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

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Seminar on International Co-operation on Design, Construction and Operation of Fruit and Vegetable Processing Plants and Cold-Storage Facilities

INTRODUCTION:

The above Seminar was held in Eulgaria from 29 September 1931 to 2 October 1981, according to the attached programme (Annex I). Participants from Algeria, Benin, Brazil, Greece, Jordan, Mozambique and Mexico, in total 18 people, attended the meeting (See Annex II - List of Participants).

The meeting had as a basic objective to acquaint participants of developing countries with the integrated fruit and vegetable sector of Bulgaria and also to inform them of the country's development in the field of refrigeration. The Seminar covered a theoretical aspect in which two papers (see Annex III and Annex IV) were presented by Bulgarian professors. The papers and discussions held by the participants covered the main trends in the fields of fruit processing and refrigeration.

It was clear from the beginning that the participants were very much interested in knowing the basic aspects of the Bulgarian organization in the field of integrated agro-industry. Therefore, by means of visits, films and discussions, the participants were informed about the following aspects:

- (i) Agricultural development especially concerning irrigation;
- (ii) Planning of agricultural production of fruit and vegetables both for the fresh market and for processing;
- (iii) Processing of fruit and vegetables from the moment of receiving the raw materials until the final products, quality control, packaging and distribution, particularly to the export market;
- (iv) Research and development centres dealing with food processing and with technological development;

- (v) Training of food technologists, both at the theoretical and practical level;
- (vi) Production of equipment covering design, equipment and construction; and
- (vii) The most modern equipment actually being built in Bulgaria.

The above items were dealt with as examples of the fruit processing sector, however, in order to complement the participants' information, the sector of milk and dairy products was also covered.

The Seminar was very intensive covering only four working days and the participants had the opportunity of visiting a large fruit and vegetables plant, a technological institute, one training institute, the largest milk and dairy products plant in Bulgaria and the International Fare at Ploydiv.

Finally in order to be acquainted with the specialization of the various sectors in Bulgaria, a film was presented to show the way TECHNOEXPORT operates to sell technology and equipment on the international market.

The representatives of the developing countries fully participated in the Seminar, had the opportunity of obtaining clear information about the Bulgarian agro-industry development and about the facilities existing in this country for further co-operation with developing countries.
