Fields of Entry Format and Lay-out

Objectives of the Directory

Part of the work programme of the Industrial and Technological Information Section and within the framework of the Consultation Meeting on Food-processing and Storage with emphasis on Fruits and Vegetables is the preparation of a directory on R&D institutions concerning fruits (tropical and non-tropical) and vegetables.

This directory has to provide, in particular the following information:

- (i) sphere of activity of the respective R&D institution with particular former, current and anticipated projects;
- (ii) essential extent and purpose of operation together with the corresponding research equipment (pilot scale);
- (iii) identification of possibilities and interest for technical co-operation and availability of organizing training programmes;
- (1v) number of staff and relation with other organization(s);
 - (v) budget and source of funds.

It is hoped that the above outlined objectives of the directory in question will contribute to develop co-operation among R&D institutions/ centers etc., working and/or supporting work in similar fields, and strengthen substantially the technological capabilities of R&D facilities in developing countries.

How to obtain the necessary Information

All the information in the directory under preparation has to be elicited by means of a professional questionnaire. The preparation of the questionnaire constitutes a very substantive part within the framework of the preparation of this directory. The major problem how to cover, as systematically and comprehensively as possible, the various possibilities of activities related to fruits and vegetables industries has been tackled by designing a table with properly defined code-numbers. By means of this system it is intended to obtain an abundance of information from every questionnaire be replied.

Indexes

Three indexes will provide full access to the descriptive listings in the

main body of the directory. These will be:

- (1) Country code index.
- (ii) Activity index to provide access to research units by specific field of activity.
- (iii) Technical co-operation index to provide access to R&D units carrying out training programmes or requesting training and/or assistance.

Entry Format

Each institution of research and development willbe given a separate entry. Each entry will be introduced with the full title of the institution. In detail the following subject fields will compose the the information profile corresponding to each entry and will confine the format lay-out. These are:

The United Nations Industrial Development Organization is in the process of compiling a Directory of R & D institutions concerning food-processing and storage with emphasis on fruits and vegetables.

The information obtained from research and training together with its proper evaluation and dissemination are pivotal elements in the industrialization process of developing countries, but a number of factors that contribute to the development of an appropriate technological infrastructure in industrialized countries are either insufficient or totally lacking in these countries.

Research and development co-operation is typically an area where a number of ideas, both old and new, still have to be fully tested. The <u>promotion of twinning arrangements</u> leads to direct channels of communication between R & D institutes and organizations in industrialized and developing countries. These arrangements also provide a framework for <u>various types of training facilities</u> and <u>longer-term collaboration</u>. Efforts might also be made to launch <u>co-operative research programmes</u> aimed at developing new technologies from which both industrialized and developing countries could benefit.

UNIDO's activities in this field are aimed at promoting the underlined objectives of technical co-operation, assistance and the exchange of industrial and technological information, and within the framework of the
