COMPUTERIZED REGISTRY INFORMATION SYSTEM (CORIS)*

Prepared by the UNIDO secretariat

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Introduction

1. In recent years developing countries became increasingly aware of the need to regulate the overall flow of technology. Regulatory policies were introduced based on among others:

- (1) to channel technology towards priority sectors of industrial development;
- (2) to reduce the overall cost of importing technology;
- (3) to obtain detailed information on the status of technology transfer in the country;
- (4) to co-ordinate technology inflow with local R and D efforts;
- (5) to promote the effective use of the imported technology and to promote technology exports.

2. To execute such policies, many countries have established technology transfer registries. A salient activity, common to all registries, is the access to technology transfer contracts either for approval or for information purpose.

3. Experience has indicated that the effective organization of handling information flow can substantially contribute to the overall registry performance as well as increase the benefits resulting from using outside sources for information.

4. Consequently, this area has gained increased attention within the co-operative framework of Technology Transfer Registries called Technological Information Exchange System (TIES). Following the recommendations of consecutive TIES meetings the UNIDO secretariat has developed the concept of a Computerized Registry Information System (CORIS) ^{1/} as a model information system operated on personal or microcomputer.

5. CORIS has been developed to be useful for four main functions, namely:

- evaluation of technology transfer agreements;
- generation of statistics on approved/registered technology transfer agreements;
- monitoring of implementation of technology transfer agreements;
- information exchange through TIES.

6. Certain assumptions are made with respect to the organization of the information flow, namely, that:

1) When a contract enters a registry for evaluation, the contract will receive a registration number and a file number and that a minimum set of information enters the information system (recipient, name, supplier name and country, object of the agreement, evaluation officer and application date).

2) The information will be completed when the contract has passed the approval stage through an "update".

3) The information will be updated periodically when monitoring reports are received.

7. At present the software prepared is applicable on a M24 personal computer manufactured by Olivetti, Italy (for details see annex I) and is IBM compatible.

8. CORIS has been developed for the use in English, Spanish and Polish.

Model Contract Card

9. While preparing a model computerized registry information system, it became necessary to determine the model information input. An export group meeting ^{2/} was called to determine such inputs, and on the basis of a comparative analysis of the existing registry information systems, a model contract card (annex II) has been designed as an abstract of the

information most commonly generated by registration, evaluation and monitoring of technology transfer contracts. In the design of the model contract card, due consideration has been given to the information needs of the various users of the information system. It has also been taken into consideration that the model contract card could serve as an example for a manual information system input format.

10. Basic description of the CORIS system

The CORIS system has been designed as a user-friendly information system. Therefore access to desired information or function is organized in a hierarchical manner, using the concept of MENUS. Menu is a specification of functions or outputs, which are possible to obtain using application programs. List of functions displayed on the screen leads to individual programs without knowing program names and file names, but simply entering the number of the function on the list. It means that it is unnecessary to be very familiar with data processing or programming. The CORIS system as a user-friendly system helps the user to activate suitable programs in a simple and clear way.

