CERTIFICATE OF ACCEPTANCE

This Certificate of Acceptance is made by the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (hereinafter referred to as "UNIDO"), SUPER BOSH Co. Egypt (hereinafter referred to as "the Project Counterpart") and Implants OMS Spa, Italy (hereinafter referred to as "the Contractor");

Whereas, the Executive Committee of the Multilateral Fund for the Implementation of the Montreal Protocol (hereinafter referred to as "the Executive Committee"), in response to a request from the Government of Egypt (hereinafter referred to as "the Government"), has approved the project entitled " Phasing out ODS at Alaska, El-Nasr, Helwan Iberna, Siltal & Super Bosh Refrigeration Plants" (hereinafter referred to as "the Project");

Whereas, to implement the Project, UNIDO has concluded Contract No. 96/036 (hereinafter referred to as "the Contract") with the Contractor for the provision of a complete package of technical services and supply including the technical documentation, supply of the manufacturing and safety equipment and spare parts, and making available the training services (including industrial safety) and technical supervision personnel, required to convert the refrigerator plant of Super Bosh, Egypt, with the aim to phase out the use of CFC-11 and CFC-12 in the manufacturing of domestic refrigerators and reaching at least the same quality and production capacity as achieved by the recipient company prior to conversion;

Whereas, the Contractor, in executing the Contract, has provided technical services including the technical documentation, supplied the equipment and spare parts, and made available the training services;

Whereas, in application of paragraph 3.09 of the Contract, the Performance Tests have been carried out by the Contractor and the Project Counterpart during the period from November to 4 December 1998, to establish the conformity of the Modified Plant with the specifications and requirements set forth in the Terms of Reference, the Contractor's proposal and in the technical documentation;

Now, therefore, the Parties hereto mutually witness the following:

1. The Contractor has fulfilled all the requirements of the Contract related to the provision of the technical documentation, supply of the equipment and spare parts;
2. The Performance Tests have proved the conformity of the Modified Plant to the requirements, including industrial safety, set forth in the Contract and its annexes;
3. The Project Counterpart's personnel have been trained by the Contractor on-the-job to operate and maintain the Modified Plant.
4. The Modified Plant is ready for commercial operation by the Project Counterpart.

The results of the Performance Tests and the document confirming safety certification of the Modified Plant by the Local Authorities are attached herewith.


All equipment replaced by the project will be destroyed latest within six (6) months. This will be certified by Super Bosh and the Government.

The transfer of title (ownership) of the new equipment will be effected upon presentation of the certificate of the disposal of the replaced equipment and of the certificate of full conversion both submitted by the Government of Egypt to UNIDO.

This Certificate of Acceptance shall not be construed to establish any limitation of other obligations which the Contractor might have under the Contract.


