I. ORGANIZATION OF THE MEETING

<u>Representation</u>

The meeting was attended by 167 participants from 20 Islamic countries, including representatives of 15 industrial organizations, regional and national financial institutions. The list of participants is attached as Annex 3.

Opening of the meeting

The meeting was formally opened by Mr. Abdulaziz A. Hanafi, Secretary General of the Islamic Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Commodity Exchange (ICCICE).

Syed Nazar Hassan Shah, Acting President of the Federation of Pakistan Chambers of Commerce and Industry, in his welcome address, called upon Islamic countries to collectively evolve policies, which when implemented can get the Ummah a respectable place in the community of nations. He further said that the Islamic countries have all the resources for attaining their objectives. They produce 50% of the world oil and accounts for 40% of the world's export of raw materials. He further said that the main objective of holding this meeting was to initiate joint ventures through mutual co-operation. He concluded by wishing the Islamic Chamber and UNIDO success in their endeavours in bringing greater co-operation among the Islamic countries.

Sheikh Ismail Ali Abudawood, President of the Islamic Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Commodity Exchange, was not able to attend the opening session. He, therefore, instructed Mr. Abudulaziz A. Hanafi to deliver the speech on his behalf. The Secretary General of ICC underlined the importance of a stable economic framework for sustained growth and self-reliance in the context of the prevailing socio-economic conditions in the selected less developed Islamic countries. He called for greater thrust on industrialization and the need for foreign private investment flows in the form of either direct equity investments or joint ventures. He further highlighted the importance of the meeting as a befitting occasion for a clear projection of common cause for tapping the potentials of foreign private capital in the industrial growth of the less developed Islamic countries. He also underlined the importance of the bilateral discussions during the meeting and the presence of a great number of sponsors which would result in deciding details of many projects. He concluded by thanking UNIDO for the technical assistance provided for the industrialization process in the Islamic countries and the Federation of Pakistan Chambers of Commerce and Industry for their support and co-operation in organizing the meeting.

Speaking on behalf of UNIDO, the Head of Arab Countries Programme and head of the UNIDO delegation welcomed the participants to the meeting and thanked them for their support and contribution towards the preparations of the meeting.

He then presented UNIDO's activities in general and its programmes for economic and technical co-operation among developing countries, in particular. Referring to the meeting, he explained that it fitted well with the overall emphasis being given to enterprise-to-enterprise co-operation, for both public and private sectors, through the transfer of technology and know-how, equity participation, external marketing, training and financing through leasing and buy-back arrangements.

The speaker expressed the hope that during the bilateral discussions on approximately 135 projects identified and submitted by the 8 less developed countries, it would be possible to reach preliminary agreements on as many projects as possible. He also underlined the importance of the follow-up activities for the actual implementation of projects.

Election of Bureau

The Meeting agreed that its proceedings be conducted by Mr. Abdulaziz A. Hanafi, Secretary General of the Islamic Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Commodity Exchange (ICCICE) as Chairman, and Mr. Syed Nazar Hassan Shah, Acting President, Federation of Pakistan Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FPCCI) as Rapporteur.

Presentation of Country Project Proposals and Possibilities of Assistance by Financial Institutions

During the second plenary meeting, the representatives of less developed Islamic countries (Bangladesh, Comoros, Djibouti, Maldives, Nigeria, Sierra Leone, Sudan, Uganda and Republic of Yemen) provided ample information on current economic and investment policies of their countries and explained the scope of the project proposals submitted to the meeting. A total of about 135 projects were submitted to the meeting by the countries mentioned above.

The representatives of the aforementioned countries referred to the Meeting as the first practical step towards promoting industrial and economic co-operation among the Islamic countries. They thanked UNIDO, FPCCI amd ICCICE for ciganizing the Second Joint-Ventures Meeting which brought together, private entrepreneurs, financial institutions, project sponsors, Government representatives etc. to discuss specific projects and to examine ways and means of promoting joint venture arrangements by mobilizing and channeling the resources available within the Islamic countries. They concluded by thanking the Islamic Chamber for the excellent hospitality and arrangements made for the Meeting.

The above presentation was followed by addresses of some of the financial institutions present at the meeting, namely Islamic Development Bank, United Group International (United Arab Emirates), Overseas Investment Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Pakistan Industrial Credit and Investment Corporation Ltd., Industrial Development Bank of Pakistan, Federation of Consultants from Islamic Countries, MediPak.

The senior officials of Investment Promotion Bureau, Government of Pakistan provided some expert advice and some guidance to the project sponsors of 8 LDCs and co-operating partners.