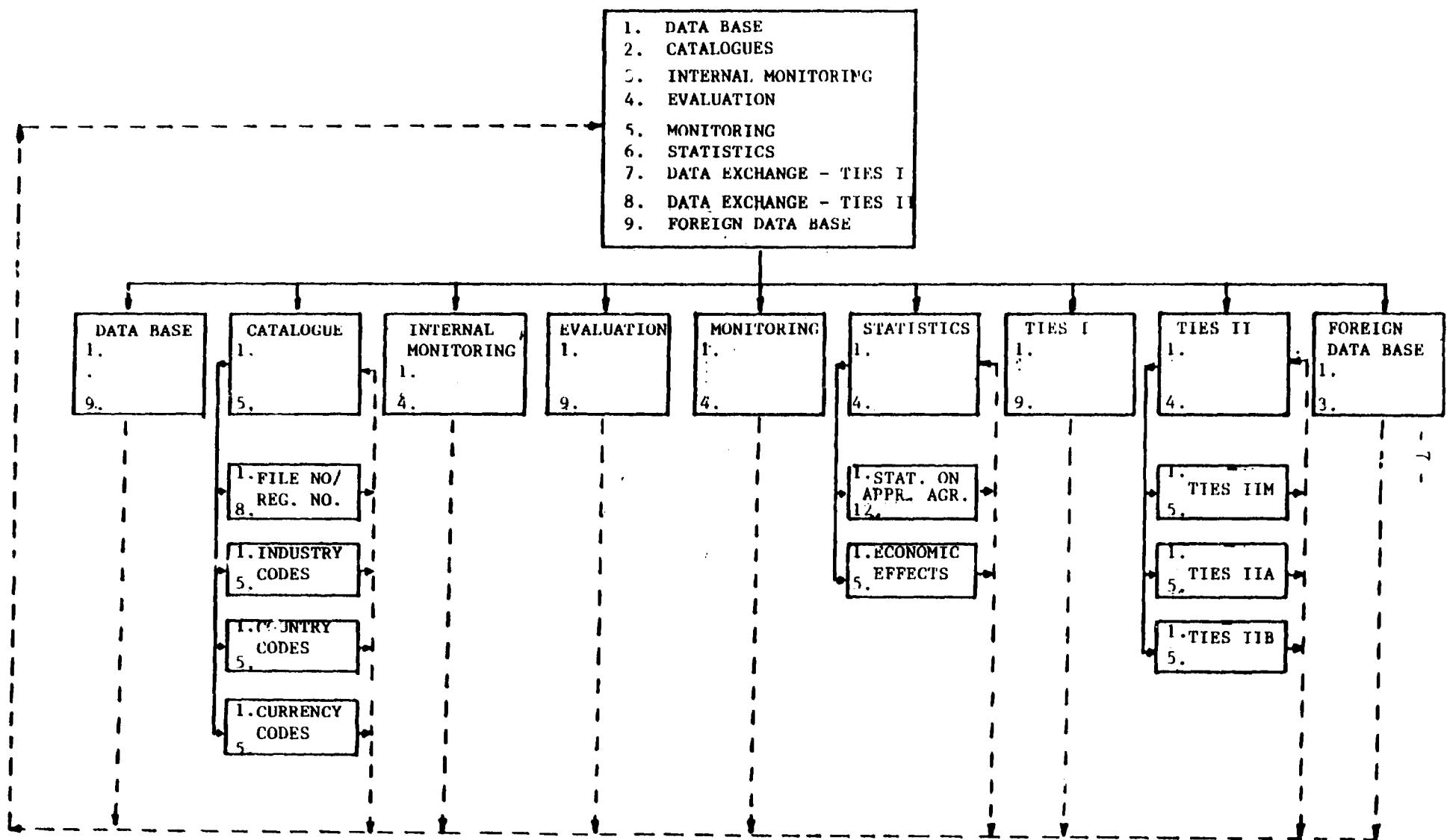


Fig. 1 Concept of MENUS.

Figure 1 on the next page summarizes the concept of MENUS on which the logical structure of the CORIS system is based and visualizes existing interconnections between menus.

Following are some of the operational characteristics of CORIS.

a. Data base

The input format of data is determined by the contract card and has been divided into nine different screens (annex III). Each screen can be completed with relevant data or left blank. When a contract enters a registry for evaluation, the contract receives a registration number and then a minimum set of information enters the information system. The information will be completed when the contract has passed the approval stage. Additionally, the information will be updated periodically when monitoring reports are received. Data entered at the registration can be corrected at any time. Furthermore, the contract card identified by its registration number can be displayed (annex II, p. 36-40) or printed (annex II, p. 41-43), deleted, and then deleted contract card can be recovered if necessary.

b. Catalogues

There are catalogues containing country codes (annex III, p. 44-45), currency codes (annex III, p. 44-45) and industrial codes (annex III, p. 44-45) which can serve for correct coding of data and which are used by special error routines to control data entering. The fourth catalogue helps the user to find interconnections between registration numbers generated automatically by the system and file numbers generated in a manual manner (annex III, p. 44-45). The content of the catalogues can be modified, displayed or printed.

c. Internal monitoring

To observe office performance, it is possible to print at any time those contracts which are under evaluation (annex III, p. 46). Furthermore, assuming that the registry is divided into sectoral departments, it is possible to summarize effects of intervention of that sector for any period of years (annex III, p. 47). The same can be done for any individual officer (annex III, p. 47).

d. Evaluation

The evaluation officer, while reviewing an application for approval of technology transfer agreements, has the possibility to request information on registered contracts (approved or rejected) in order to find quickly answers (annex III, p. 48-51) to such questions as:

- What other contracts does that supplier have?
- Are there more contracts of that nature (by product, by industry)?
- Has the supplier previously presented a contract which has been rejected?

