INTRODUCTION

One of the recommendations and the priority follow-up actions suggested by The Tenth Round Table on Industrial Cooperation among Developing Countries from Small-Scale Industry to Transnational Corporations held in Zagreb, Yugoslavia, 15th to 17th September 1982, was the establishment of cooperative network of industrial planning institutions. In order to implement this recommendation, this Directory of industrial planning institutions in developing countries has been elaborated in close cooperation with the Institute for Developing Countries, Zagreb.

In most developing countries there are governmental and non-governmental organizations and institutions concerned with industrial planning and development. This Directory identifies some of these institutions, gives the scope of their competences, and presents their activities in industrial development planning and cooperation at national, regional and international levels. The Code is included in the Directory to enable those industrial planning institutions in developing countries which conform to the criteria and standards elaborated in it to join the network for purposes of cooperation and mutual communication.

The aim of the Directory of industrial planning institutions is to present those areas in which practical measures and actions concerning industrial development and cooperation among developing countries could be undertaken. The Directory is designed, inter alia, to

- strengthen international cooperation in the field of industrialization
- facilitate the exchange of information on industrial development activities among developing countries
- help in collecting, preparation and analysis of data on industrial planning and development activities in developing countries
- promote cooperation between institutions interested in industrial development
- increase the opportunities for industrial planning institutions in developing countries to participate in development efforts.

By allowing access to data on industrial planning institutions and organizations in developing countries and identifying the scope of their activities and competences, the Directory will help those institutions in developing countries interested in developing their linkages and exchanging information concerning industrial planning and

development at national, regional and international levels.

It is hoped that this Directory will contribute to effective mutual cooperation among developing countries in the field of industrialization.

We gratefully acknowledge the collaboration of governmental and non-governmental institutions and persons in developing countries who were kind enough to supply us with requested information.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This Directory is based on responses to a questionnaire sent to institutions in eighty countries in Africa, Asia, Latin America and Europe, of which 43 responded in time to be included in the Directory.

Countries are presented in alphabetical order according to the United Nations English nomenclature. Within each country institutions are listed alphabetically and specific data is presented in the language used by respondents. Institution name, country and acronym indexes are provided to facilitate location of specific information in the Directory.

This Directory contains a Code of standards enabling industrial planning institutions to be included in a network for the establishment of their mutual communications.

The full description of an industrial planning institution includes items presented in the Questionnaire shown below.

THE CODE

(Principles of cooperation)

1. The Directory of Industrial Planning Institutions in developing countries is conceived as a basis for a better understanding of the activities and capabilities of various governmental and non-governmental institutions in developing countries dealing with the promotion and planning of industrial development, economic development policies and planning, science and technology policies, information policy, trade

policy, investment promotion legislation, and incentive activities.

2. At a later stage the Directory should form the basis of a future network of such institutions. The network would act as a means of promoting communication and cooperation among industrial planning institutions in developing countries for their greater and more efficient self-reliant development. The main aim of the network will be to establish and successively develop direct links among institutions in such a way that all participants could communicate through terminals.

3. With industrial development as the basic task, the objectives of cooperation can be defined as follows:

- to enable the participants to improve their knowledge about one another, and to exchange actual experience,
- to facilitate and improve working efforts by pooling the participants' expert potential whenever desirable or feasible,
- to promote a freer view of global development and their own development problems,
- to develop a framework for a dynamic international information system in the field of promotion and planning of industrial development,
- to initiate the exchange of experts, study visits, etc.

4. The principles of cooperation within the network will be shaped and improved successively, but the following general principles (code) must be respected: voluntariness, solidarity, accessibility, complementarity, decentralisation, non-profit character of the network. Further:

- (a) The participants - industrial planning institutions - join solely on the basis of their respective interests.
- (b) Solidarity will manifest itself through the exchange of information and data on projects and research results, exchange of publications, encouragement of joint project activities, and various other ways of promoting and improving working capabilities.
- (c) Information flow, data bases and knowledge within the network should be accessible to all, and only conditionally on the relevance to key notions.
- (d) The network will, according to the principles decided by the participants, use all relevant channels of information, and to this purpose selectively and complementarily link itself with other similar networks, with information and communication systems, with UN agencies and international organisations.

- (e) The network will be characterized by equal rights and responsibilities of all the participants, with the selected institution acting only as a promoting focal point.

The participants of the network are forty three institutions from Africa, Asia, Latin America and Europe, primarily those which have responded to the questionnaire. Their interests are concentrated in the following fields, and activities:

- Industrial promotion and planning
- Economic development and planning
- Science and technology policies
- Information policy
- Trade policy
- Investment promotion policy/laws and regulations
- Fiscal incentive policy
- Sub-regional and regional development policies
- International cooperation in exchange of information
- Joining the network of industrial planning institutions/organizations in developing countries, and participation in the computerization of the network.

The possibility is left open also for other industrial planning institutions in developing countries to join the network at a later stage.

5. The medium of communication will be a bulletin by means of which the participants (and intending participants) will be informed on the developments within the network. The bulletin will be distributed to all the participants (and intending participants), cooperating networks, UN agencies, and individual experts.

The objective will be to ensure prompt and concise communication among institutions and individuals from developing countries interested in the exchange of information, experience, results and problems stemming from their actual work. Besides the data on the participants and their capabilities, the communication will review current projects and research tasks, aims, topics, methodology, restrictions, results and applications; cooperative and joint projects; exchange of information, data, documents; information on relevant literature; news from selected networks and organizations, etc.

6. National governmental and non-governmental industrial planning institutions/organizations should be encouraged to:

- (a) effectively contribute to the development of industrial planning institutions network of developing countries, and
- (b) introduce a computerized or other data banking systems, where none are at present available.

- Science and technology policies. While the National Science and Technology Authority (NSTA) is the primary governmental unit dealing with science

and technology issues and programmes, the NEDA plays a supportive role in the identification of policy gaps in the field of science and technology. It ensures that the S & T policies of the NSTA fit into the overall recovery and development plans of the country,

- Trade policy. The NEDA policy Coordination Staff is largely engaged in conducting policy studies and recommending policy options on matters relating to the country's domestic and international trade activities.