<u>Closing of the Meeting</u>

The Meeting for the Promotion of Joint Ventures among Islamic Countries was concluded on 28 November 1991. The meeting adopted the draft report and requested the ICCICE and the UNIDO to finalize, reproduce and circulate the final report to all participants.

The meeting also resolved to place on record its high appreciation to the organizers for the hospitality, the excellent arrangements, mode of conduct of the meeting and extended hearty thanks to the Government and the People of Pakistan.

Closing statements were made by Mr. Syed Nazar Hassan Shah, Acting President of the Federation of Pakistan Chambers of Commerce and Industry, the Head of the UNIDO delegation and Sheikh Ismail Ali Abudawood, President of Islamic Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Commodity Exchange.

The speakers expressed their hopes that all necessary arrangements should be undertaken in order to ensure speedy implementation of the agreements. In this regard, they urged the Islamic countries to mobilize their resources, capacities and capabilities so that the required follow-up action is successfully carried out. They also urged the Islamic financial institutions

to play a major role in financing the implementation of joint venture agreements reached at the Meeting and requested the member Governments to open up channels to provide necessary incentives for promoting joint ventures among Islamic countries.

II. SUPPLARY OF BILATERAL DISCUSSIONS ON INDUSTRIAL PROJECTS

During the meeting a total of 155 bilateral sessions took place between project sponsors on one side and potential co-operating partners on the other side. Several bilateral discussions also took place with representatives of the Islamic Development Bank and other financial institutions. A detailed project by project summary of the results of the bilateral discussions is given in Annex 2. The results reflect a high degree of active participation by all participants of the meeting. Of the 135 industrial projects considered by the meeting, preliminary agreements on various forms of co-operation were reached on 104 projects. Memoranda of understanding were signed for 28 projects as per Annex 1. The projects discussed and the preliminary agreements reached cover such areas as: pre-feasibility and feasibility studies, project designing, supply of equipment, consultancy, training, equity participation and joint ventures.

The visits to the industrial plants within Karachi area exposed the participants to some important industrial achievements in Pakistan, including technological developments. The visit would facilitate the future co-operation between Pakistani companies and the project sponsors from the less developed Islamic countries.

The success of the meeting indicates that the potential for economic and technical co-operation among developing countries clearly exists. Besides the agreements reached during the meeting itself, many participants were of the view that their participation and contacts during the meeting were very positive and useful, particularly for future industrial co-operation.

III. RECOMMENDATIONS

1. <u>Recommendations for Action by Co-operating Parties</u>:

- a) Co-operating parties of the projects should further examine ways and means for the implementation of the specific projects discussed at the Karachi meeting.
- b) Each of the co-operating parties should, where appropriate, contact financial and investment institutions such as the Islamic Development Bank, Faysal Islamic Bank of Bahrain, as well as national and other development banks to mobilize the resources for implementation of agreed projects.
- c) For projects where the amount of financing required from the Islamic Development Bank is less than 2 million Islamic Dinars, co-operating partners should approach the national development financing institutions where the IDB has extended lines of equity or leasing. Projects requiring financing of more than 2 million Islamic Dinars from the IDB may be forwarded to the Bank through the office of IDB Governor in the Member Country concerned, along with a recent feasibility study.
- d) The advanced Islamic countries are invited to examine the possibility of providing to the less developed Islamic countries technical and financial assistance necessary for the implementation of projects discussed at the meeting.

2. <u>Recommendations for Action by Organizations and</u> <u>Financial Institutions of Islamic countries</u>

a) Organizations and Institutions in Islamic countries are invited to provide support, to the extent possible, towards implementation of identified projects. b) Financial institutions such as the Islamic Development Bank, African Development Bank, Arab Fund for Economic and Social Development, Arab Bank for Economic Development in Africa, Faysal Islamic Bank of Bahrain etc. are invited to provide financial assistance towards the implementation of identified projects.

3. <u>Recommendations for Action by UNIDO and ICCICE</u>

- a) The participants stressed the need for continuing support from UNIDO in promoting ECDC/TCDC activities.
- b) UNIDO should within its possibilities provide to co-operating parties the necessary support during the follow-up stage for the implementation of identified projects.
- c) UNIDO and ICCICE should identify institutions and enterprises in more advanced developing countries that can provide expertise, technologies and equipment for co-operation with the less developed countries.
- d) UNIDO and ICCICE should monitor the implementation of projects identified in the meeting. For this, the co-operating partners should provide the necessary information to UNIDO and ICCICE.
- e) UNIDO, in co-operation with ICCICE, should review the implementation of the projects discussed in Karachi.