In addition it is possible to consult some statistics to observe trends by industrial sectors as well as to obtain an abstract of contracts registered in other countries (through participation in TIES at the TIES II level).

e. Monitoring

Although monitoring is not always performed by the technology transfer registries, it has been incorporated in CORIS as it is expected that this function will receive increased attention at the registry level. The mechanism will enable the official in charge of monitoring to select those contracts which did not fulfill their expected implementation targets from the point of view of effective technology transfer as well as those contracts which exceeded their targets.

The following targets can be monitored: production volume, net sales, exports, imports, R + D expenditures, employment, profit before tax, number of persons trained home and abroad, number of foreign personnel, yearly technology transfer payments (annex III, p. 52-53), assuming that every year a monitoring report is presented to the registry informing about targets achieved.

f. Statistics

There is a possibility to print or display at any time the table summarizing effects of intervention of the registry for any period of years (annex III, p. 54).

Furthermore, it is possible to know the influence of approved technology transfer contracts on national economy (annex III, p. 61-62), as well as perform monitoring at the macro level (annex III, p. ??). In addition some statistics concerning approved technology transfer contracts have been prepared in accordance with TIES I tables giving the possibility to observe trends by industrial sectors (annex III, p. 55-60), being also useful for the evaluation procedure.

g. Data exchange (TIES I)

TIES information exchange on technology transfer contracts at the TIES I level has been incorporated in CORIS. It is the periodic exchange of a summary of terms and conditions of contracts by industrial sectors (ISIC, four digits). It contains 8 tables (annex III, p. 63-70).

h. Data exchange /TIES II/

TIES information exchange on technology transfer contracts at the TIES II level of participation has been also included in CORIS.

There are three options at that level:

TIES II M - the periodic exchange of a minimum information on technology transfer contracts approved,

TIES II A - the periodic exchange of non-financial data on contracts,

TIES II B - the periodic exchange of non-financial data and detailed information on the financial terms of the contracts.

Files containing above information are created on floppy disks. Since ID key for each contract can be generated only once during file generation, the special routine can be used for recovering lost file, assuming that the first ID key used for such file is known for the user. Having file created on the diskette, it is possible to print its content (annex II, p. 71-76).

I. Foreign data base

Based on the assumption that every year a full set of contracts approved by TIES participants is sent to the national registries from TIES, it is possible to obtain an abstract of contracts registered in other countries, searching such data set using required supplier name, ISIC or SITC codes. All contracts found can be printed (annex II, p. 77-78).

2. HARDWARE CONFIGURATION

The IBM compatible version of the CORIS system is originally prepared on the M24 Personal Computer (Olivetti)

Some technical specifications of the M24 PC are listed below:

- a) CPU-8086 microprocessing with 16-bit technology (8 Mhz), 128 KB basic capacity expandable to 640 KB, 8087 coprocessor, calendar/clock with battery, 16 KB ROM for bootstrapping, power-on diagnostics and BIOS.
- b) Mass storage devices - one or two 360 KB or 720 KB slim floppy discs plus one 10 MB or 12.6 MB or 19.4 MB or 30 MN or 50 MB slim hard disc.
- c) Keyboard, self-standing, 83-key industry standard layout.
- d) Display, self-standing monochrome or colour displays (12 in.), 80x85, 40x25, 64x16 (col x lines) characters, 640x400, 640x200, 320x200 pixel resolution, 16-colour palette.
- e) Printers, dot-matrix 80/132 columns, hard-copy graphics, electronic typewriters

Options originally used for CORIS preparation

- a) As above, 125 KB RAM
- b) 360 KB slim floppy disc plus external 10 MB hard disc
- c) As above
- d) Colour display
- e) Dot-matrix 80 columns with hard-copy possibilities.

3. Operating system and application programmes

The following operating systems are available on the M24 Personal Computer:

- MS-DOS
- Concurrent CP/M-86
- UCSD P-system
- PCOS

To achieve the objective of IBM compatibility, the CORIS system is running under MS-DOS operating system.

The Olivetti Personal Computer MS-DOS Operating System (Rev. 1.01) is equivalent to the Microsoft Disc Operating System Ms-DOS (Microsoft rev. 2.11) and operationally compatible with industry standard personal computers. All application programmes have been written in MS GW-BASIC interpreted language (Microsoft Rev. 2.01). GW-BASIC is the most common

and the most extensive implementation available for personal computers. It meets the requirements of the ANSI standard for BASIC and supports many unique features rarely found in other BASICS. In addition, it provides structured programming features and has improved graphics possibilities, so GW-BASIC combined with MS-DOS provides a powerful and friendly environment for the BASIC programmer.
