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Preface

This statistical digest is a continuation of the work begun with Volume II of the study "The Vegetable Oils and Fats Industry in Developing Countries: Outlook and Perspectives", Sectoral Study Series No. 13 (UNIDO/IS.477). It is intended to issue regularly quantitative information on the sector, presenting recent data and estimates of relevance to the development of the vegetable oils and fats industry.

While FAO continues to be a major source for data in this sector, the primary source for this digest is Oil World Weekly. This choice permits the presentation of an internally consistent statistical picture of the entire vegetable oils and fats system. Where necessary, the UNIDO secretariat supplements these data through additional primary information or own estimates to achieve a sufficiently detailed picture of the sector.

INTRODUCTION

The digest deals with ten groups of vegetable fats and oil products, namely:

Copra, copra meal and coconut oil
Cottonseed, cottonseed meal, cotton oil
Groundnuts, groundnut meal, groundnut oil
Olives, olive meal, olive oil
Palmfruit, palm oil
Palmkernels, palmkernel meal, palmkernel oil
Rapeseed, rapeseed meal, rapeseed oil
Sesameseed, sesame meal, sesameseed oil
Soybeans, soybean meal, soybean oil
Sunflowerseed, sunflowerseed meal,
sunflowerseed oil

The vegetable oils and fats industry constitutes an important part of manufacturing in many economies. To illustrate its relative position, the tables in this introduction show the vegetable oils and fats sector in relation to total production and trade in regional economies. The shares of vegetable oils and fats, meals, and seeds in total GDP have been estimated from the gross output values of the A-tables by using the following average value added/gross output ratios:

Section A of the digest contains summary tables of the production and trade, by type of crop and UNITAD region, and gives the statistical interpretation of the same data. For any given crop, the tables are presented on the same page to facilitate a meaningful comparison of the absolute and the relative information. Section B identifies the major producers and traders in the world, by type of crop. Section C gives the available information from a variety of sources, on capacities for a number of countries.^{1/} These data may contain significant errors, mainly due to differing definitions in different sources. The data, nevertheless, represent the best information available on this important topic.

Export data by destination, normally presented in Section D of these digests, are not presented for this sector. Likewise, import data on input materials (Section E) are not presented because of the primary nature of this sector.

Section F gives world export and import price quantity indices of the chain-linked Fisher type, calculated by UNIDO. They are based on external trade unit values which have been screened for consistency in terms of reported units of measurement, value and quantity.

The regional breakdown is done according to the regions of the UNITAD model, a joint UNIDO/UNCTAD model for exploring prospective long term changes in the world economy.

Section A

Production and trade by type of crop and region,
1976, 1980 and 1984; thousands of tons,
shares and annual growth rates

These tables are based upon data obtained from Oil World Weekly; the computations are by the UNIDO secretariat. The tables are summary tables showing estimated production and trade by product group and UNITAD region as well as shares and growth rates based on the same data. The value of the world total, evaluated at the 1984 world price in US dollars, is also given to illustrate the economic magnitudes of the physical quantities. In concept it corresponds most closely to that of gross output.

The prices, obtained from Oil World Weekly, present the "Lowest Representative Asking-Price for Nearest Forward Shipment (US - \$/MT)" and are equal to those given by both the FAO in its Production Yearbook and UNCTAD in its Monthly Commodity Price Bulletin. Note, however, that because neither Oil World Weekly nor FAO give the price for the sesame products, the prices used here are those for Sudan, a major supplier, provided to UNIDO by ITC. The prices can easily be recalculated by dividing the world total value by the world total quantity, and can be subsequently applied to the regional quantities in the tables to obtain \$ - values for them as well.

Section F

Section F presents price and quantity indices for the world trade in vegetable oils and fats, computed by UNIDO. These indices are of the chain-linked Fisher type and are based on unit values calculated from the UNSO Commodity Trade Statistics. They are based on external trade values which have been screened for consistency in terms of units of measurement, and in terms of reporting of both value and quantity. Large and unexplained jumps in unit values from one year to another have been filtered out by the computing algorithm.

Note that the calculated indices for 1984 may be based on yet very incomplete reporting and may therefore be unrepresentative of true trends.
