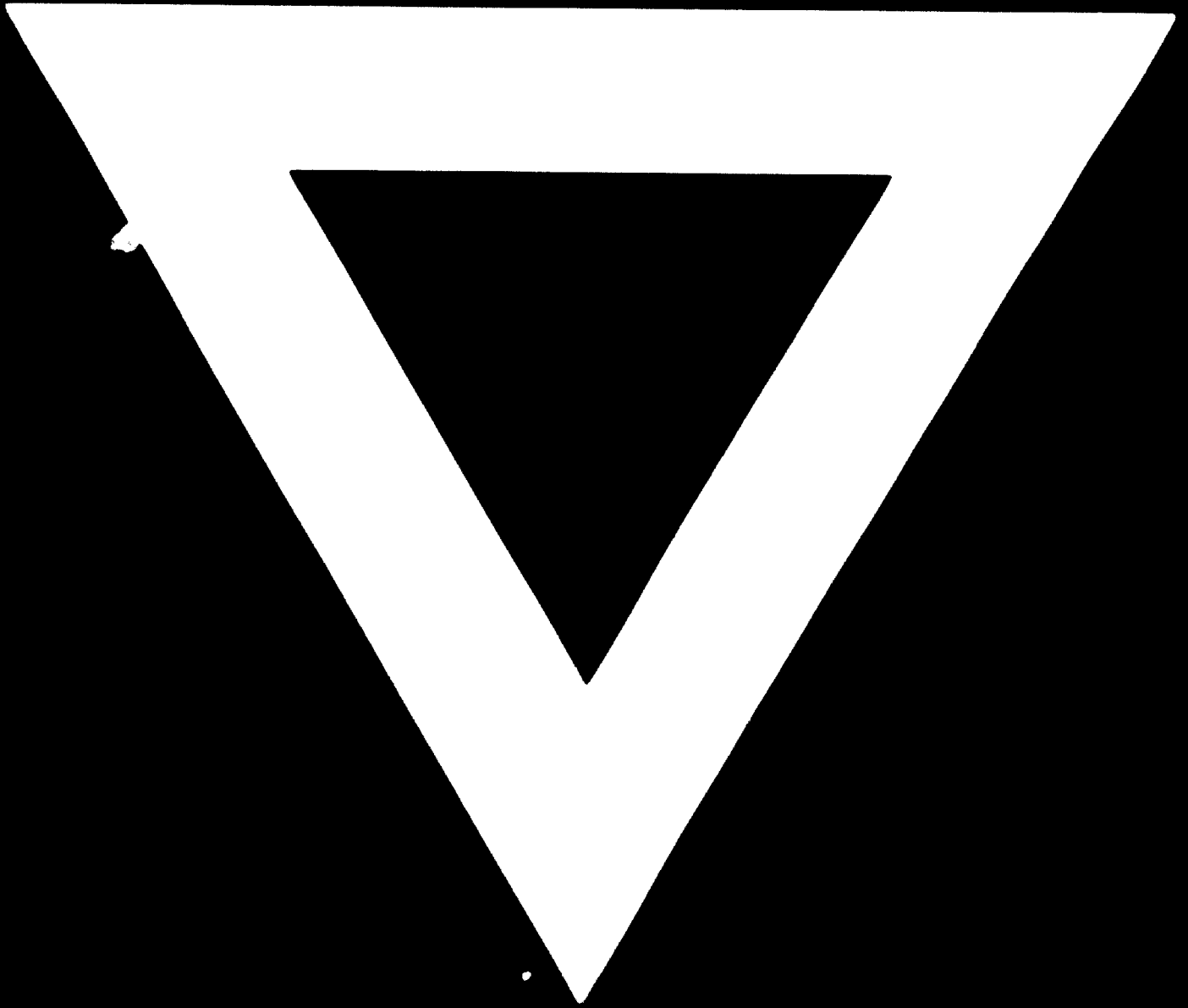
